Directions to Black Dog Farm: From the 15 Freeway (north or south) take the Clinton Keith off ramp. Travel west 6.9 miles to stop sign, Tenaja Rd, turn Right. Go 1.7 miles to Harkey Circle, turn Left. You have arrived.

Did you know that a horse may be shown by two riders? The horse must be ridden in the same level or the next consecutive level –maximum of 3 tests (4 tests permitted, if 2 are USDF/WDAA Intro tests) – Equitation not counted as a test. Each horse/rider combination must complete a *separate entry* form. Drug fee and grounds fee per horse (2 riders 1 horse = 1 drug/grounds fee)

TEV YEAR END SHOW SERIES AWARDS

Rated Series and Schooling Series

Horse/rider combinations that have competed for Year End awards at Intro Level, Training Level and First Level who have placed Champion or Reserve will no longer be eligible for Year End awards at that level.

Traditional Dressage – Excludes Para, Freestyle, Young Horse, Western

Introductory Through Grand Prix Levels * Exception: Open rider Introductory scores will not be awarded*

- **High Score, Rider** – Open, Amateur, Jr/Yr
- **Breed High Score** – Open, Amateur, Jr/Yr
- **High Point, Accumulated** – Open, Amateur, Jr/Yr (Horse/Rider combo)
- **Reserve High Point, Accumulated** – Open, Amateur, Jr/Yr (Horse/Rider combo)
- **Accumulated High Point – Top Ten** recognition

Western Dressage – Excludes Para, Freestyle, Young Horse, Traditional

Introductory Through Fourth Levels * Exception: Open rider Introductory scores will not be awarded*

- **High Score, Rider** – Open, Amateur, Jr/Yr
- **High Point, Accumulated** – Open, Amateur, Jr/Yr (Horse/rider combo)
- **Reserve High Point, Accumulated** – Open, Amateur, Jr/Yr (Horse/rider combo)
- **Accumulated High Point – Top Ten** recognition

TEV Special Trophies and Awards

Luna Tunes Freestyle Perpetual Trophy – Awarded to the overall Highest score (%) earned in a Musical Freestyle English or Western, at a Rated or Schooling Show.

Scarlet Moon Amateur Perpetual Trophy – Awarded to the overall Highest score (%) earned by an Amateur in a Western Class at either a 1* Rated or Schooling Show.

The Patricia Ommert Western Dressage Perpetual Trophy – Awarded to the overall Highest score (%) by an Open rider in a Western Class at a rated show.

Versatility Award – Awarded to the Highest scoring (%) Horse/rider combo showing both English and Western Schooling Show Series. Must be adjacent levels

High Point Qualifications for All levels – Intro through Grand Prix – Traditional and Western:

- Minimum classes to be ridden – 3 at Intro through Third Level; 2 at Fourth level and above
- Minimum score for Year End awards, 55.000%
- Two tests per day/show will count. The highest two scores to be used.
- Qualifying period – October 1 to September 30

➤ Points earned: First place = 5 points, Second place = 3 points, Third place = 1 point

To be eligible for year-end awards, you must do one of the following:

- **Be a TEV chapter sponsor**
- **OR volunteer** a minimum of 4 hours per horse/rider combo. Volunteer hours may be assigned to horse/rider combo of choice in Rated or Schooling show. *Volunteer hours may be earned by 1.) Working at any TEV show, rated or schooling (Show set-up and tear-down worth double hours!) 2.) Serving on a committee, 3.) Helping with a TEV educational event*
- **OR** pay a nomination fee per horse/rider combo in current year. TEV chapter member \$25, non-TEV chapter member \$35.

FEES: All classes \$30 Plus: office fee \$10, grounds fee \$15, CA drug fee \$14, late fee \$25, CAWDA High Point Fee \$3 (Western Dressage only.)

DIVISION: Specify Open (O), Adult Amateur (AA), Junior/Young Rider (Jr/YR). If you do not specify, you will be entered as Open.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY: Entries will be accepted in the order received. **ALL TESTS** will be ridden in a 20m x 60m dressage court. Maximum number of tests per horse – 3.
