Entry Information & Stall Deposits

Entry, chaperone, and coaches' forms will be completed online. All mounted competitors must send a \$50 stall deposit check, directly to the USPC National Office, which will be destroyed following verification of their stall being stripped. Any competitor who does not strip their stall will lose their stall deposit. Checks to be made out to USPC with the name of the competitor on the memo line and mailed to USPC, 4041 Iron Works Parkway, Lexington, KY 40511.

Team Configuration

Teams consist of three to four riders and a stable manager.

Teams including competitors below the age of 18 - require a non-riding stable manager.

Senior teams with members all above the age of 18 – a non-riding stable manager is highly encouraged.

Regions are encouraged to send additional individuals or partial teams to place on scramble teams. Any teams entered with four riders and no stable manager may be split up.

Competition Minimum Requirements

All Levels: Competitions must have occurred on or after July 5, 2021.

Standard Divisions

Complete a standard Western Dressage rally. Complete Test 3, 4 and musical ride at the competition level. Earn a minimum score of 60% on Test 4.

Modified Divisions

Participate in a standard or modified Western Dressage rally and earn a minimum score of 55% on Test 3 at the competition level.
