ENTRIES AND FEES

ENTRIES CLOSE July 21, 2023. Entries postmarked after the closing date will be considered late and a late fee (\$25) will be added to each entry.

Entries received must include the following documentation. Entries without the following documentation are subject to an incomplete fee:

- 1. Completed entry form
- 2. Copies of registration papers
- 3. Copies of membership cards for Owner, Rider & Trainer
- 4. Copies of lease agreements, bill of sale and/or purchase contract (when applicable)
- 5. Full payment are subject to incomplete fee charge

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS: Canadian exhibitors must pay in US funds either by money order or check drawn on a US Bank.

INSUFFICIENT FUNDS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be charged 10% of the face value of the check or \$50.00, whichever is the greater amount.

REFUNDS VET or DR Full refund, less office fee before closing date. **After the closing date, a Veterinarian or Doctors certificate must be in the Show Secretary's hands before THE CLOSE of the show.** Stalls fees, Office fees are NOT refundable. 9-90 Fees are only refundable if the horse is fully vetted out of the show before the show begins, is not on the grounds, and is in compliance with the show policy. **NO REFUNDS ONCE CLASSES COMMENCE.** In the case where a horse has been entered and not shown all fees will be forfeited.

RABIES VACCINATION Proof of current Rabies vaccination is strongly recommended.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES

OUT OF STATE HORSES

- 1. Health Certificates within 30 days. BRING WITH YOU, INTERSTATE HEALTH CERTIFICATES State law requires a health certificate for horses traveling between state lines. Certificates must be on the approved state form and must list the origin and destination of the transported horse(s). The HC must show a temp recording, and show that the equine(s) are negative to a USDA approved test for Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) and identify the lab performing the EIA test, the accession number and the result of the test and the date the sample was drawn. Health Certificates are good for 30 days from the date of issue.
- 2. Proof of Current Negative Coggins Test dated within 1 year of date of show

IN STATE HORSES

1. Proof of Current Negative Coggins Test within 1 year of show

*USEF rule GR845 requires that horses entering competition grounds must be able to provide documentation of vaccination for Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes (Rhino pneumonitis).

SHOW ACCOUNTS: An open account may be started at the show for post entries only if a signed, blank check payable to AHCC is left on file at the office. If a posted class is charged to the exhibitor's account, and is later scratched, the exhibitor is still responsible for payment of that class. Even exchanges for posts and scratches will be allowed, provided they are done at the same time and are the same owner or payee.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries for additional classes will be accepted as follows;

Morning classes by 9:00 pm the evening before

Afternoon classes by 11:00 am Evening classes by 4:30 pm.

*After the above times you may enter a class with a late fee plus the entry fee. If a horse/rider shows in a class for which it is not properly entered, the exhibitor will be charged a double entry fee.

SCRATCHES: The office or in-gate must be notified if a horse does not intend to show and a class scratch form must be filled out at the show office. Failure to do so will result in a \$25.00 fine

SPLIT CLASSES: Junior Exhibitor classes with more than 18 will be split into two sections to be judged individually and two sets of ribbons and awards will be given. W/T/J classes will be split by discipline if entries warrant, decision of Show Manager and Show Committee.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HORSE SHOW OFFICE: Located in Barn C. The office will be open Thursday, 10 am, through 30 minutes past the close of the show on Sunday. The show office will open each show day 30 minutes before classes start and close 30 minutes after each the last class of the evening. The office phone number is 413-205-5084. Hours will be posted on the show office window. Office will be closed daily for lunch and dinner.

VETERINARIAN: Salmon Brook is our on-call vet and can be reached by calling 860-653-7238. The number is also posted on the show office wall.

STABLING: Stalls are 12'x9' permanent stalls with concrete floors and doors. Horse Stalls do not have initial bedding. Pleasant Brook Feed should be contacted to place orders, 413-467-9464. Please see the form attached to this prize list to ensure beeding and feed for your arrival and duration of the show.

SHOWING OUT OF TRAILER: Showing horses from a trailer and/or van is permitted. No horses will be allowed to remain in the trailer or van overnight. Fee: \$35.00 per day.

PARKING and UNLOADING: Parking and unloading MUST be in designated areas only. All improperly parked vehicles will be towed away at the owner's expense.

DOGS: USEF RULE GR1301.6 Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dog's behavior. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to

penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. See also GR 1037 – Warning cards. Dogs must have proof of current rabies vaccination.

CAMPERS & TRAILERS: There will be a \$125.00 charge per hookup and must be in designated areas only. Camper stickers must be easily visible. The Big E does NOT count the hours for camper spots, if you arrive on a half day and leave the following day, you will be charged 2 days.

FOOTING: The footing of the facilities is as follows: Coliseum 100' X 200' with a mix of sand, wood chips and clay. D Barn/4-H Ring-75' x 150' with stone dust. Dressage is 20M x 60M sand. C Barn Warm up stone dust

WARM UP RING: There is to be no lunging or long lining in the warm up or holding ring when classes are in session.

FOOD SERVICE: Collie Corner is located just inside the Coliseum. They are open daily during the show for breakfast, lunch & dinner. They close at the conclusion of the evening session and directly at the close of the show on Sunday.

HOSPITALITY: Provided daily, Thursday through Sunday, from 6:00 am just inside Barn C past the show office. Coffee, donuts and select bagels will be offered.

SCHOOLING SCHEDULE: The Coliseum will be open Thursday morning and will close at midnight, with a reserved time from 6:30 pm-7:30 pm reserved for 13 & Under, ACTS and Opportunity riders. It will be available daily prior to each session up to 30 minutes before the session starting time and again between sessions. It will remain open after the last class through midnight daily. Trail/Ranch Riding obstacles will be available to practice with on Saturday Evening.

LONGEING: There will be no longeing of horses in the Coliseum. Longeing areas are located outside behind the Coliseum, in the ring out back and in both practice areas in between sessions.

OTHER RULES PERTAINING TO THE SHOW:

SHARPS/MEDICAL WASTE: State rules will supersede USEF (USAE) sharps rule. Where applicable medical waste must be disposed of in marked containers, any needles etc, found in stalls will be subject to a \$100.00 fine.

MANURE: Must be dumped in designated areas ONLY. Anyone found dumping into empty stalls, undesignated areas or on the grass, will pay an additional fee.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS: Every horse in the show will be assigned an exhibitor number and this number must be worn by the exhibitor when the horse is being shown. Any exhibitor using the wrong number on not having a number may be excused or disqualified.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR All exhibitors in over fences and Hunt Seat Equitation classes must wear a helmet passing ASTM testing standards. ALL junior exhibitors riding anywhere on the grounds must wear protective headgear with harnesses buckled or they will be prohibited from riding anywhere other than the show ring. Adults are encouraged to comply with this safety rule. NYS requires parents or guardians to abide by the law requiring anyone under the age of 14 to wear a helmet. A law Officer can assess a fine to the parent or guardian not abiding by this law.

DR 120 1.1 (Dressage): Protective Headgear. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet, which meets or exceeds current ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para Dressage tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. The harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until the headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear may be the same as or a coordinating color with the coat, and may include contrast coloring, accent, and crystal decoration. See DR136 for dress code rules for exhibitions.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES: Any professional service or consultation performed by the Show Veterinarian and/or Farrier for exhibitors outside the show ring will be upon a private fee basis. Vet's phone number for after show hours will be posted at the show office.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

SAFE SPORT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

MEMBERSHIP

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT:

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

PLEASE NOTE: AHA Competition Level membership is required for showing at the Regional show. This would include Walk/Trot Classes. Leadline is exempt. WHEN A FARM, RANCH, SYNDICATE, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION OR OTHER BUSINESS ENTITY LISTED AS RECORDED OWNERS ON THE REGISTRATION PAPERS, THE SAME AHA MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED PARENTS SIGNING THE TRAINER LINE FOR JUNIOR EXHIBITORS NEED NOT BE A MEMBER, HOWEVER THEY MUST SIGN "PARENT" NEXT TO THEIR SIGNATURE.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT:

Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

CLASS SPECIFICS

Amateur to Ride/Owner to Ride: All riders in Amateur to Ride classes must have in their possession a current Amateur Certification Card issued by USEF or make an application for the card, at least one hour prior to riding in these classes. Applications may be secured through the Horse Show Secretary. Juniors are automatically considered amateurs. Combined ownership is not allowed in Amateur-Owner Classes unless all owners are members of the immediate family. Leased horses are not eligible for owner to ride classes unless the lessee and lessor are members of the immediate family. Horses entered in amateur owner must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF (Horses registered in the farm, ranch, syndicate, partnership, or corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by USEF. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted)

Exhibitor Age: For horse show purposes, the age of an individual on Dec. 1st of the preceding calendar year shall be maintained the entire show year.


Acts/Opportunity Classes: AHA and USEF Membership not required. These classes are NOT recognized. Cross-Entering between ACTS and Opportunity is PROHIBITED. Horses may cross-enter between ACTS, Opportunity and regular breed specific classes. Please see ACTS guidelines here: https://apaha.com/acts/including cross entry and tack, and rider appointments. See GR821 for further specifications regarding Opportunity Classes.

From points north, take interstate 91 or 5 south to the West Springfield Rotary, go right on Memorial Ave, you will be making a left turn into Eastern States.



- 1. No smoking is allowed in the barns or in the coliseum.
- 2. Fireproof material must be used for all stall decorations, No live trees,(unless potted) wreaths, roping etc.
- 3. The center Aisle of barns must remain clear.
 a. Aisle displays are not to exceed: Main aisle
- 30" from each side, side aisles- 24" from each side
 No accumulation of litter or rubbish allowed.
- b. No accumulation of litter or rubbish allowed.
 c. All exits shall be kept free and unobstructed.
- d. All fire lanes and other means of access for emergency vehicles shall be kept free and clear at all times
- e. All fire extinguishers, fire pulls and fire alarms stations shall be free and clear of obstructions and readily visible in their designated locations.
- 4. Bedding material and the like are not allowed on the floor of any aisle. This would include wood shavings, wet sawdust, peat moss, fine ground

wood mulch, etc. large wood chips or coarse bark mulch may be used, but must be kept damp at all times. No coverings over aisles, which would in any way limit the effectiveness of the sprinkler system.

- No graffiti in barns or in stalls. You will be billed for any type of damage.
- 6. Dogs must have current rabies vaccinations. Refer to each show for additional rules
- 7. No children are allowed on the rail in the coliseum.
- 8. No motorized vehicles of any type including bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, scooters, golf carts or mopeds are allowed in the barns, practice areas or any normal route used by horses. Any violation will result in the immediate impounding of the vehicle until the conclusion of the horse show.
- 9. No one under the age of 16 is permitted to drive a motorized vehicle on the grounds unless they have a permit or valid drivers license in accordance with the states registry of motor vehicle law. This regulation includes golf carts and mopeds.
- 10. All children 12 years and under must wear a helmet when riding a bicycle.
- 11. No rollerblading or skateboarding will be allowed on the Eastern States Exposition grounds.
- 12. All extension cords used by exhibitors MUST BE ALL RUBBERIZED TYPES AND MEET OSHA SPECIFICATIONS NO HOME TYPE EXTENSION CORDS ALLOWED.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.
In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:
I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and

limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with

such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

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In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:
I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and

limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with

such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. <u>USDF Membership Benefits:</u> USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those
 sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at
 Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are
 exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot,
 academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM
 identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program. **Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.
