CLASS FEES: Dressage Classes—\$20 per class or \$50 for 3 (horse & rider pair). Musical Freestyle class \$15 per rider. All dressage classes require pre-registration. No exceptions. Office fee \$8.00 per horse/rider.

DRESSAGE TESTS: All current dressage tests are available at www.foxrunfarm.net. TOC = Test of choice. High percentage wins. You may ride more than one test per TOC class as long as it is not the same test. Please specify test(s) on entry form.

ENTRIES: Entries must be made online at www.foxrunfarm.net. Online entries must be paid to be complete. Closing date is 5-8-23 at midnight. Late entries may be accepted by organizer if space allows with \$10 extra fee per class. Classes may be combined or divided depending on the number of competitors. Negative Coggins within 1 year required and available upon request.

REFUNDS: Prior to closing date - \$10 office fee. No refunds past the closing date.

MUSICAL FREESTYLES: There will be a Junior and an Open division. One winner in each division will be chosen based on music choice, creativity, and technicality of movements. No requirements per level. Costumes are permitted. Judging criteria available at www.foxrunfarm.net/shows.

AWARDS: Ribbons awarded to 6th place. Jr. & Sr. high point score awards at Intro. Level and Training Level & above. Special awards for MARIE DOLCHAN MEMORIAL, QUINCY MEMORIAL, CASPER AWARD CLASS & MUSICAL FREESTYLE.

1st YEAR: Any horse or rider in their first year of dressage competition.

TIMES: Dressage times will be posted on FB at F.R.R.I.E.N.D.S. Fox Run Farm Student page & www.foxrunfarm.net by 5-11-23.

STABLING: Very limited. \$20 per night. Initial shavings provided. No straw allowed. Barn closes at 10 p.m. and opens at 6 a.m.

ARENAS: All classes except class 14 will be ridden in a 55' x 116' covered arena - rubber footing. Class 14 will be ridden on grass in a standard dressage ring (20 x 60 m).

DRESS/ATTIRE: Standard show attire. This is not a schooling show and informal dress will be penalized. An ATSM approved helmet and heeled boots MUST be worn when mounted at any time including with western tack.

DIRECTIONS: From I-24 in Kentucky, take Exit 65 (Hwy 68-80) west towards Cadiz. Pass through stop light at Interstate, stop light at FNB bank and proceed to caution light at Hwy 139 (South Rd). Turn left onto 139 and go to 1st caution light. Turn right onto Hwy 272. South Tanyard Rd. is the first road on the left - approx. 1/2 mile. Fox Run Farm is .4 miles on the left. Look for signs. From HWY 68-80 East - turn right at caution light (Hwy 139) and proceed as above. From Hwy 120 in Tennessee - 120 north turns into Hwy 139. Turn left at Hwy 272 and proceed as above. Note that most GPS systems will not take you to Fox Run Farm. When on South Tanyard Rd., look for

blue mailbox with Fox Run Farm. Long gravel driveway - barn and arena are not visible from the road.
