“Under the CDPH Order, masks remain required for unvaccinated individuals in indoor public settings and businesses...” “Fully vaccinated individuals are recommended to continue indoor masking when the risk may be high. Surgical masks or high-level respirators (e.g. N95, KN95, KF94) with a good fit are highly recommended.” ... “There are currently no local Health Orders for Sacramento County.”
- 2) All persons entering competition grounds are required to self-monitor their temperature once daily prior to entering the competition grounds. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4° F (38° C) or higher may not enter the facility.
- 3) The following individuals are not allowed to enter the competition grounds:
 - a) Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, including a temperature of 100.4° F (38° C) or higher,
 - b) Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within last 10 days,
 - c) Anyone who has tested positive outside of the past 10 days, but is still symptomatic, or
 - d) Anyone* who has been exposed to or has been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19 within either the last 7 or 10 days (dependent upon certain criteria - refer to CDC Quarantine Options).

**Exception: Healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical-grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties and those individuals who are fully vaccinated are exempted from this quarantine restriction.*
- 4) Anyone who is not fully vaccinated must exercise personal responsibility and wear a face covering/mask wearing and continue to practice social distancing and frequent hand washing.
- 5) Any individual on competition grounds who tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the conclusion of the competition, is required to report such result to the Competition Organizer.
- 6) Face masks/coverings: In accordance with Sacramento County, California and California state requirements, face covering/masks are not required for fully vaccinated persons. Any Individual may choose to wear a face covering/mask although not required, and can do so without penalty.

This competition will be run in accordance with USEF's & CDFA's biosecurity recommendations due to recent EHV-1 and EHM cases in California.

- 1) USEF states, "In an effort to mitigate the risk of further spread of EHV-1, the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) has issued an Extension of Recommended Caution for California Equine Events. The California State Veterinarian recommends that all equine events of any discipline continue to be postponed through March 31, and all non-essential horse movements also be postponed at least through March 31."
- 2) USEF has implemented a return-to-competition protocol that applies to any horse that has been on the Desert International Horse Park (DIHP) or Rancho Murieta showgrounds, or any horse that has been exposed to a horse confirmed positive for EHV-1 off competition grounds in the past 14 days. This will allow the horse to be released from the EHV-1 Ineligibility List. **Only horses entered in the show are allowed on-site during the show.**
- 3) Healthy Horse Policy: Upon arrival at the show grounds, the owner/agent shall sign a health certification statement attesting that the entered horse(s) arriving at the venue has/have been healthy with no clinical signs of a contagious disease or body temperature(s) above 102°F for the preceding seven (7) days. If these statements are untrue, then the exhibitor shall leave the horse home and will receive a refund of all entries and fees except for the Office Fee.
- 4) Owner/Agent must certify that their entered horse(s) has/have not been on a premises with a confirmed case of neurologic form of EHV-1 in the preceding twenty-one (21) days. If the horse(s) were exposed as described, then the exhibitor shall leave the horse(s) home and will receive a refund of all entries and fees except for the Office Fee.
- 5) No Fever Policy: **Exhibitors shall check each horse's temperature at least once per day while on the show grounds.** Exhibitors, Owners, Trainers and anyone attending this event shall immediately report any suspicion of illness in horses, including a temperature over 102°F to the Show Secretary or Manager. The Secretary or Manager will then report as soon as possible to the show committee or Manager as appropriate for further action, including but not limited to calling the on-call veterinarian for consultation at the horse owner's expense or sending the horse home.
- 6) Exhibitors shall take all appropriate measures to limit horse-to-horse contact during this event. For multi-horse classes such as Hunter Under Saddle and Sport Horse Under Saddle, exhibitors shall keep at least 1 horse-length distance among horses during the class and shall line-up at least eight feet (8') feet apart.
- 7) Cleaning and Disinfection Protocol: Brookside Equestrian Center will disinfect all surfaces in every stall prior to the start of this event. *Please note: due to dirt floors and porous wooden stall walls, disinfection cannot eliminate risk of exposure to pathogens.*
- 8) Exhibitors shall limit access for Human-to-Horse and Horse-to-Horse contact as much as possible.
- 9) Exhibitors shall provide alcohol wipes or alcohol hand sanitizer products at their stall(s) or trailer(s) for use by people handling multiple horses to maximize biosecurity between horses.

Registration Papers Required: A copy of the front of the current registration papers (plus the back for old style registration papers) showing proof of ownership MUST be submitted with the entry form and will be returned in your show packet. Arabian horses must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (CAHR). Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian horses must have been issued a certificate of registration from the AHA's Half-Arabian (HA) or Anglo-Arabian (AA) Registry or have been issued an AHA CPAR (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registry) Permit.

Post Entries:

For the Pre-Show: Post entries will NOT be accepted for Dressage or Western Dressage. Entries for all other classes postmarked after May 16th will be accepted with a post entry fee of \$10.00 per class.

For the Region III and off-site Pacific Slope Arabian Sport Horse Championships: Post entries will NOT be accepted for Dressage or Western Dressage. Between May 17 – June 16, post entries will be accepted with a penalty of double the entry for all other classes. No new horses or new class entries for horses already entered will be accepted for entry to the Region III or off-site Pacific Slope Championship after **noon on Friday, June 17, 2022.**

FEES AND PRIZES:

AHA Results fee: \$8 per horse entered for AHA show results reporting. Note: separate fees apply to the pre-show, Region III and Pacific Slopes Championships as these are three (3) shows for AHA purposes.

AHA Resolution 9-90 Fee: \$10 per horse entered in the Pre-show, \$20 per horse entered in the Region III Arabian Sport Horse Championship Show and \$20 per horse entered in the Pacific Slopes Championship Show (1 to 3 fees per horse). These mandatory fees are designated for AHA's judges & stewards education programs. Note: separate fees apply to the pre-show, Region III and Pacific Slopes Championships as these are three (3) shows for AHA purposes.

USEF Show Pass Fee: USEF non-members may enter the Pre-Show with payment of the USEF Show Pass fee of \$45.00. Note: one fee applies to the pre-show, Region III and Pacific Slopes Championships as this is one show for USEF purposes.

USEF Drugs / Medications Fee: \$23 per horse to USEF (\$15 to Drugs and Medications, \$8 to USEF), plus \$8 to the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA). Note: one fee applies to the pre-show, Region III and Pacific Slopes Championships as this is one show for USEF purposes. (see Article GR407.1, 2. & 3). Horses at a recognized competition are subject to examination which may include physical, urine, blood, or any other test or procedure at the discretion of the official drug-testing agent. No horse may be shown at an USEF recognized competition if it has been administered any forbidden substance in any manner except as provided in USEF Article GR410-412. Exhibitors shall file a Medication Report Form with the Show Steward or Designated Show Office Representative within one hour after administration or one hour after the Steward or Designated Show Office Representative returns to duty if administration is at a time other than during competition hours.

Western Dressage Association of America (WDAA) Show Pass Fee: WDAA non-members may enter the show with payment of a non-member show pass fee (\$35 for adults and \$25 for juniors) and complete a Show Pass Form.

California Dressage Society (CDS) Competition Grant Fee: \$3 per horse entered in Dressage (not including western dressage) for the CDS Competition Grant Travel Fund. Note: one fee applies to the pre-show and Region III Championships as this is one show for CDS purposes.

Refunds: Horses may be scratched from the show at the owner's option. Requests for refund of entry fees will be considered for any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a veterinarian's certificate accompanied with a letter explaining the circumstances to the Show Secretary PRIOR to the start of show. For approved refund requests, ONLY class fees will be refunded with 25% of class fees retained for processing. No refunds will be made for USEF, AHA, CDFA, CDS or office fees. No refunds will be made for stall or tack room fees requested after the closing date of June 17th. Approved refunds will be mailed approximately two weeks after the show ends. In the event of a cancellation due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds will be provided within 30 days of the cancellation upon request of the exhibitor.

Region III & Pacific Slope Championship Awards: Top Five Awards will be made regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse, Achievement Award, High Point Amateur Achievement Award and Distance Award Points.

ASSOCIATIONS, RULES AND REFERENCES:

Association Memberships: Owner, rider/driver/handler, coach and trainer of each horse must be a current member in good standing with the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) and the USEF to enter. Exhibitors in dressage classes must also be members of the United States Dressage Federation (USDF) and CDS). Exhibitors in Western Dressage must be members of the WDAA. To be eligible to participate and/or compete as an exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer in any Western Dressage class at any Federation-Licensed Western Dressage Competition, persons must be active

members of WDAA or pay a non-member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition.

Exceptions: AHA non-members may enter the pre-show with payment of an AHA Single Event Membership fee. USEF non-members may enter the show with payment of the USEF Show Pass fee. WDAA non-members may enter the show with payment of a non-member show pass fee (\$35 for adults and \$25 for juniors) and complete a Show Pass Form.

Exhibitors are responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (AHA, USEF, USDF, CDS, WDAA) for each horse, owner, rider/driver/handler, coach and trainer (or custodian), before the competition along with their entries. Scores and points earned by competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward National awards. Dressage owners/exhibitors are not required to be members of USDF to show at this show. Note: CDS members are automatically enrolled as members of USDF. Owners and riders who are USDF members must list their membership numbers on the entry form.

AHA Membership Statement: Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner, and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an AHA Recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership / competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership Fee per competitor.

When an Agent signs for the owner at an AHA Recognized Competition, both the owner and Agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership.

Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Walk-Trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or Parents / Guardians signing for Minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12)

USEF Membership Statement: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF Safe Sport Statement: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S.

Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

USEF Membership Requirements: Copies of every owner's, trainer's, rider's, driver's, and In-Hand handler's current USEF Membership Cards **MUST** be included with the horse show entry form at the time of entry. A non-member, who wishes to participate as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longer, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions must pay a Show Pass fee for each competition competing. Lessees are considered owners in connection with this membership requirement. In the event of multiple ownership of a horse, only one owner need be a Member or pay a Show Pass fee. The amount of the Show Pass fee will be established by the Federation. Unless otherwise established, the fee will be \$45 and must be collected by all appropriate competitions and remitted to the Federation. If you do not have a copy of your current USEF membership card, you will have to pay the \$45 non-refundable, non-member fee. If you are **NOT** a member of USEF, you **MUST** pay the appropriate non-member fee of \$45. Affidavits are no longer available. USEF Membership for an adult is \$80 (with or without amateur certification). USEF Membership for a junior is \$80.

Scratching or Cancelling Classes: As a courtesy to Exhibitors and Management, please notify the Gate person and show office when it is necessary to scratch or cancel a class. Your consideration will be greatly appreciated and will enable the Show to run more efficiently.

GROUND INFORMATION:

Arenas: There is sand footing in all arenas and warm-up rings. Ring dimensions are as follows: Main Arena – 275' x 150', Arena #2 – 240' x 150', and Grand Prix Arena – 150' x 240'. The warm-up arenas are 200' x 150'.

Stabling: Stalls will be available starting Tuesday June 15 at 8 AM. Stall Fees are a “one time” fee for all 3 shows (Region III Sport Horse pre-show, off-site Pacific Slope & off-site Region III Sport Horse Championships), Wednesday June 16 through Sunday June 20. There will be an **additional daily fee** of \$10 per stall for any exceptions to the dates and times listed. **Stall assignments will be made on a first come, first served basis, with Patrons and Sponsors having first priority.** If you want to be stabled together with other competitors, make a note on your entry forms. If you have any special requests or considerations, please submit them with your entry for consideration. Horses must be placed in the assigned stalls. No changes will be permitted without express consent of the Barn Manager. Management will try to stable late entries as close as possible to other entries, but no guarantees can be made. Show Management's decision is final.

Trash cans will be placed at convenient locations to ALL barns. Please deposit refuse directly into the trash cans only. Exhibitors are asked to clean stalls daily, to sweep/rake the aisles, and to minimize hosing. Your help will be greatly appreciated.

Stalls – Permanent barns are wooden. Portable barns are canvas with double stall doors and have canvas roofs. Stalls are lighted and water is close to each barn.

Wash Racks – Concrete wash racks are located in several locations close to stable areas.

*****IMPORTANT – Exhibitors may be charged for any damage to the stalls or other facilities. Absolutely NO nails are allowed in permanent stalls or stall doors. Do not use contact cement or any other permanent adhesive to attach stall signs or drapes to the barns. Do not tie horses to water pipes or electrical conduit. Any exhibitor found in violation will be charged for repairs.***

Shavings: No bedding is provided. Exhibitors may pre-order shavings & hay for the show from Brookside Show Park, (916) 682-1403.

Sharps Containers – Competition management will place a minimum of one sharps container on the grounds. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments will be placed in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. Competition management is responsible for replacing such containers when full and disposing of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. (USEF GR1210.4).

Showing from Trailers: Exhibitors may show from their trailers and must park in designated parking areas. There will be a **Trailer-In Fee of \$30 per Horse** for the show. Every horse entered in this show must pay either a stall fee or trailer-in fee.

Dogs: Dogs are permitted on a leash only (or otherwise contained) on the competition grounds and must not be allowed to run loose. Dog owners are required to clean up after their dog. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty. (USEF Rulebook GR1301.6). Riders must not lead dogs while mounted. Owners of dogs left unattended in the barn area, RV parking area, parking lot, etc., that bark and/or disturb other exhibitors or guests will be requested to remove their dog from the Show grounds. This rule will be strictly enforced.

Trailer and Living Quarter Reservations: Limited Trailer and Living Quarter hook-ups (15 amps) are available by reservation only. Trailer and Living Quarter spaces must be reserved. Any rig plugged into an electrical hook-up will be considered a Trailer and Living Quarter. There is a flat fee of \$150 for the entire show. Please bring your own generator just in case it is needed. PLEASE NOTE: Brookside Show Park is in charge of all Trailer and Living Quarter reservations, collection of payment and placement of Trailer and Living Quarters. Please call (916) 682-1403 to make your reservations now.

Vendors: Commercial Exhibitor Vendors are welcome! All commercial vendors **must** make reservations with Brookside Show Park, (916) 682-1403. Vendors are required to provide a certificate of liability insurance.

Veterinarian: A veterinarian will be on-call during the shows (Pre-Show, off-site Pacific Slope Arabian Sport Horse Championship, and Region III Arabian Sport Horse Championship). Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring, a communicable disease. No veterinarian other than the official show veterinarian will be permitted to treat, medicate, or attend to a horse on the grounds. Anyone wishing to use another veterinarian other than the official Show Veterinarian on the show grounds must obtain permission from Show Management.

Farrier: A farrier will be on-call.

USEF Motorized Vehicle Statement: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the

child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

CLASS INFORMATION:

Sport Horse in Hand: Horses will be judged on the triangle in an open stance. Refer to USEF Chapter AR-12, SUBCHAPTER AR-16 SPORT HORSE SECTION, AR175 Sport Horse In-hand Classes for further details. Classes will be run with a "semi-open" card, with order-of-go assigned at the gate according to the gate manager's preference, generally in order of check-in at the gate. Approximate show times will be assigned to each horse showing Sport Horse In-Hand. Decimals may be used in scoring. HORSE MUST BE AT LEAST ONE YEAR OF AGE TO BE NAMED CHAMPION OR RESERVE CHAMPION (AR175) The AHA Individual Sport Horse Score Sheet shall be used. Tied scores shall be broken first by referring to the totals of the movement scores. If still tied, the tie may be broken at the judge's discretion, by the use of decimals, or the horses may be examined again (movement only). Pre-show Champion and Reserve will be awarded based upon score sheets from the qualifying classes, and horses will not show again to compete for Champion. Supreme Champion for Region III will be selected based upon the Champion score sheets from their qualifying classes, and horses will not be shown again.

Get of Sire & Produce of Dam Classes: Refer to USEF Chapter AR-12, SUBCHAPTER AR-16 SPORT HORSE SECTION, AR181 Sport Horse Class Specifications (#2 GROUP CLASSES) for further details. Horses will be judged at the walk and trot, but not necessarily on the triangle. Each horse shall stand for conformation judging before and/or after completion of the group's movement. **Sires & Dams will not be shown in the class and do not need to be present on the show grounds.** Emphasis shall be placed upon reproductive likeness, uniformity, quality of breed characteristics, conformation & similarity. See USEF Rulebook AR119 and AR181 (group classes). The AHA Score Sheet is divided as follows:

- *Movement – 40% (20% for walk and 20% for trot).*
- *Conformation – 40%*
- *Quality and Uniformity of Quality (Reproductive likeness) – 10%.*
- *Overall Quality, Balance, Harmony (Apparent ability of sire or dam to produce or beget Sport Horse performance or breeding stock) – 10%.*

Note: The breed of the sire or dam apply to the correct class for entry (versus the breed of the shown offspring). Minimum of two (2) purebred Arabian, Half-Arabian and/or Anglo-Arabian (A/HA/AA) offspring of the purebred Arabian parent may enter class 415 and/or 416. Minimum of two (2) HA/AA offspring may enter class 433 and/or 434.

Non-Sanctioned classes: Local classes are offered by the Region III Arabian Sport Horse Pre-Show which are not sanctioned or governed by AHA, including Shagya breed dressage, SHIH, SHUS and show shack classes. All of these classes will be governed by the rules of USEF and USDF, CDS, or WDAA, as appropriate.

Western Dressage Tests and Information: Western Dressage classes are qualifying classes for California Western Dressage High point year-end awards. For rules & FAQ, go to <https://www.usef.org/compete/disciplines/western-dressage>

For Western Dressage Tests (2022 tests are in effect): <https://www.westerndressageassociation.org/wdaatests>

Dressage Classes: Competitors in Regional Dressage Championship Classes (Region III) will show only ONE ride at the highest test of the USEF/FEI level. The Top Five will be selected using scores, with ties broken in accordance with USEF and USDF rules. The horse with the highest score shall be named Champion and the horse with the second highest score shall be named Reserve Champion. The remaining Top Five shall be named in a random, undesignated order. In case of a tie, the judge shall determine the winner. A caller, if supplied by the competitor, may be used for Introductory Level through Fourth Level in an AHA Regional Dressage Championship class. **Whips are prohibited in Region III Championship dressage classes.** One whip no longer than 47.2 inches (120 cm), including lash, may be carried in all classes where whips are allowed. No horse may compete in more than two consecutive levels, with the exception of the USDF Introductory Level – 10 & Under class.

Dressage Equipment, Dress & Helmet Requirements: Only saddlery and equipment listed in USEF Article DR 21 will be allowed when warming up or schooling for Dressage. Dressage competitors must wear their entry number at all times on the show grounds when warming up or schooling for dressage.

The dress code for all Dressage tests and classes through Fourth Level changed extensively with revised requirements beginning in 2022. Please see DR 120 (Dress).

Management may announce prior to or during the competition that competitors may show without jackets when extreme heat and/or humidity is forecasted. If this occurs, then Competitors must wear protective headgear and shirt with sleeves and collar, without neckwear. T-shirts are not permitted. (DR 120 2.1)

Protective headgear for Riders in Dressage and Hunter/Jumper classes: Protective headgear MUST be worn by anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, as defined by DR 120, AR 111.2 and otherwise in compliance with GR 801 (Dress). Any rider violating this rule at any time shall immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted.

Ride Times: Dressage and Western Dressage ride times will be available from Dressage Manager, Annette Wells, via phone (530-409-0701), email serserr@aol.com and/or website www.ArabianHorses3.org by Wednesday, June 15th. Notification of ride times will be made by email and final ride times will be posted at the show office. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the Dressage Manager if times are not received. Failure to enter the ring by the specified time will incur elimination. It is the rider's responsibility to verify ride times on the day of the class to ensure they have not changed, as classes may not follow the schedule in the Prize List.

Tests and Scores: Current tests approved by USEF will be used or scored classes. For national level dressage (intro, freestyle, and Tr – 4th level, 2019): <http://www.usdf.org/downloads/forms/index.asp?TypePass=Tests>

Test sheets will be available at the show office after completion of scoring for each class. Exhibitors are encouraged to double-check their scores in all scored classes. If an error is discovered on a score sheet, it must be brought to the attention of the show management within one hour after the official posting of scores from the last class of that show day.

Hunters & Jumpers:

Championship Classes: Hunters must show in one (1) under-saddle and at least one (1) over-fences rounds to be eligible to compete for Hunter Championships offered at Sport Horse Regional Pre-Show, Region III and Pacific Slope.

USEF Measurement: Per USEF Rule GR502 and GR503, entrants in the 14.2 hand and under classes are required by USEF to have a measurement card and Management is required to check for measurement cards when processing entries. Management will not provide an exhibitor number to an animal entered on the entry blank in any 14.2 hands and under classes unless a measurement card is submitted with the entry or at the show office prior to the start of the class. Management is not required to provide this service, but is offering it as a courtesy to our exhibitors. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to present the animal at the appointed time or make other arrangements with the steward and judge. Therefore, if you need to have your horse measured, **PLEASE ADVISE MANAGEMENT PRIOR TO THE SHOW.** If needed, Management will arrange to have the steward and a judge available on **Thursday, June 16th, between 7:30 - 8:45 am**, to provide the service of measuring your horse.

Scoring & Points for Sport Horse Regional Pre-Show Hunter Classes: See USEF Rulebook AR149. 1st Place, 10 Points; 2nd Place, 6 Points; 3rd Place 4 Points; 4th Place, 2 Points; 5th Place, 1 Point; 6th Place, 1/2 Point.

Scoring & Points for Region III & Pacific Slope Arabian Sport Horse Championship Hunter Classes: See USEF Rulebook AR149. 1st Place, 20 Points; 2nd Place, 16 Points; 3rd Place 14 Points; 4th Place, 12 Points; 5th Place, 10 Point; 6th Place, 8 Points; 7th Place, 6 Points; 8th Place, 5 Points; 9th Place, 4 Points; 10th Place, 3 Points.

Carriage Pleasure Driving: For rules pertaining to Arabian Carriage Pleasure Driving, please refer to USEF Rulebook, Arabian Division Chapter AR-14, and to Chapter CP, Carriage Pleasure Driving. Classes are open to Arabian, Half-Arabian, or Anglo-Arabian unless otherwise specified in the class title.

CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATIONS: New AHA Participation Qualifications are in effect for the 2022 Region III and Pacific Slope Championship Shows. The Qualification period is the previous year (2021) plus the current year up to the close of entries. The Region III pre-show is a qualifying show for Region III and Pacific Slopes Championships. Post entries to Region III and Pacific Slope Championship Shows for horses qualifying at the pre-show will be accepted with post entry penalties until noon on Friday, June 17, 2022.

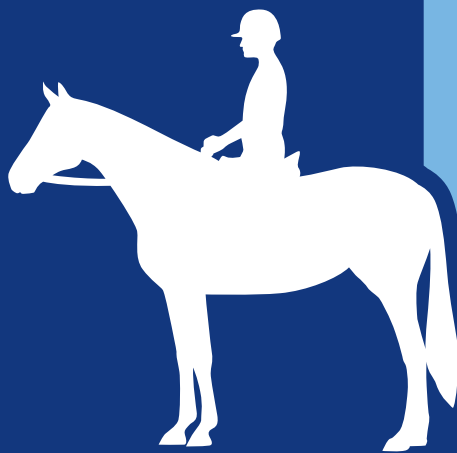

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of individual members and over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.
