



- 5. Upload your video test(s) to whichever share or upload service you prefer (YouTube, Dropbox Google Drive, etc.) and send a SHAREABLE link to Wdqueenagers@gmail.com. Please note "BOSS Video Entry, Class # & Horse Name" in email subject line.

What Happens After I Submit My Video Test?

- 1. BOSS Show Mgmt confirms receipt of entry form & PayPal payment.
- 2. BOSS Show Mgmt reviews video, confirms all Virtual Show Guidelines have been followed & all attire & equipment is legal.
- 3. BOSS Show Mgmt submits video test for judging & adds your submissions to the live scoreboard.
- 4. BOSS Judges judge submission & provide feedback for Etest.
- 5. BOSS Show Mgmt checks scoring, posts score on Live FB Scoreboard & Emails Etest to exhibitor.

2020 BOSS Virtual Show Guidelines:

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: BOSS Show Management will review all submissions to ensure adherence to the guidelines as stated below. If a test is submitted that does not comply with these guidelines, BOSS Show Management will contact the exhibitor immediately via email or phone. The exhibitor will have 48 hours to resubmit their test from the time of notification. Please take this guideline into consideration when preparing for your test submission.



Online Show Guidelines Applicable for ALL Exhibitors:

- 1. Use arenas that are as near as possible to regulation size and be sure letters are set appropriately to be viewed by the judge. Cones with large letters on them and poles on the ground to delineate the corners are acceptable. For arena measurements please visit this link, https://westerndressage-arena/
- 2. Videos of tests must be unedited from start to finish, including the equipment, attire, and bit check. They must be one continuous recording with the horse and rider visible at all times.
- 3. Videos **must** be filmed in LANDSCAPE orientation.
- 4. The test must be videoed from C, where the judge would normally be seated.
- 5. After entering the arena, prior to beginning the test, the <u>BOSS Class Video Template</u> which includes <u>DATE</u> filmed must be held up. Remove the sign just before beginning the ride. The videographer can hold the sign then move back to behind the camera or hold the sign in front of the camera at arm's length while also holding the camera.
- 6. No horse may be ridden more than once in any class including Test Of Choice (TOC) or Level of Choice classes.
- 7. Western Dressage Horse / Rider teams will be limited to 3 rides per day per WDAA rule. Please submit all video rides with the BOSS Class Video Template including DATE filmed.
- 8. Classical Dressage Horse entered @ introductory level may enter 6 classes per day. Horses entered @ Training Level or above are limited to 4 rides per day per GLASS-ED ride limits. Please submit all video rides with the <u>BOSS Class Video Template</u> including <u>DATE</u> filmed.
- 9. Keep the horse in frame, paying close attention to the near corners. You may zoom in slightly on the far corners. Videos must be in focus.
- 10. Make sure to keep the letters in the frame that are elements of the test being performed.
- 11. Western Dressage attire & equipment must adhere to <u>USEF Rulebook</u> WD chapter, subchapter WD-5 Appointments for Tack, Illegal Equipment & Attire.
- 12. Classical Dressage attire & equipment must adhere to 2020 GLASS-ED Rules, Chapter 2, section 2.2
- 13. As soon as the test is finished, the camera must <u>slowly</u> circle the horse and rider showing all equipment and attire, including spurs and whip if used. If the videographer is unable to enter the arena, at G the rider may turn the horse slowly, wait five seconds, then turn slowly to show the second side, and wait an additional 5 seconds to complete filming of the equipment.
- 14. Following equipment check, the rider will dismount and drop the bit so it can be evaluated. Before dropping the bit, present the bridle so as not to obscure the curb strap or curb chain. Demonstrate that the curb strap or chain is flexible, ½ inch wide, and that two fingers can fit between the bosal or cavesson and the horse's cheek. Make sure the judge can see all parts of the bridle, including bit and reins clearly. Bosals must also be shown as flexible.
- 15. Exceptional riders are exempt from the dropping the bit requirement.
- 16. Coaching during the test is not allowed EXCEPT for WDAA Exceptional Rider Coached tests (BOSS WDAA Class #87 & 90).
- 17. The natural background sound for the test must be audible. Tests with no sound at all will not be accepted
- 18. The test may be called.
- 19. Bridle or saddle pad numbers are not allowed.
- 20. Tying a horse's tongue down is not allowed
- 21. Fly masks are not allowed. Ear nets ARE allowed.
