USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1)leadline; 2)exhibitions; 3)games and races; 4)classes for 4-H members; 5)walk trot (exemption: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6)USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7)NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8)Opportunity classes; 9)citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation;10)USEA beginner novice division; and 11)assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying show management with the correct applicable numbers (USEF, AHA, USDF, WDAA) for horse, owner, rider and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

Dressage competition will be conducted according to USEF Rule XIX. 2019 USEF Tests and USDF 2015 Introductory Tests will be used. WDAA 2017 Tests will be used.

Current Competition Level Membership is required for all owners, trainers, riders/drivers/handlers or a Single Event Membership must be purchased at a fee of \$35 per person.

Ribbons and Awards Regular Class Ribbons awarded 1st – 6th

Minors Operating Motorized Vehicles

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of the rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from the operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF Drug Fee – To provide funds for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medication and drugs, each exhibitor must pay \$23 per horse (\$15 Drugs and Medications, \$8.00 Administration) entered in the show including halter and equitation horses.

Farrier and Veterinarian – In order to keep costs down we ask that you use the services of the show farrier and veterinarian, prior to seeing any customers or clients, all farriers and veterinarians must check in with the show manager to get permission to work on the show grounds and pay a vendor fee.

Effective March 1, 2011 DR 120 requires all riders at fourth level and below to wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets at any time while mounted on competition grounds. All riders under 18, all para-equestrian riders and all riders on non-competing horses must wear helmets. When a horse is competing at both the national and FEI levels, its rider must wear a helmet at all times, including any FEI tests.

Stabling

All horses must have a stall or pay a grounds fee. Requests for adjoining stalls from different owners will be honored if all entries are mailed together. Stalls are wooden with full doors. 12x12 12x10

Stalls may be occupied between 8:00am Thursday, August 18, 2022 until midnight Sunday, August 22, 2022 at the regular fee. Those planning to arrive before or after that must contact Marie Taylor to make arrangements. Early arrival fee is \$20 per stall/per day.

Feed and Bedding – There will be bedding available on the show grounds and be ordered through the Show Office. Bedding is pelleted. No first bedding will be supplied.

Technical

AHA Membership Statement – Each competitor (This includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association Recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit copy of a valid AHA Membership/Competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA Recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions. Exhibitors in Walk-Trot 10 & Under classes are exempt from AHA Membership requirements at qualifying competitions. But must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions. Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership Requirements (BOD)5/12

Class Information

Junior Exhibitor – Junior exhibitors shall not have reached their 19th birthday. For horse show purposed, the age of the junior exhibitor on December 1st of the show year shall be maintained throughout the entire year.

Amateur – Every rider having reached his/her 19th birthday prior to 12/01/11 must have in their possession an amateur card issued yearly by USEF or make application for such card at least one hour prior to showing in an Amateur class. Applications may be found in the Horse Show Office and submitted to Horse Show Secretary.

Owners Classes – Combined ownership is not permitted in Owners or Amateur Owners classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Leased horses are not eligible. Contracts of sale or bill of sale will not be accepted.

Walk-Trot/Jog – (See USEF Subchapter AR-27) Open to riders 10 years old and under. As of January 1, 1995, a rider must never have been judged in a class at a Licensed Competition that required a canter or lope. No cross entries into any other classes except halter or showmanship. Headers are permitted but not required. **NO STALLIONS ALLOWED**

ATR Walk-Trot/Jog – Open to riders of any age. Riders will be asked to walk, trot or jog both directions of the arena. Emphasis on suitability of horse to rider.

Sport Horse in-Hand – to be shown on the triangle. As per USEF AR 161.1. Marker will be used to define the triangle. Horse are walked and trotted on the perimeter of the triangle, then stop and show in an “open position” for conformation judging. The horse should stand with the neck in a natural position and the handler stands away from the horse with a loose lead. Halter championships will be determined by the two highest scores from the preceding classes of that division.

Sport Horse Under Saddle – Will follow the performance classes provisions and regulations. Class is to enter the ring counterclockwise at the trot. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. Judge my request lengthening of stride at any gait and may request horse to back, either on the rail or in the line-up.

Dressage – All classes must be pre-entered. Dressage Entries close August 10, 2022. Entries accepted by post-marked dates. First come-first schedules. If show is over subscribed a waiting list will be maintained. Official ride times will be posted by email and at the show. 2019 USEF and USDF Tests will be used. 2022 WDAA Tests will be used.

Entries – Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by a negotiable, signed valid check or Money order for the total amount. Entries shall be on the official entry form of the show. **ALL ENTRIES SHOULD BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COPY OF EACH HORSE'S REGISTRATION PAPER, CURRENT AHA & USEF MEMBERSHIP CARDS OR THE APPROPRIATE NON-MEMBER FEES (AFFIDAVITS MAY BE FILED IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE UPON ARRIVAL).** A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST WITHIN THE LAST 12 MONTHS MUST BE INCLUDED.

Health Requirements – All horses entering Virginia are required to have an official health certificate within 30 days per the Board of State Veterinarians.

Show Management may, at its sole discretion, refuse an entry of an exhibitor, or the participation of, an agent, trainer, rider or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude towards a USEF Recognized competition or displayed previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a USEF Recognized competition or towards its management, as well as those persons suspended or expelled from any previous USEF Recognized competitions by USEF.

Payment of Fees – There will be a \$100 charge for any returned checks. Stopping payment on checks or placing holds on credit card charges is in violation of USEF rules and all violations will be filed with USEF.

Failure to Check Out – Prior to leaving the show grounds, please come to the show office and settle your accounts. Failure to check out at the show office will result in a non-checkout fee of \$50.00.

Post Entries – Closing date is November 10, 2021. Entries postmarked after this date will automatically be considered Post Entries and assessed the post entry fee as shown in the fee schedule. A United Postal Service postmark will take precedence over postmarks from private meters, etc.

Condition of Entry – The Show Committee and the Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel an entry, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and remove from the grounds any individual, stable or both without claim for damages. The submitting of an entry form to the show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

Refunds – Withdrawal of entries must be made in writing and accompanied by a vet certificate. Those received before entry closing date will be refunded all fees except office fees. After entry closing all fees will be refunded except the stall and office fee. During the show only class fees, less classes already shown will be refunded, exception, no refunds in dressage or western dressage classes.

Protests – See USEF Chapter 6

Indemnity and Responsibility – All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the Airfield 4-H Center or Heritage Arabian Horse Association, the Show Committee, nor any Show Official, will be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but the solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, and the exhibitor shall indemnify the above mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof.

Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Eligibility to Compete – Horses shown in this section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian and/or Anglo-Arabian Registry. Or have been issued an Arabian Horse Association (Canadian Part Bred Arabian Registry) CPAR permits or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for, and must be entered under their full registered name USEF rule XVI Article 1699V.1

Arabian Registry Eligibility to Compete – Horses to be shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. and/or the Canadian Horse Registry or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration be applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

Quarter Horses participating in the open Western Dressage must send in a copy of papers. Rider must be a member of WDAA. USEF Membership is required if showing Amateur and in the HOY program.

This horse show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the USEF. The official rule book of USEF will prevail for this show. This prize list is based on rules of the current rule book and the handbook of the Arabian Horse Association, where they apply respectively; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the prize list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF rules. Questions not covered by USEF rules shall be decided by the show committee and its decisions will be final. By entering the show, each exhibitor agrees to abide by the final decision of the Show Committee and USEF Steward.

Procedures

Admission to the Arena – No person will be permitted to enter the arena except participants in the class, judges and their assistants, show photographer and assistant, show officials and stall. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by the judge.

Judges – In the event of illness or failure of a judge or any other official to attend this show or to perform his/her duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one who was officially designated in the prize list, according to USEF rules.

Calls for Classes – Courtesy to our exhibitors, the public address system will be used to make barn calls whenever possible. However, exhibitors are responsible for seeing the entries reach the gate on time and should not rely solely on the P.A. system. Classes will be called promptly. The paddock manager should be notified of any special requirements and he/she may delay opening the gate for the next class for very brief accommodations. Please check your class schedule and make arrangements for tack changes. Tack holds will only be granted to Back to Back classes and will be for 3 minutes per USEF rules.

Two Minute Rule – The gate will be closed two minutes after opening for a class. This procedure must be followed. Your Cooperation is appreciated.

Cancellation of Classes – The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class to accommodate for an insufficient or excessive number of entries. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this prize list. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to these rules.

Ring Dimensions – 3 Rings 250'x100' sand mixture.

Stalls 10x10 or 12x12 Wooden sides with full sliding doors.

Take Route 460 to Wakefield. East bound traffic turn right at the signal light on Route 460 onto Route 628. West bound traffic turn left at the signal light on Route 628. Go 5 ½ miles on Route 628. Turn right onto Turkey Pen Road and go ¾ of a mile. The Airfield Conference Center Entrance is on the left.

From Richmond, VA – Take I-95 or I-295 South to Petersburg. Take Route 460 East towards Suffolk/Virginia Beach. In Wakefield follow the above directions.

From Norfolk, VA – Take I 264 West to Bowers Hill area and pick up Route 58 West towards Suffolk. Follow Route 58 until you see the exit to 460 West. Turn onto Route 460 West until you get to Wakefield. Follow the above directions.

Sharps Containers – Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitor or their agents, up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. **Competition management will place a notice of this requirement either in its prize list or on a specific handout given to trainers on check in at the competition.** If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail. GR 1210.4

Equine Vaccination Rule – 1. At federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration by or under the direction of a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations, name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody and control of the horse, name serial number and expiration date of the vaccine and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward or technical delegate when requested. 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.

I AGREE, in consideration for my participation as a competitor, and therefore a representative of the United States and the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the National Federation), to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, or as parent or guardian of an exhibitor under 18 years of age. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Federation from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me, or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and to hold it harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me, or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me, or my horse at the Competition.

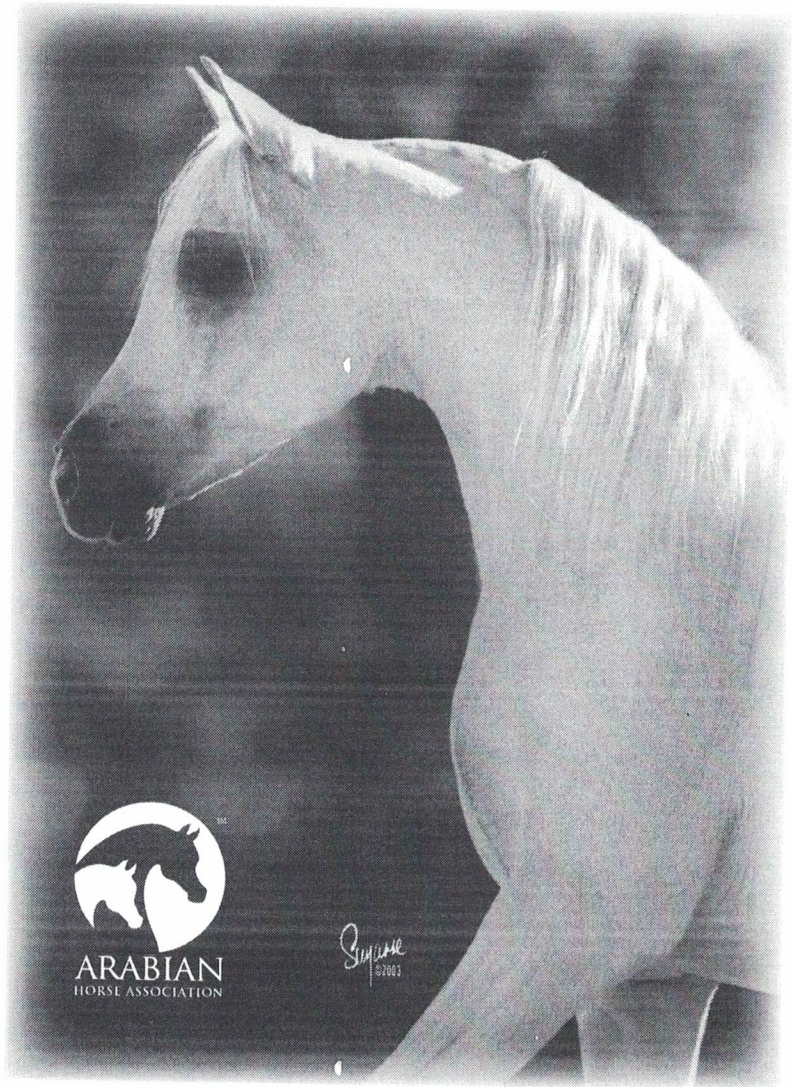

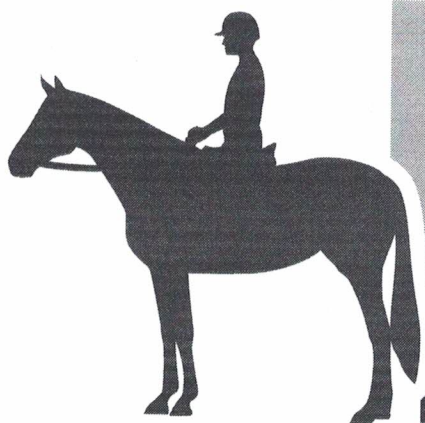
