Headed up by Dee Kellner of Azle, TX, the state affiliate has been re-established from the ground up with the support and dedication of Kathy Marcum, Lori Krell, and Roxie Lee.

In the past, others found it difficult to build and retain membership in the affiliate because the state is large and requires support from several areas to be able to offer inclusion to the entire state. Dee has responded to this issue by reaching out to people in different parts of the state to inform members who were previously unable to be included in activities and events that were confined to a smaller area of the state that the affiliate wants to be inclusive in all parts of the state.
