The Region 4 Sport Horse Show Committee is pleased to present the Region 4 Sport Horse Prospect Purse Jackpot, an exciting opportunity for handlers to win money while showcasing the most athletic young fillies, geldings, and colts at the Region 4 Sport Horse Championship Show. The Sport Horse Prospect Purse Jackpot is are split into two sport horse in hand jackpot classes for horses age two and under and divided by Purebred and Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian entries. Jackpot money will be divided up among the Top 5 winners in each class and consist of each class's jackpot enrollment fees, in addition to money provided by jackpot sponsors.

GENERAL RULES

- > Current AHA Membership with Competition Card is required for participation.
- > All entries must be Purebred or Half Arabian/ Anglo Arabians registered with AHA or CAHR.
- The jackpot classes will be a combination of yearling and two-year-old fillies, geldings, and colts and will not be split except for by Purebred and Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian registration status.
- Entries will be scored in hand on the triangle and adhere to the sport horse in hand class procedure as outlined in ARABIAN SPORT HORSE SUBCHAPTER AR-17 of the USEF Rulebook.
- Jackpot payout divided: 5 or more entries: champion 35%, reserve 25%, third/ fourth 15%, fifth 10%. 4 entries: champion 40%, reserve 30%, remaining entries 15%. 3 entries: champion 50%, reserve 35%, remaining entry 15%. 2 entries: champion
- ➢ 60%, reserve 40%. 1 entry: champion 100%.
- > Winners will be mailed a check within ten days of the completion of the show. Ribbons will be handed out at the show.
- > No refunds of jackpot enrollment fees will be issued.

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Entry Information

Online entries are accepted via Gaitkeeper at <u>www.gaitkeeper.com</u>. There is no fee to use this service – help us provide you a better competitor experience by entering online. **THIS IS THE PREFERRED METHOD OF ENTRY.** Entering online helps us ensure the accuracy of your entry and personal information. Competitors are responsible to provide valid membership numbers on the entry form for all horse, owner, rider, and trainer names listed on the entry form. **AHA, USEF and USDF membership is verified electronically** (no copies of cards, registration papers, etc. needed) if valid membership numbers are provided on the entry form. You may be asked to provide copies of your membership documents if your memberships cannot be verified for any reason. **Please verify USEF and USDF horse registration when you check in.** The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

To enter by e-mail/ground mail, call secretary for entry form. Copies of the horse's registration certificate and all current membership cards must be enclosed with the emailed/paper entry and date stamped, postmarked or hand delivered to the show secretary beginning June 1st and <u>DELIVERED</u> <u>NO LATER THAN JULY 5th</u>. No entries will be taken over the phone or by fax, and <u>no entries accepted without payment</u>. Entry Confirmation will be sent via email to the legible email address on your entry form. Please review it as soon as it arrives to avoid delays in the show office when you arrive at the show.

All fees must be paid in US Dollars. Region 4 AHA accepts checks and Credit Cards. Region 4 does not do PayPal or Venmo. <u>Do not send cash</u> with mailed entries. Fees must accompany the entry form for each show entered. Entries not accompanied by fees will be considered late and not entered until fees are received including any late or post entry fees. In fairness to all exhibitors, open checks are not allowed for the initial entry. If an open check is sent, it will be closed for the amount due at the time the entry is processed and will be deposited.

Cancelled Classes: Classes with no entries by closing date may be cancelled. If an entire division has no entries – for example, if there are no FEI-level Dressage entries in the pre-show – expect that that judge will be released from her contract and those classes will not be available for late entry.

Late Entries: Late entries will be accepted after the closing date if space is available, upon payment of an additional late entry fee.

Payments Full payment is required for the balance of the entry for an entry to be processed. Region 4 AHA accepts checks and Credit Cards. Region 4 AHA does not do PayPal or Venmo. Do not send cash with mailed entries. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Submission of entry to us is your intent to show and acceptance of our show policies. <u>Check should be made payable to "Region 4 AHA"</u>. All payments will be deposited immediately after closing date and thereafter upon receipt. Foreign competitors checks must indicate payment in USD.

Post Entries: Previously entered horses may fill scratches and added classes up to the start of competition, if scheduling permits. No late entry fee will be required but will be required to pay a post entry fee in addition to the normal class fee.


Policy for Accepting Post Entries and Filling Scratches in classes: Must be eligible for class. Must have previously entered in competition as a competing or non-competing horse. Must register with secretary and put name on wait list.

Scratched Classes. After the close of entries, horses may be scratched from one or more classes at the owner's option. No fees will be refunded. Please scratch horses with the Show Secretary. If you don't show up for an assigned ride time, this Competition reserves the right to scratch you from all remaining dressage rides and offer them to other exhibitors.

Wait-listed Entries. Entries received after closing date are not guaranteed accommodation. For that matter, neither are entries received before closing date, if all times are filled. Enter early! Every effort is being made to accommodate all those who want to participate, but since there are a limited number of slots for Dressage, Western Dressage and Sport Horse In-Hand, those classes may fill before the closing date. If that happens, entries will be placed on a waiting list in order received, priority to on-line entries over e-mailed or ground mailed.

ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (AHA, USDF and USEF) for horse, owner, riders, handlers, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

Areas which are off limits. The main barn is a full service boarding stable. Please respect their privacy. Please stay on bridle paths and out of outdoor arenas. Please respect "Arena Closed" signs. The area set aside for hand-grazing is under the announcer's tower.

Arenas & Footing. Schooling hours will be posted at show office and published with ride times.

All arenas, lunge rings and bridle paths close at 8:30PM

- Six outdoor arenas, three competition and three warm-ups; two indoor arenas, one competition and one warm-up.
- Indoor Arena and Indoor warm-up are Equi-Base[™] Arenas (Sand and Geotek Fabric over rubber matting).
- Memorial: Risohorse [®] Ebb & Flow Surface by Dammann (Hydro-Active Sand Arena)
- Sylvan: Equi-Base (Sand and Geotek Fabric over rubber matting)
- Terrace: Risohorse[®] Ebb & Flow Surface by Dammann (Hydro-Active Sand Arena)
- Footpaths are packed and leveled 1/4" Minus Crushed Gravel

Children & Pets. Absolutely **NO DOGS ALLOWED** on show grounds, except <u>Medical Assistance Animals/Service Dogs</u>, as permitted by law. Children must be supervised at all times. Emotional support animals (ESA) are not permitted. If you choose to bring a non-equine to the show, it must remain outside the Main Gates at all times. For your animals' safety, please leave them at home. Do not leave them in the car or trailer as temperatures can quickly become dangerous to their health.

Food. Due to current state and county regulations, Food may <u>not</u> be readily available on the show grounds. there will be limited concessions available on-site. There are a variety of restaurants within a ten-minute drive.

Feed & hay are available from local retailers. They will not be available on the grounds.

Lungeing. Brand new footing in the lunge pen by lower stabling! Two of the white round pens outside the upper guest barn will be reserved for our lungeing. No free lungeing or turn-out in lunge pens. No lungeing is permitted anywhere else on the grounds.

RV Parking/Camping. A limited number of RV parking spaces with electrical hookups are available for purchase; spaces will not be assigned. Entire rig must fit within space, both length and width, to ensure clear fire lane. Tents, trailers and tow vehicles may park outside the main facility gates at no fee. Electrical service is available at the end of each stall row as a courtesy on a first come, first served basis as available. RVs and horse trailers with Premium RV/Trailer permits are welcome to hook-up/run an extension cord from 7PM to 7AM daily. Extension cords must be unplugged and stowed during competition hours. Please, out of courtesy to your neighbors, only quiet generators. One plug-in per outlet, splitters and piggy-backing/daisy-chaining is strictly forbidden. You'll blow out the electrical system and we will all be mad! No water hookups.

Security. Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure valuables and their stall areas. DWEC, Region 4, AHA, its members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

Sharps Containers for medical waste (needles, syringes, etc.) are mounted in the barn aisles. A \$100 fine per violation will be passed on to the violator for medical waste found in your area or if you are found disposing of materials improperly.

Smoking (including vaping) prohibited everywhere on the grounds. DevonWood is a 100% smoke- and vape-free facility. If you smoke or vape, please do it inside your vehicle, outside the main gates.

Stabling. For horses' and exhibitors' safety, (1) each horse brought onto the grounds must have an assigned stall, and (2) aisles must be kept clear — no tents, canopies, etc. in aisles regardless of aisle ownership or permission from competitors. All stalls are box stalls with full fastening doors. Stall fee includes 1 bag of shavings; no bedding in tack stalls. Additional shavings available for purchase. Straw and other bedding materials prohibited. Stalls may not be resold/sublet. Shavings may not be brought in from outside sources. Violators will be fined.

Stabling fees listed are for THURSDAY NOON through Sunday evening. If you arrive early without making prior arrangements, the gate will be locked and admission denied. Early arrivals are accepted on a case-by-case basis and must be approved by and contracted with DevonWood Equestrian Centre, LLC. Please contact Lisa Kolke via e-mail: horseshownumber@gmail.com for details.

Vaccinations/Coggins: USEF Vaccination Rule (GR844). Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Noncompliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the Vaccination Record is missing or incomplete. Whether the horse is vaccinated by a veterinarian or by an owner or agent, or is exempt for medical or age reasons, documentation is required; see USEF GR844 for details. Download report form from USEF and bring completed, signed document(s) to the competition with the horse. Download the form from https://www.usef.org/documents/membership/EquineVaccinationRecord.pdf

Out-of-State Horses. The regulations do change periodically. Oregon Department of Agriculture, (503) 986-4680, has the most recent information. The person who has care and custody of the horse is responsible for being aware of, and complying with, the regulations when taking animal(s) into another state. Your veterinarian can help with this process.

Directions. From I-5 south from Portland/north from Salem to Sherwood/Tualatin exit, #289. West on Nyberg Road (Nyberg Road becomes Tualatin/Sherwood Hwy) and go five miles to Hwy 99W. Turn south and go three miles to 25033 SW Pacific Hwy, on your right just past Brookman/Chapman Rd. Gate code will be shared via confirmation e-mail and posted at main gate on day of arrival.

Coming from the south? To avoid traffic in Tualatin/Sherwood and if your rig is not too long to make a U-turn, you may prefer to: Take Aurora/Donald exit #278. West on Ehlen/McKay Rd. 6.5 miles to end. Right (north) on Hwy 219 3.4 mi to first traffic signal. Right on Springbrook 1 mi to Hwy 99E. Right on Hwy 99E. After approx. 4 miles, just past railroad trestle, see DevonWood entrance on left. This is a four-lane divided highway; make a U-turn at Brookman/Chapman Rd (unprotected turn) or continue north .75 mi to Sunset Blvd (traffic signal, protected U-turn).

A Word about Horse Health

With the safety and welfare of our horses the absolute primary importance, the management of the Region 4 Championship Show will now be requiring the following documents to be presented prior to accessing your stabling at the DevonWood Equestrian Centre:

- 1. Master Check-In Sheet (list all horses in your trailer)
- 2. USEF EHV-1 Declaration Form
- 3. Vaccination Records. Supply your own or use the USEF Form
- 4. Health Certificate for out of state horses
- 5. Negative Coggins Report for out of state horses

IMPORTANT **** These documents <u>will be</u> collected prior to the off-loading of your horses. Do NOT SEND them ahead of time. All paperwork travels <u>with the horse</u>. We understand and appreciate your time spent on this. Thank you for helping us protect our horses and industry. If you have questions, please call Lisa Kolke.

No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because Vaccination Documentation is missing. **We encourage** you to begin using the Temperature Chart 7 days before departure and throughout the show. It has proven to be the MOST effective warning system!

USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN AMATEUR RESTRICTED CLASSES ACTIVE Equine Canada members who are not current USEF members and want to compete in an amateur class are not required to pay for a USEF membership or Show Pass fee; however, they must fill out the USEF membership application with their name, signature, date of birth and check the "Amateur" box in order to be eligible to compete in an amateur restricted class.

ANYONE ELSE COMPETING IN AN AMATEUR CLASS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW PROOF OF AMATEUR STATUS ISSUED

BY USEF. Only active Federation members [Competition memberships] may obtain amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 19th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation Arabian rules must possess current amateur status issued by the Federation. Exceptions• Any person who has not reached his/her 19th birthday as of December 1 of the previous calendar year is a Junior Exhibitor; all Junior Exhibitors are considered amateurs for competition purposes. Proof of amateur status is not required for Opportunity classes. (GR1307.1 and AR 110.6)

REMINDER: US EQUESTRIAN SAFE SPORT –All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes (*downloaded* 5/8/2023)

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership /Competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership Fee per competitor. When an Agent signs for the Owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the Owner and Agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions. Exhibitors in walk-trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions but must have an AHA membership with Competition Card at AHA Regional and National Competitions. Exhibitors in leadline classes or parents/ guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements.



AHA Competition Card Requirements. Current COMPETITION CARDS for all concerned must be mailed with entry or entry will be considered incomplete. All riders, drivers, owners, agents and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must show proof of AHA COMPETITION level membership or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$35 per person. If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) and does not have a current AHA Business membership, a Single Event Membership must be purchased for that entity. Exhibitors in Walk/Trot classes and Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership (refer to AHA Article 705).

WDAA MEMBERSHIP



A USEF/WD rule change went into effect December 1, 2021, concerning the requirement for WDAA memberships at USEFlicensed shows offering western dressage classes. The new rule WD102.8 states, "To be eligible to participate and/or compete as **an exhibitor**, **owner**, **lessee**, **agent**, **coach**, **or trainer** in any Western Dressage class or at any Western Dressage Federation Licensed Competition persons **must be active members of WDAA** (<u>westerndressageassociation.org</u>) **or pay a non-member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition**." Lessees are considered owners in connection with this membership requirement. In the event of an entry under multiple ownership, only one owner need be a Member or pay a non-member fee.

This rule change means that breed shows must now verify WDAA memberships for exhibitors, owners, and trainers exhibiting in western dressage classes. If an exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer is not a WDAA member, they have 2 choices:

•Join or renew online at www.westerndressageassociation.org or join through the show by filling out a WDAA membership form completely and submitting payment through the show office \$45 for adults and \$30 for juniors.

•Pay a non-member show pass fee \$45 for adults and \$30 for juniors (junior members are as defined by USEF Rule GR128).

Joining WDAA instead of paying a show pass fee is a better value for you!

Membership

<u>USDF Membership Benefits:</u> USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the USDF Member Guide or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

<u>Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions:</u> Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non- Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the

competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires
 or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular
 Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this
 requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity
 classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM
 identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT

be counted towards Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form and fax or mail it to the USDF office.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day. 02/2022



Rules and General Information

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. EACH PARTICIPANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWLEDGE OF AND IS SUBJECT TO THE USEF RULE BOOK. THE USEF RULE BOOK IS AVAILABLE AT <u>www.usef.org</u>

Rules, Violations and Penalties.

1. Membership, registration and other rule violations will subject the violator to be disqualified.

- 2. All classes are to be conducted in accordance with the rules of AHA. Judging, class specifications, rules and conduct shall be in accordance with the current USEF/EC Rulebook.
- 3. In the event of any rule violation which necessitates a disqualification of any entry, Show Management will make the necessary corrections and submit the results to the AHA office.
- 4. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are deemed final and cannot be protested.

Abbreviations. If the class title does not list the breed, the class is open to Arabian, Half Arabian and Anglo Arabians.

- AATR = Adult Amateur to Ride (19 yrs & over)
- **ATH** = Amateur to Handle (any age, adults & juniors)
- HA/AA = Half-Arabian / Anglo-Arabian JTR = Junior to ride (18 & under)
- ATR = Amateur to Ride (any age, adults & juniors)
- **TOC** = Test of Choice (You pick any one test of the level)

Amateur Status. Adults competing in classes for amateurs must meet the criteria for amateur certification as defined by USEF.

Awards of Trophies and Ribbons • Awards must be picked up and signed for at the awards room. Awards room will be open while classes are in session only. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed.

A full Top Five will be awarded regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payouts, AHA Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Awards, High Point Amateur Achievement Awards and Distance Award points. All Top Five Awards will qualify for the corresponding national championship.

Region 4 Championship Classes: Champion – Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Plaque, Reserve Champion Ribbon. Balance of Top 5 will receive Top 5 plaque and ribbon. ABS Sweepstakes ribbons will be awarded to enrolled horses in ABS Sweepstakes classes.

Region 4 Sport Horse Prospect Purse Classes – Top Ten ribbons to 10th. Champion – Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Plaque, Reserve Champion Ribbon. For purse distribution, refer to the Prospect Program rules on website: <u>https://aharegion4.com/sport-horse</u>.

Call for Classes. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class. The public address system is considered a courtesy to the exhibitors and its function or coverage of areas cannot be guaranteed. No refunds will be made solely because of sound system inadequacy or failure.

Changes of Handler/Rider. Please fill out a handler or rider change form, including signatures, correct association numbers and required documentation, in the show office prior to the start of the class. This will ensure that points are recorded correctly for qualifying purposes.

Delay of Class (more commonly known as a "Gate Hold"). In classes where horses compete collectively, when it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor, such request shall be made to the Paddock Manager or "Lord of the Ring" (gate person) prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request must be stated. The gate hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. In classes where horses compete individually, failure to check in with the Paddock Manager or to enter the competition arena at the assigned time will result in elimination.

Drug and medication rule • Refer to USEF Chapter 4, GR 408-411. The official Medication Report Form is now online at: <u>https://competitions.usef.org/drugs-and-medication-report-form/usef.</u>

Motorized Vehicles: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating such devices for individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Office hours. The show office will be open Thursday from 2-8PM; thereafter from one hour before first class until 30 minutes after the last class of the day for the remainder of the show. Show office phone is (360) 687-2256.

Rules and General Information

Refusal/Removal of Entries. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel entries of any contestant, as stated in USEF Rules. The show commission reserves the right to remove any agent, owner, groom, trainer, manager, coach or handler, horse or rider from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages. The Region 4 AHA Board of Delegates has directed that entries must be refused from anyone who has an outstanding obligation to a Region 4 affiliated club or show. Refunds will not be given to exhibitors evicted for cause.

Scheduling and Ride Times Classes may be split or combined at show management's discretion. Preliminary Schedules for Dressage, Western Dressage and Sport Horse In-Hand will be posted on the Region 4 website. Official in-hand and ride times will be posted in the show office by noon prior to the day of competition. Classes may not necessarily be run in the order listed. Responsibility for obtaining ride times from show management remains with the competitor. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule.

Scheduling Changes. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions. Competition management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion. All changes will be posted on the announcement board in the office and the appropriate announcements made during the competition. Classes with no entries by closing date may be canceled. If entries warrant, additional judges may be hired.

Show Management reserves the right to vary or add officials and refuse any entry for a cause; to disqualify any exhibitor and/or his or her horse for cause; to cause an exhibitor to forfeit his or her ribbons and winnings for cause; to return any entry and/or stall fee before or during the show for cause; all without being liable for damage or compensation. Show management reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary for the safe and efficient conduct of this competition.

Weather/Acts of God/Accidents or Emergency Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to regional group classes; in-hand and dressage. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies.

Scoring Systems. If a mathematical scoring error on the score sheet is discovered, it must be reported to Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last scored class of that competition day or the error will stand with no change in class placings. Please claim all dressage and western dressage test sheets and In-Hand score sheets at the show; they will not be mailed.

I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

- 2. Qualification period is the previous year plus the current year up to the close of entries. (*Placings in 2021 count towards 2022 qualification period if your placing was not recorded, you will need to qualify in 2022 under the participation system*)
- 3. Compete in any qualifying AHA Recognized show in any region (which includes Concurrent, Pre-Show, Value Show).
- 4. Compete in a recognized section, i.e., HA/AA Western Pleasure, Arabian Country English Pleasure, Arabian Hunter Pleasure, etc.
- 5. Compete in any recognized class within that section (Note: for Dressage, each level is considered its own section).
- 6. <u>Any</u> Amateur can qualify the horse to participate in <u>any</u> Amateur or Amateur Owner class. (Owner does not need to qualify on their own)
- 7. Equitation is based on the rider and the rider must participate in their qualifying equitation section.
- 8. Participation in one (1) recognized class in the section now qualifies you to compete in as many classes within that section at any one (1) Regional Championship Show of your choice. (Category 1)
- 9. Participate at two (2) AHA Qualifying Shows and compete at any and as many (1 18) Regional Championships in that section. (Category 1)
- 10. It is the responsibility of the person(s) signing the Official Entry Form to verify that the horse is eligible to be entered and compete in the Regional Championship Class. Exhibitors are responsible for their qualifications. (AHA Handbook, Chapter 14)
