PtHA Mission Statement

- To improve, promote and enhance the Pinto horse, pony, miniature and Utility horse and Long Ear
- To collect, record and preserve Pinto pedigrees and Pinto competition records
- To represent the multifaceted world of Pinto ownership: breeding, competition and pleasure

- To promote the continued growth of PtHA through good horsemanship and good sportsmanship

PtHA Sportsmanship Conduct Rule

• UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT or any other form of misconduct that is irresponsible, illegal, indecent, profane, intimidating, threatening or abusive is prohibited. This provision applies to:

1. PtHA members, non-members, exhibitors, trainers, owners, owner representatives, spectators and all other persons on the show grounds of a PtHA-approved event; and
2. PtHA members on the show grounds of an event held in conjunction with a PtHA-approved event; and
3. PtHA members on the show grounds of an event during which a PtHA-approved class is held regardless of whether the conduct is associated with or occurs during a PtHA-approved class.

Show management may immediately expel individuals exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct from show grounds and shall file a written report with PtHA concerning the conduct in question.

PtHA Animal Welfare Statement

Every Pinto shall, at all times, be treated humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. This prohibition against inhumane treatment applies to PtHA members and non-members.

1. PtHA members may be held responsible for the actions of their trainers, agents, representatives and/or employees. For violation of this rule, an individual may be disciplined, suspended, fined, denied PtHA privileges, disqualified, expelled from show grounds and/or expelled from PtHA.
2. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine care, training and exhibition procedures or veterinary standards, would determine to be cruel, abusive or inhumane.

ARRIVAL

The Check-In Station and barns will open at 8 a.m., Friday, June 9. **ABSOLUTELY NO ARRIVALS WILL BE ACCEPTED PRIOR TO THIS TIME.** All equine must have their printed health certificates and Coggins papers checked.

Required Health Documents

To comply with Oklahoma state animal health regulations and to ensure the health of your Pinto, the following requirements will be strictly enforced for all equine at the Pinto World Championship.

All equine must have:

1. A 12-month Negative Coggins test. The State of Oklahoma Department of Animal Health Division requires a negative Coggins Test, showing said animal to be negative to either AGID or ELISA test for EIA within 12 months prior to show date, must accompany all equines. Foals, 6 months of age and under are exempt from this requirement if accompanied by their negative tested dam. Date and results of this test must be shown on the health certificate. Test result papers should include animals REGISTERED NAME (rather than barn names) and MARKINGS.
2. A PRINTED hard copy of a 30-day Health Certificate is required for all equines entering the Expo Square facility. The State of Oklahoma Department of Animal Health Division requires that all equine must be accompanied by an official health certificate dated within 30 days prior to arrival onto the show grounds by a licensed veterinarian from the state of origin. An inspector will review all Coggins test and health papers before

any equine is admitted onto the horseshow grounds. Any equine arriving without a negative Coggins test and Health Papers will be quarantined until released by the show veterinarian. All tests will be at the owner's expense.

Make sure and bring your stamped Health Certificate to the Show Office in order to get your show packet. All health papers must be printed on paper; no pictures on phones will be accepted.

DEPARTURE

All facilities must be vacated by noon, Sunday, June 25.



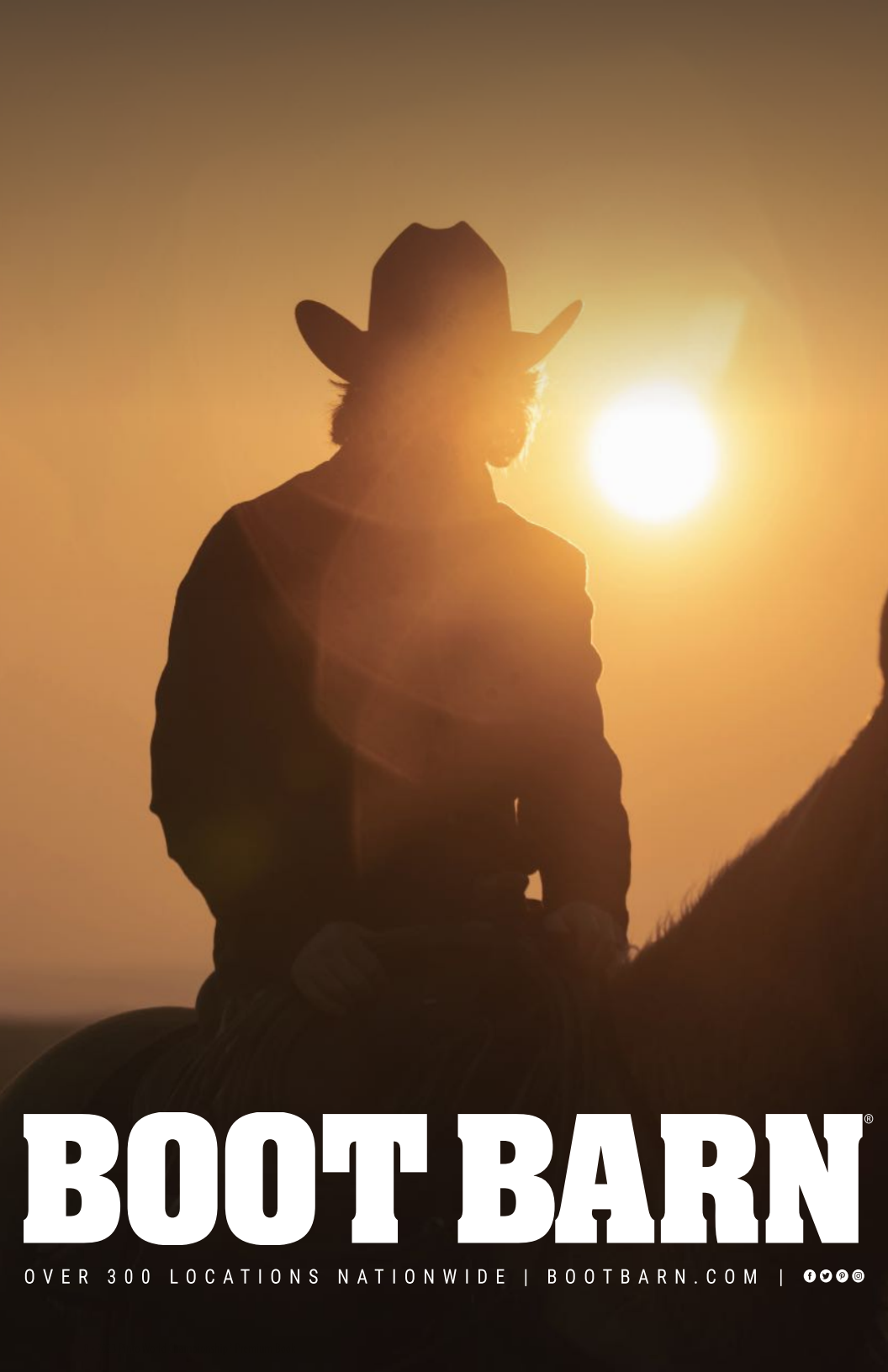
NSBA Dual-Approved Classes

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

IMPORTANT: Absolutely no animals will be allowed onto the show grounds until 8 a.m. on Friday, June 9. Especially on the first move-in day, there could be a line of trailers at the first check point, this line usually moves quickly, but please be patient while the health inspectors move as quickly as possible.

Checkpoint #1 - Health Station, just inside Gate 5

Have Coggins and Health Papers for all equines in your trailer ready for the inspector. All papers must be stamped before proceeding to Checkpoint #2. If you don't have the required documents, please be patient while the Staff locates the Pinto World Championship Veterinarian as soon as possible.

Checkpoint #2 - Stalling Office, North end of the Expedition Barn

Obtain your stalling assignments and proceed to the trailer unloading area in front of the barns.

Checkpoint #3 - Stall Key Booth, in the center of each barn

Present the Pinto World Championship Staff Member your stall assignments and they will unlock your stalls. After promptly unloading your trailer, please move your trailer to the designated secured trailer parking area North of the Feed Store so other people may unload.

Checkpoint #4 - Show Office, lower level of the Ford Truck Arena

Bring your stamped health papers, to the show office and pick up your Show Packet that contains back numbers, class lists and other vital information.

Checkpoint #5 - Identification Station in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Barn

Take all exhibitors numbers, original Registration Certificate (or a legible color copy) and your Pinto to be positively identified. Ponies, Miniatures, and Mini Long Ears must also be measured at this time.

CLASS INFORMATION

Classes Requiring A Hand Gallop

Up to 12 horses can hand gallop at one time at the Pinto World Championship depending on arena size.

Dressage/Western Dressage

There will NOT be ride times for Dressage or Western Dressage classes. Random draw order will be posted along with other classes. Notify the paddock if the random draw places you back to back in a class. Score sheets will be available online.

PThA will not provide Dressage tests. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to obtain an official Dressage test from the United States Equestrian Federation or the Western Dressage Association of America.

NSBA Dual Approved Classes

Multiple classes are dual approved through the National Snaffle Bit Association for the Pinto World Championship, including select classes of Open, Amateur and Youth Western Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Western Riding, Yearling Longe Line, Ranch Rail Pleasure, Ranch Riding and Ranch Trail. Open classes will receive a trophy for first place and paybacks according to the NSBA scale. Youth and Amateur classes will receive a trophy for first place. Classes will run concurrently with PThA classes. Horse owner and exhibitor must be current NSBA members. All horses competing in any NSBA class (including Dual Approved classes) will be required to be registered with NSBA in the current owner's name. Call (847) 623-6722 for NSBA membership information.

Amateur Walk/Trot Classes

Classes – All classes offered will be judged in the same manner as their regular Amateur division counterparts (eliminating lope or canter). All exhibitors must have applied for Amateur card.

Eligibility – PThA member, 19 years old and older is eligible for this division. Entries in this division may NOT enter any class at the 2023 Pinto World Championship that requires a lope or canter.

Ownership – All Pintos must be owned or leased by the exhibitor or family member.

Points – Amateur Walk/Trot classes will be counted for Amateur, Junior/Senior and Elite Walk/Trot High Point awards.

Youth Leadline Walk Only class

For PThA members, 8 years old and under, a Walk-only Leadline class will be offered. Participants in this class will not be allowed to compete in any other youth designated showmanship or performance class at this show. The class will not count toward any high point.

Youth Leadline Walk/Trot

All classes offered will be judged in the same manner as their regular Youth division counterparts (eliminating lope or canter).

Eligibility – Any PThA member, 8 years old and under is eligible for this division. Entries in this division may NOT enter any class at the 2023 Pinto World Championship that requires a lope or canter, or any Walk/Trot class not designated a Leadline Walk/Trot class.

Ownership – Exhibitors need not own or lease the Pinto exhibited.

Points – 8 & under Youth Leadline Walk/Trot classes will be counted for Youth Leadline Walk/Trot High Point awards.

Youth Walk/Trot Classes (10 & Under)

All classes offered will be judged in the same manner as their regular Youth division counterparts (eliminating lope or canter).

Eligibility – Any PThA member, 10 years old and under is eligible for this division. Entries in this division may NOT enter any class at the 2023 Pinto World Championship that requires a lope or canter, or any Leadline class.

Ownership – All Pintos must be owned or leased by the exhibitor or family member.

Points – 10 & Under Youth Walk/Trot classes will be counted for Youth Walk/Trot High Point awards.

Youth Walk/Trot Classes (11-18)

All classes offered will be judged in the same manner as their regular Youth division counterparts (eliminating lope or canter).

Eligibility – Any PThA member, 11-18 years of age is eligible for this division. Entries in this division may NOT enter any class at the 2023 Pinto World Championship that requires a lope or canter.

Ownership – All Pintos must be owned or leased by the exhibitor or family member.

Points – Youth Walk/Trot classes will be counted for Youth Walk/Trot 11-18 High Point awards.

SHOW INFORMATION

Participation/Membership Requirements

Horses and exhibitors do not have to pre-qualify to be eligible to participate in this show. All World Championship exhibitors are required to be current members, even if entered in non-point earning classes. In addition, all owners of Pintos entered in this show must be current members in good standing with PTHA. Owners and exhibitors may join PTHA at the time of entry.

To compete in Amateur or Amateur Walk/Trot classes, an exhibitor must possess (or have applied for) a current PTHA Amateur card at the time entries are submitted. To compete in Youth or Youth Walk/Trot classes an exhibitor must possess (or have applied for) a current PTHA Youth card at the time entries are submitted. To compete in Novice classes, whether Youth or Amateur, a Novice exhibitor must possess (or have applied for) a current PTHA Novice card.

Registration

All Pintos must be permanently registered with PTHA at the time of exhibition. Horses will not be registered at the show. Rush fees will be charged on registrations for Pintos wishing to enter the show if registration is received after April 25, 2023.

Leases

If a Pinto is to be shown by a Youth or Amateur that is NOT the current owner nor related to the current owner, the exhibitor MUST have a current Lease for the Pinto on file with the PTHA. Lease applications will not be accepted at the show. Rush fees will be charged on leases for exhibitors wishing to enter the show if lease is received after April 25, 2023. The lease must be processed through the PTHA office.

Transfer of Ownership

No transfer applications will be accepted at the show. All transfers must be processed through the PTHA office. Rush fees will be charged on Transfers of Ownership for Pintos wishing to enter the show if transfer is received after April 25, 2023.

STALL INFORMATION

All animals must have a stall paid for each day exhibiting. No more than one animal may occupy a stall. Anyone using an unassigned stall for grooming, storage or stalling of a horse will be charged a full show stall fee for the use of that stall. Anyone not obtaining their stall assignment from the Stall Manager, or found to be stalling horses in stalls not yet paid for, will be eliminated from the show by management. The Stall Manager must make any change in stall assignments.

Stall Reservations

Stall reservations must be postmarked by April 25, 2023 in order to avoid late fees. Any reservation received without full payment will be considered received on the date complete payment is received at the PTHA office. Payment is deposited upon receipt, but does not guarantee assignment to a requested stall area.

Stall assignments will be based on the stall locations previously established at past World Shows. The following is the order stalls will be assigned:

- Returning individuals whose reservations are postmarked by April 25 and are requesting their established location. However, if more stalls are needed than last year, it may be necessary for that exhibitor to move to a different area.
- Returning individuals whose reservations are postmarked by April 25 that request a new location.
- New requests/individuals whose reservations are postmarked by April 25
- Reservations postmarked after April 25 will be assigned by date postmarked.

Group Stalling

Persons wishing to stall together must submit stall reservation forms in the same envelope, along with the full payment of stall fees.

Feed and Bedding - Explorer Barn

Bedding will be the responsibility of the exhibitor/owner. Straw and coarse shavings are allowed as stall bedding. Individuals may bring bedding for their own use, but the sale of bedding by exhibitors/owners is prohibited under PTHA's contract with Expo Square. Feed and bedding orders will be taken by Fairgrounds Feed and Bedding, located on the north end of the Expedition Barn, (918)-728-3299. All payments must be made to Fairgrounds Feed and Bedding at the time of ordering.

Soiled Bedding

All soiled bedding must be disposed of in designated bins only. Please do not put bedding in trashcans.

Removing Panels/Damages

If panels are removed from stalls, a \$20 fee will be charged to the PTHA account of the stall renter for EACH panel not returned to original position prior to move out. Any other damage assessed by Expo Square will also be charged to the stall renter.

Safety

Congested aisles and alleys are an inconvenience and a safety threat for other exhibitors and animals. Please exercise common courtesy and sensible judgment in regards to the placement of chairs and items that may block aisles. No aisles may be closed off. See also: Stall Decorations. Show management reserves the right to ask any person, whose animal, equipment or decorations are creating a dangerous situation, to move locations.

Grills

Open flame, or other devices emitting flame, fire, heat or any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal or other cooking devices shall not be permitted inside stall barns or under the eaves of stall barns.

Stall Decorations

Absolutely no decorations will be allowed to protrude into the barn aisles. If seating areas, entertainment centers, etc., are desired, additional stalls may be purchased for this purpose. All decorations must be attached using temporary set-ups and must be removed by the decorator prior to move out. Use of nails, tacks or any similar material is prohibited.

Wash Racks

Animals are to be washed in wash racks only. Bathing of animals in stalls, walkways, streets or any other area is prohibited.

Stall Mat Rental

Stall mat rentals are available through Rent a Stall Mat. The mats should be ordered online at www.rentastallmat.com or 844-628-7787 prior to the show to ensure delivery prior to your arrival. Stall assignments will be finalized the week prior to move-in. The mats will be delivered and removed after your departure.

This show is approved and managed by the Pinto Horse Association of America Inc. All classes will be conducted in accordance with this Premium Book and the current PtHA rulebook.

The final right to settle all conflicts arising at the Pinto World Championship is reserved by the Show Management. If this Premium Book and the PtHA rulebook do not cover a rule and/or condition, the PtHA Executive Director will make the final decision.

Responsibility and Liability

See also PtHA Rule B3 and B4.

It is agreed that by entering the Pinto World Championship, either as an owner or exhibitor or in any way assisting in the Pinto World Championship, the Pinto Horse Association of America, Inc., the PtHA Executive Committee, staff, independent contractors and Expo Square shall not be held responsible in any manner for loss or damage to any animals, owners, exhibitors, handlers, affiliated parties, property or properties associated with these aforementioned articles.

Photography and Videography

Only photographers and videographers under contract with the PtHA will be allowed to take photos or video of any Pinto, exhibitor, owner, staff member or those associated with the show during the Pinto World Championship. Persons directly related to or associated with an exhibitor may take photos or video of the exhibitor for personal use only but permission must be obtained from the show office.

Television and Media

See also PtHA Rule B2.

Attendance at a PtHA-approved event, in whatever capacity, shall constitute authorization for PtHA, its agents, designees, or assigns to photograph, video tape, televise, or record by other means any person or Pinto on the premises of a PtHA-approved event, and shall further constitute authorization for the use of such person's name, voice and biography, or the name, pedigree and performance record of any Pinto on the premises in conjunction with any photographic material.

Announce Requests

The announcer stand and paddock booth will be off limits except for authorized show personnel assigned to that area. Show Management will not tolerate interruptions or loud activity in or around these areas.

All announcement requests must be submitted in writing on a Special Announcements Form at the show office. PTHA staff must approve all announcements.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry Submission

All entries must be postmarked no later than April 25, 2023, to avoid post-entry fees. Entries must be submitted on the official Entry Form for this show and may be photocopied as needed. Entry Forms must be complete, with all class numbers and proper signatures included. Incomplete Entry Forms may be returned unprocessed. Entries without payment of full fees, entries paid by returned checks or credit cards declined after close of entries, will be considered post-entries, with additional fees assessed accordingly. Balance due must be paid before you will be allowed to show.

Send all entries to: Pinto Horse Association of America Inc., World Championship Entries, 7330 NW 23rd St., Bethany, OK 73008. Entries can be emailed to worldshow@pinto.org or faxed to (405) 787-0773. If entries are emailed or faxed, please do not mail also.

Post-Entries Before the Show

Entries postmarked after the deadline will be considered post-entries, as will entries received prior to April 25 without acceptable payment of fees.

If classes are added to a current entry after the April 25 deadline, the additional classes will be considered post-entries and will be charged accordingly. If adding classes after April 25, to an entry that is on the Flat Fee, the additional classes will be considered post-entries and will not be eligible to be under the Flat Fee. They will be charged separately, using the post-entry fee.

Post-Entries at the Show

Post-entries must be made by 6 p.m. the day prior to when the class to be entered is scheduled. Day of class entries will not be accepted.

Entering Classes with Payback

If entering any class with a cash prize, the owner must complete the financial information included on the entry form to be eligible for payback. Awards/Money won at the Pinto World Championships are subject to IRS 1099 reporting in accordance with IRS rules.

Adding Classes

No classes will be added at the gate. An Add Form MUST be completed by 6 pm at the Show Office the day before the class the exhibitor wishes to enter.

Scratching Classes

As a courtesy to show management, any exhibitor wishing to scratch a class, must complete a Scratch Form at the Show Office BEFORE that class is called to the makeup pen.

Substituting Classes

Classes may be substituted on a Pinto that is already entered. If a class is scratched with the show office before the class enters the arena, then a class may be substituted at a fee of \$15 per class. 'No Show' entries WILL NOT be eligible for substitutions. A Substitute Form MUST be completed at the Show Office by 6 p.m. the day before the class the exhibitor wishes to enter.

Substituting a Pinto

Any Pinto (Youth, Amateur or Open) that has been scratched entirely from competition, in writing, may be replaced at a fee of \$15 per class, in addition to the office charge on the new Pinto but the new Pinto MUST be owned/leased by the same owner/lessee as the scratched Pinto.

Substituting a Rider

Riders may be substituted in OPEN classes, only if the Pinto is already entered in the class. A Rider Substitute form must be filed at the horse show office before the class enters the arena.

Cross-Entry in Youth/Amateur/Open Classes

Cross-entry of a Pinto in the Jr, Sr and Elite Amateur division classes

is prohibited under PTHA® rules, except in Showmanship, Horsemanship, or Equitation classes. Cross-entry of a Pinto in the 13 & under and 14-18 age divisions of Youth classes is prohibited under PTHA rules, except in Showmanship, Horsemanship or Equitation classes. Pintos may be otherwise cross entered between Youth, Amateur and Open classes.

Payment of Fees

Checks – Checks should be made payable to PTHA in U.S. Funds Only. A \$35 penalty will be added to the amount due on any returned check. Returned checks not cleared by April 25, 2023, will result in post-entry charges being assessed to all associated entries. Checks will be deposited on the same day received. Credit Cards – American Express, Visa, MasterCard or Discover cards will be accepted for entries and all show related fees. When entering: provide the account number, card expiration date, exact name appearing on the card and PTHA membership number of cardholder AND horse owner. Charges made at the show will require the use of the actual credit card. In the event that the credit card company declines a credit card, post-entry fees will apply if credit card is not honored by April 25, 2023, plus \$50 insufficient funds fee.

Office Fee

There will be a one-time \$40 administrative office charge for each Pinto entered. This fee is assessed only one time per Pinto regardless of the number of classes in which it is entered and is non-refundable.

Drug Test Fee

There will be a one-time \$20 drug testing fee for each Pinto entered. This fee is assessed only one time per Pinto regardless of the number of classes entered and is non-refundable.

Flat Fee

Youth or Amateur exhibitors may pay a Flat Fee for each rider/horse combination and enter a limited number of classes for which they are eligible according to the flat fee division. All classes the Youth or Amateur wishes to enter under this plan must be listed on the ORIGINAL ENTRY.

If adding classes after the original entry form is submitted to an entry that is on the Flat Fee, the additional classes will be considered separate and will NOT be eligible to be under the Flat Fee. These classes will be charged, using the post-entry fee. Classes may be dropped at no charge, but exhibitors must notify the Show Office of any such scratches prior to the start of the affected class(es) to be eligible for class substitutions.

No cross-entering within the Flat Fee – If Flat Fee is used, it must be used for all Youth, all Youth Novice, all Youth Walk/Trot, all Amateur, all Amateur Walk/Trot or all Amateur Novice classes.

Cancellation/Refund of Entries and Stall Fees

All entries or stalls cancelled regardless of reason, will be handled in the following manner:

Entries cancelled before April 25 – Full refund of entry and stall fees and stall/grounds fees will be granted. PTHA will retain office charge.

Entries cancelled April 26 through May 7 – 75% refund of entry fees and stall fees will be granted. PTHA will retain office charge.

Entries cancelled May 8 through May 23 – 50% refund of entry fees and stall fees will be granted. PTHA will retain office charge.

Entries cancelled May 24 through June 11 – 25% refund of entry fees and stall fees will be granted. PTHA will retain office charge.

Entries cancelled after June 11 – After the show begins, NO REFUNDS, under any circumstances.

All notifications must be made by mail, e-mail or fax. Date of cancellation will be determined by the date the PTHA office receives written notification. PHONE CANCELLATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. If eligible, refund checks will be mailed approximately 30 days after the conclusion of the show. No other refund requests will be honored.

SHOW RULES

Admission to the Arena

No person will be permitted to enter the arena, except participants in the class, judges and their assistants. In classes where attendants are allowed, they will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by the judge.

Arena Gate Calls

Barn calls are a courtesy and will be made for each class. Regardless of the circumstances, it is the exhibitor's ultimate responsibility to report to their class on time.

Attire

All attendants must be neatly and suitably attired for a World Championship, long sleeves or a lab coat and appropriate footwear are required. Shorts, tank tops, sandals, etc., are not considered proper. Hats are optional, but ball caps are not permitted. The management may, at their discretion, bar any entry or person from entering the arena if deemed not suitable to appear before an audience.

Breaks

PtHA reserves the right to reschedule any published breaks as necessary. Additional breaks will be announced as deemed proper according to the progression of the show.

Class Placings

During the Pinto World Championship, the announcer will announce the placings under each judge, as well as the average placings in all classes. Average placings only will line up for awards. Ribbons for individual placings will be available for pick up in the Hospitality Room in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Barn.

Results of classes are considered final upon receipt of the judge's cards, unless an error in tabulation has occurred. PtHA reserves the right to correct obvious errors on judges' cards when detected.

Commercial Exhibits/Vendors

If an individual wishes to sell, display, or advertise tack, clothing, jewelry, furniture or any miscellaneous merchandise, a signed vendor contract must be on file with PtHA. In addition, the merchandise must be sold in designated vendor areas only. No items may be displayed or sold out of the barns or parking lots. Anyone found in violation of this rule will be issued a written warning on the first offense. The second and all subsequent offenses will yield a \$500 fine each.

Disqualification

Abuse — Any Pinto that shows evidence of fresh blood in the mouth, nose, chin, shoulder, barrel, flank or hip area will be considered to be abused and may be excused from the arena.

Dishonesty — Any exhibitor that has made or caused to be made any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from exhibiting.

General — In all individual work classes, simple majority opinion of the judges shall prevail, such as off pattern and lameness.

Lameness — A Pinto will be excused from the arena if a simple majority of judges disqualify the entry due to lameness.

Loose Pinto — Any equine that becomes separated from its handler, rider or driver and cannot be caught by the original exhibitor or is beyond the exhibitors control may be disqualified and excused from the arena.

Drug Declaration

A Pinto that has received medication that contains a prohibited substance may be shown if all requirements listed in PtHA rule G16 are met and a drug declaration form has been completed and returned to the Show Office.

Drug Testing

See PtHA rule G16. Drug Testing at the Pinto World Championship will be at random. Cooperation is mandatory.

Electronic Devices

Any exhibitor using an electronic device in the show arena will be immediately disqualified. (Exception: Reasonable Accommodation certificate has been issued.)

Equipment Failure/Time Outs

Unless specific class rules apply, any tack/attire infraction is to be considered a penalty, not a disqualification and the judges may penalize at their discretion. See PtHA rule G10 for Time Out rules in English classes.

Exhibitor Back Numbers

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to verify, prior to entry into the ring, the correctness of their exhibitor number. Any exhibitor not displaying a number or displaying a wrong number will not receive credit for placing in that class. All exhibitors must have all numbers stamped by a show staff member. (See also: ID Station) If laminating exhibitor numbers, the number must be ID stamped prior to lamination.

In-Hand and Saddle Seat Classes — Exhibitor numbers should be worn on the exhibitor's back, between the neck and the waist.

Hunt and Stock Seat Classes — One number must be on EACH side of the saddle pad/blanket.

Driving Classes — Number must be displayed on both sides of the vehicle shafts.

Lost Back Numbers

In the event of a lost back number, a fee of \$20 will be assessed for a replacement. The exhibitor will also be required to go back to the I.D. Station and have new back numbers stamped.

Equipment Judges

Equipment Judges shall be responsible for attire and equipment rule interpretations. Final interpretations are the responsibility of show management. All bits, tack, appointments and attire shall be checked by the equipment judge prior to entering the arena. Any equipment considered to be inhumane or illegal by the official equipment judge must be removed or entry into the arena will be denied. The equipment judge may disqualify an entry for the presence of blood on the horse. The equipment judge (s) may serve as an official alternate judge at the discretion of show management.

Exercise/Longeing

Exhibitors will receive a schedule of available practice times for some specific disciplines and age groups in their show packets. No longeing will be allowed in the arenas. Longeing areas will be designated and should be closely followed.

Health Requirements

No equine will be allowed on the show grounds without the following:

- 30 day Health Certificate * must be printed on paper
- Negative Coggins

Make sure the veterinarian uses PtHA registered names on the health certificate and Coggins papers. If current Health and negative Coggins are not available upon arrival at the show, the horse will be quarantined until released by the Show Veterinarian. All tests will be at the owner's expense.

Inhumane Treatment

No person shall treat any equine in an inhumane manner. This prohibition against inhumane treatment applies to PtHA members and non-members. Inhumane treatment shall include, but not be limited to, the prohibited conduct specified below. Inhumane treatment to horses other than Pintos and other animals used in competition is included in this prohibition as it indicates a general course of dealing with horses, which is unacceptable to PtHA.

1. For purposes of this rule, a person responsible for the care of an equine is

also responsible for and may be disciplined for the inhumane conduct of their trainers, agents, representatives and employees. For violation of this rule, an individual may be disciplined, suspended, fined, denied PTHA privileges, disqualified, expelled from show grounds and/or expelled from PTHA.

2. Inhumane treatment of any horse or any other animal on show grounds is strictly prohibited. Treatment of any horse will be considered inhumane if a person, educated or experienced in accepted equine training techniques, would perceive the conduct of an individual to be inhumane.
3. For purposes of this rule, a fines and penalty system has been established based on the severity of the offense. All offenses below will be assigned a minimum level of offense (level 1 = mild; level 2 = moderate; level 3 = severe). Depending on the facts of a situation, the level of offense may be increased.
4. Warning or Show Ground Removal cards will be issued based on the frequency and level of offense.
5. Inhumane treatment includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. placing an object in an equine's mouth so as to cause undue discomfort or distress (min. level 2);
 - b. leaving a bit in an equine's mouth for extended periods of time so as to cause undue discomfort or distress (min. level 1);
 - c. tying an equine up or around in a stall or anywhere at a PTHA event in the manner as to cause undue discomfort or distress (min. level 2);
 - d. longing or riding an equine in a manner as to cause undue discomfort or distress to the equine (min. level 1);
 - e. tying or fastening any foreign object onto an equine, halter, bridle and/or saddle in order to de-sensitize the horse (min. level 2);
 - f. use of training techniques or methods such as poling or striking an equine's legs with objects (min. level 2);
 - g. excessive spurring or whipping (min. level 1);
 - h. excessive jerking of reins (min. level 1);
 - i. excessive fencing (min. level 1);
 - j. excessive spinning (defined as no more than eight (8) consecutive turns in either direction) (min. level 1);
 - k. schooling over ramped oxers in reverse order (i.e., from highest to lowest instead of lowest to highest) (min. level 1);
 - l. schooling using rails higher than four (4) feet (min. level 1);
6. use of prohibited equipment, including, but not limited to: saw tooth bits; hock hobbles; tack collars; or tack hackamores; whips used for showmanship; war bridles or like devices; riding in a curb bit without a curb strap; wire or solid metal curb straps no matter how padded; wire cavesson; wire or cable tie-downs; bumper bits; metal bosals (no matter how padded); chambons; headstalls made of metal (no matter how wrapped or padded), twisted rawhide, or rope may not be used on a horse's head (3/8 inch rope may be used with a slip/gag bit); running martingales used with curb bits used without rein stops; draw reins attached between or around the front legs will not be allowed at PTHA-approved events (min. level 2);
- n. use of any item or appliance that restricts movement or circulation of the equine's tail (min. level 3);
- o. exhibiting an equine which appears to be sullen, dull, lethargic, emaciated, drawn or overly tired (min. level 1);
- p. intentional or negligent treatment which results in any bleeding – intentional (min. level 3); negligent (min. level 1);
- q. applying excessive pressure on or excessively jerking of a halter lead shank or an allowed lip chain (min. level 2);
- r. Any other treatment or conduct deemed by a show official to be inhumane or abusive (min. level 1).

Judges

Four judges selected from and rotated within a panel of PTHA approved

judges will judge all classes. In the event that a judge officially designated on the premium list is unable to perform their duties, or for any other reason deemed appropriate, the show committee reserves the right to substitute another PTHA judge or to change scheduled assignments.

Judges Video Reviews

Judges may video review runs before cards are submitted in scored classes that lack concurrence when major penalties, disqualifications, zero scores or "no scores" are involved or when a judge requests a review. Lack of concurrence concerning non-major penalties will not be reviewed and cannot be changed once submitted. No judge shall be required to change his/her score following a video review. Each judge's decision is an individual call.

Patterns

All patterns (excluding Dressage and Western Dressage) will be printed in a pattern book. One pattern book will be available to each back number per horse. Dressage tests may be obtained from the United States Equestrian Federation and the Western Dressage Association of America.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check the boards behind each arena before their class starts in case any changes and/or corrections to the pattern have occurred.

Pony and Miniature Measurements

All ponies, miniature horses, and mini mules/donkeys must be measured at the show by a designated PTHA staff member and must measure within their size classification.

Measurement officials will be located at the Identification Station. Owners must pick up show packets BEFORE taking a Pinto to be measured.

If a Pinto measures outside of its documented classification, it will be subject to reclassification and a revision of show entries and fees.

Positive Identification

All Pintos entered in the show must be positively identified at the Identification Station located in the OK Ford Dealers Barn. The owner and/or exhibitor must pick up the show packet (that includes exhibitor numbers) at the Show Office BEFORE being identified. The original PTHA Registration Papers (or legible color copy) must be presented with the Pinto and exhibitor numbers. A show staff member will inspect the Pinto and stamp the exhibitor numbers. If a Pinto is wearing a saddle, sheet, slinky, etc., it may be necessary for the handler to remove the items before the numbers are stamped. NO PINTO WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE SHOW RING WITHOUT A STAMPED EXHIBITOR NUMBER.

Paid Practice Schedule

All Dressage, Western Dressage, Trail In Hand, Hunter In Hand, Jumping In Hand, Over Fences, Obstacle Driving, Trail and Ranch Trail classes will include a scheduled practice time in which all entrants will have the opportunity to school. No additional sign-up is required. All pintos participating in a scheduled practice must wear their back number during the practices. All entries in these classes are required to pay the Schooling/Equipment fee in addition to the class fee.

Protests

See PtHA Rule G14.

All protests must be given to the show office in writing and signed by the protester within 12 hours of the time of the cause of the protest and must be accompanied by \$250.

Results Posting

Results for each World Championship Class and High Point will be posted on the PtHA Web site. High Point and class results will be published in the online Pinto Horse magazine immediately following the show. After they are published in the magazine, the results are deemed final.

Secure Trailer Lot

After unloading trailers, please park the trailers in the secure trailer lot north of the Feed Store. You will receive a numbered sticker for your trailer that will match one for your truck. Both stickers must match before you will be allowed to leave with a trailer from the secure lot.

Show Office

The Show Office is located in the Ford Livestock Exhibit Hall and will be open:

June 9 • Noon to 6 pm

June 10 & 11 • 8 am to 6 pm

June 12-24 • 7 am to 6 pm

These are the only times exhibitor packets may be picked up, class adds, scratches or substitutions may be made. Post entries must be made by 6 pm the day prior to when the class is scheduled to be held.

The following must be brought to the office in order to pick up exhibitor packets:

- Health certificate that has been stamped by the Stall Office when you arrived with your horse.

Veterinarian

An official Pinto World Championship veterinarian will be available during show hours. Individual owners are responsible for any fees due for services rendered. PtHA provides this service as a convenience only, and accepts no responsibility for actions resulting from services rendered. Any other veterinarian coming onto the Expo Square grounds during the Pinto World Championship must receive written permission from the Show Manager before working on any horse, pony, miniature, or mule or donkey.

All animals are subject to a physical inspection by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee. Any horse deemed contagious by the Show Veterinarian must be removed from the show grounds immediately. Any animal on the grounds in immediate need of veterinarian care will be treated at the expense of the owner, if the animal's owner(s) cannot be located.

PADDOCK PROCEDURES

Exhibitors must check in with the paddock. The paddock will call exhibitors to enter the arena in their posted order of go. Only the exhibitors in the class that immediately follows the class in the arena will be allowed in the paddock area. If needed, a handler may be permitted in the paddock area for youth and amateur classes. Absolutely no sprays will be allowed in the paddock area.

Barn calls are a courtesy and will be made for each class. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to report to their class on time.

Gate Rule

A one-minute gate rule will be enforced. After the final call for a class has been given, the gate will be closed in one minute, and no late participants will be accepted. Barn calls are made as a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the progression of the show and be ready for their class when it enters the arena. No refunds for missed classes.

Class Conflict

In the event that a Pinto or exhibitor is entered in two classes in separate arenas that have a potential to be showing at the same time, the Paddock Master of each arena must be notified by filing a class conflict notification with each at least one class prior to the conflict. The Paddock Master will make an attempt to accommodate conflicts. Please keep the Paddock Master of each arena advised if your situation changes. Class Conflict Forms are available at all three Paddocks.

Split Classes/Preliminaries

Any class deemed necessary by the Show Staff will be split. For rail classes:

All recalls from the average card will be announced in random order by exhibitor number and will retire to the Paddock area until called for the final go.

For showmanship, horsemanship, equitation classes –

More than 25 entries – Splits will be made, exhibitors will perform the PRELIM pattern, each judge will place a percentage of the entries in each split. Recalls (from

the average card) will be announced in random order by exhibitor number. Class finalists will return to the paddock for the finals class according to the schedule. They will be judged on the finals pattern for the World Championship.

25 Entries or less – Perform PRELIM Pattern only.

Finals classes are listed in the schedule for showmanship, horsemanship and equitation. Any other class requiring a finals performance will be held directly following the preliminary go. Not all classes will have a preliminary and final performance. Classes will be split according to the rules established by the Premium Book.

Rail Classes Timer

In all rail classes, a maximum time will be set for exhibitors to enter the arena. A timer will be visible to the Paddock area. When time has expired, the gate will be closed and no one will be allowed to enter the arena.

Tack Changes

All tack changes must be pre-scheduled with the Paddock Master on an official request form. Three minutes after the final class call will be allowed for all changes to be made in the Paddock Area.

Working Order

All individual work classes will have a working order. The order will be posted in the make-up area. Show management reserves the right to make changes as deemed necessary. If an exhibitor does not show up for their turn in the working order, it will be considered a missed class and they WILL NOT be moved in the order.

CLASS/HIGH POINT TABULATION RULES

Point Tabulation

ROM Points

One set of ROM points will be awarded for each judge's placing. One set of ROM points will be awarded for the three-judge average in all eligible PthA classes. ROM points will not be awarded if there are less than three entries in the class.

Class Placings

A four-judge system will be used at this show with the low card being dropped before the average card is tabulated. The averaging system used by PthA is as follows: horses are given an advantage or "weighted" credit for receiving first place on any judge's card.

Points will be awarded based on the following:

1st place — 0 points	6th place — 6 points
2nd place — 2 points	7th place — 7 points
3rd place — 3 points	8th place — 8 points
4th place — 4 points	9th place — 9 points
5th place — 5 points	10th place — 10 points

All Pintos not appearing on a judge's card will receive 1 more point than the last Pinto placed in the class. Points from all three judges' cards are totaled and the entry with the lowest score wins on the average card.

Tabulation Error

If a tabulation error is suspected, a written inquiry may be presented to the Show Steward within 24 hours after the completion of the affected class without using the protest procedure, EXCEPT AT THE END OF THE SHOW WHEN ALL INQUIRIES MUST BE GIVEN BEFORE THE AWARDS ARE PRESENTED. The PthA reserves the right to correct such an error without recourse from entrants.

Class Tie Breaker

One judge is designated as the tiebreaker for each class. In the event of a tie, the entry appearing highest on the tiebreaker judge's card is placed highest in the average. The judge designated as tiebreaker will be alternated from class to class.

High Point Rules

All classes in which a Pinto, YA/Pinto or AM/Pinto is eligible will count toward High Point awards in their respective divisions. Supreme Color Champion and Charity Walk/Trot do not count for High Points. Halter does not count for Walk/Trot or Novice High Point, except for YA Walk/Trot 10 & Under. High Point awards will not be final until the last class in the division has been tabulated. Awards will only be released after the tabulation is final.

High Point Tabulation

High Point awards do not follow ROM standards. Therefore, it is possible to have the greatest number of ROM points in a division, and not be High Point for the show.

High Point awards will be tabulated using the average card according to the following scale.

High Point Ties

If there is a tie for 1st or 2nd place for High Point or Reserve High Point in a division, ties will be broken first on the Pinto, Youth/ Pinto or Amateur/Pinto combination, earning the greatest number of first places (on the average judge card for each class entered). Then, second place through seventh place. If a tie still remains, the winner will be the entrant who entered in the greatest number of classes. If a tie still remains, then the tie will be broken in favor of the entrant who has the lowest total score on all individual judge cards for all classes entered.

AWARDS

Please check all awards upon presentation before leaving the area. PTHA will not replace awards after they leave the presentation area.

Individual Judge Placings

Ribbons for individual judge placings will be available for pick up in the Hospitality Room in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Barn (Barn B).

World Championship Titles

All classes offered at the 2023 Pinto World Championship are considered World Championship classes except specialty classes. First place winners on the average card are considered World Champions and second place winners on the average card are considered Reserve World Champions.

Duplicate Buckles

Duplicate buckles are available for purchase through Gist Silversmiths, located in the tradeshow on the North side of the Livestock Arena.

FACILITY RULES

Alcohol

It is unlawful for any person or organization to bring or have upon the premises any alcoholic beverages other than the alcoholic beverages that the licensed caterer of the show grounds is authorized to sell. Any packaged liquor brought onto the fairgrounds will be confiscated.

Dogs and Pets

Owners assume all liability for any pets brought to the show. All pets must be on leashes while on the grounds. No pets of any kind are allowed in the arena at any time. As a courtesy to fellow exhibitors, pet owners are required to pick up and dispose of ALL animal waste, especially in the courtyard and esplanade areas.

Fire Safety

The use of electric, flame or space heaters and air conditioners is prohibited in the barn area. Use of extension cords in stall areas, requires Ground Fault Interrupter Protection (GFCI). These cords have a test and reset button on the cord, and most cords have the words "GFCI protected" printed on the cord. All 120-volt extension cords must be three-wire grounded, (have a three-prong plug on the end of the cord). Frayed or damaged cords may not be used. Fire Inspectors will check the premises for compliance.

Golf Carts and Scooters

Golf Carts and scooters are allowed on the show grounds, however, for the safety of fellow exhibitors no golf carts, scooters, bicycles or other personal motorized vehicles will be allowed inside the barns at any time (except for staff and handicap vehicles). Handicap vehicles may obtain special permission at the Horse Show Office. ANY person driving ANY motorized vehicle must possess a current drivers license.

Grills

Open flame, or other devices emitting flame, fire, heat or any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal or other cooking devices shall not be permitted inside stall barns or under the eaves of stall barns

Parking/Trailer Parking

Due to move-in congestion, please limit unloading time as much as possible. Trailers must be parked in designated secured trailer parking after unloading, NOT IN FRONT OF BARNs. Handicap parking spaces are for Handicap Permit holders only.

Security
