1. Anyone not appearing for a scheduled ride without notifying the show office will be scratched from the rest of their remaining classes (no refunds given).

Times—posted at www.southeasthorseshows.com the Thursday before the show. Please make sure you check your ride times each day at the show in case changes have been made to the schedule.

IMPORTANT: PLEASE INCLUDE PROOF OF ALL YOUR NUMBERS AND YOUR HORSES NUMBERS ONE TIME, WE WILL KEEP IT ON FILE.

- 2. AWARDS- Gift to 1st place for each class and ribbons through 6th place. various other highpoints, drawings, etc.
- 3. STABLING-Permanent 12x12 stalls with full sliding doors. Friday 12:00 PM to Sunday 8:00 PM, Horse Stalls: \$120 This includes 2 bags of bedding per horse stall PLEASE PRE ORDER EXTRA BEDDING ON YOUR ENTRY. Extra Bedding available on grounds \$9.00 per bag. Tack Stalls \$105 (no bedding) \$30 per horse for extra nights. \$35 per horse daily grounds fee for un-stabled horses each day including Friday.

NON COMPETING HORSES: Non Competing fee is \$35, Must fill out entry form with signatures, pay \$35 office fee plus stabling or grounds fee. Neg. Coggins Required

Stall assignments will be posted on the stabling info board at entrance as well as at the show office.

- 4. ACCOMMODATIONS-Canterbury Host Hotel—Best Western Gateway Grand Phone: (352) 331-3336 RV hookups a with electric and water only are available on grounds \$38 per night. Please reserve with your entry as all hookups are locked.
- 5. FOOTING AND RINGS -20 X 60M in covered arena and warm-up rings have sand/clay mix footing. 20 x 60m in outdoor ring has fiber footing. Please lunge horses in designated area only.
- 6. DIRECTIONS— Alachua County Ag & Eq Center/Canterbury address is 23100 W Newberry Rd., Newberry, Fl 32669. From I-75 take exit 387 (Newberry Rd) And go west ~10 miles. Alachua County Ag & Eq Center is on your right hand side.



- 7. VETERNARIAN AND FARRIER- names and numbers will posted on show grounds in office, stabling info board and in show program.
- 8. REFUNDS- Full refund less office fee before closing date. After closing date office stall fees & association fees, will be

refunded if horse is withdrawn on a vet cert. or rider with a medical certificate before 1st day of the show. Class fees not refundable. All fees except office/entry fees are refunded if show if cancelled due to an act of God prior to event starting. If cancelled due to an act of God during the event cancelled class fess will be refunded. If you scratch any class (except dressage & western dressage) and add another you will not be charged for the scratched class.

- 9. SHARPS DISPOSAL: Competition management may fine any individuals including owners, exhibitors, trainers, or their agent up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Sharps disposals are available in the barn area.
- 10. Miscellaneous Rules: Dogs must be contained or leashed at all times. No lunging in designated warm up areas. No parking allowed between barns. No smoking permitted in barn area.
- 11. **IMPORTANT:** All entries shall be on the official entry form of the show. The entry form should be completed in every detail; otherwise, the record of wins may not be properly credited. The show management reserves the right to return any incomplete entry form. All entries must be accompanied by a complete payment. A fee of \$50.00 will be added to any account due if any person gives a non-negotiable check. Non-negotiable checks will be turned over to USEF.

General Information

REMINDER: All Usef Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the US Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the US Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy and the Minor Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org

IMPORTANT: All entries shall be on the official entry form of the show. The entry form should be completed in every detail; otherwise, the record of wins may not be properly credited. The show management reserves the right to return any incomplete entry form. All pre-entries and stall reservations must be accompanied by a check completely filled in for all fees. A blank check is only acceptable at the show and must be left with the secretary when picking up the show packet. If you do not add classes, the check will be returned to you after closing out your account. A fee of \$50.00 will be added to any account due if any person gives a non-negotiable check. Non-negotiable checks will be turned over to USEF per GR913.1and AHA Chapter 6 of the current handbook.

ENTRIES: All entries MUST include a copy of the following: USEF, Amateur, AHA, registration papers for each horse, and a current Coggins (within 12 months) for each horse. Proof of membership must be presented or non members will need to be paid. Owner, Rider and Trainer must sign the entry form in the spots provided. If owner and trainer are the same, owner must sign both spaces (trainer is "any adult who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody, or performance of a horse") (Rule IV, Art. 403). The entry blank provides a space for the signatures of and addresses of the trainer and owner/agent and rider each horse. Signatures are required as indicated. No person under 18 may sign as trainer (Rule IV, Article 405.1). All entry forms must be accompanied by check or money order or credit card information to cover original entries and stalls

AMATEUR REQUIREMENTS: All Amateur riders, handlers and drivers must have in their possession a current USEF Amateur Certification or make application for such with the Show Secretary at least one session prior to class.

HORSE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS: Arabian Horses must have been issued a certificate from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or, if less than one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for (Exception Art. 1699M.1) and must be entered under their full registered name.

Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabians must have been issued a certificate of registration from the AHA in the Half- Arabian or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an AHA (Canadian Part bred Arabian Register) CPAR PERMIT or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.

AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: Current Competition Level Membership is required for all owners, trainers, riders, drivers and handlers or a single event membership must be purchased for \$35 per person. A copy of all AHA membership verification should be included with your entry.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PERCOMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

HELMET REQUIREMENT

From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on noncompeting horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further © USEF 2021 DR - 23 riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meetsor exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted. Unless jackets are waived, while in the competition ring, exhibitors wearing protective headgear must wear a short, dark jacket, dark tail-coat (only permitted for tests above Fourth Level), or Armed Services or police uniform (if eligible), dark hatcovers (where applicable) and must otherwise conform to DR120 (see GR801).



Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the USDF Member Guide or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

This competition is recognized by USDF for 2022

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those
 sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at
 Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are
 exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot,
 academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequant/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan*iUSDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great

American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an

LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.
