Class Fees: \$45 per class entry. Include copy of current coggins, signed entry agreement and vaccination certificate with the on line entry. Online entries must be received by the closing date. [Enter online at StriderPro.com](https://www.striderpro.com). Entries received after the closing date will only be accepted online and if there is available space. A \$30 post entry fee will apply. No entry will be accepted without a negative coggins, signature, and full payment.

Stabling: Six stalls are available. Stalls are \$60.00 per show. Shavings are available for purchase at \$10.00 per bag. No hay or grain will be available. Stalls will be assigned on a first requested, first pay basis. Stalls will be available at 1PM on the day prior to the show.

Refunds: There will be no refunds for any reason after the closing date. Before closing date, full refunds minus the \$45 office fee.

Dogs: All dogs must be kept in trailer parking area and attached to a responsible person at all times.

Awards: Ribbons 1st-6th place and Champion and Reserve for high percentage test in each level with at least 3 entries awarded at the end of each day.

Ties: The competitor with the highest scores for Collective Marks shall be declared the winner of the tie; In the event a tie remains, the competitor with the highest Collective Mark scores by the judge sitting at C shall be declared the winner of the tie; In the event a tie still remains, the competitor with the highest free walk score shall be declared the winner; In the event there is a tie on the free walk, the competitor with the highest sum of scores with coefficients greater than one shall be declared the winner; If a tie remains, the judge(s) must break the tie.

Dressage Tests: 2022 WDAA tests. All tests may be read. Horse/Rider combinations may show in only 2 consecutive levels.

Combining/Splitting of Tests/Classes: Tests may be combined if there are less than 3 entries. Tests may be split if there are more than 12 entries or at management's discretion. If you do not indicate your level on your entry form you will automatically be entered as open.

USEF Lite: Specific shows are USEF Lite recognized. Membership is required to be eligible for HOTY points. Anyone listed as Trainer or Coach must be a USEF competing member. Licensee #5942929.

WDAA: This show is recognized by the Western Dressage Association of America. If you wish for your points to count toward WHLPAP awards, you must join the WDAA prior to the show, and include your WDAA number on your entry form.

Management, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

Headgear: GR801.8. Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, the Federation strongly encourages all riders, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear protective headgear with harness secured. (Exception hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions refer to GR801.2) It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

Attire: Riders may compete wearing a suitable western hat, boots, long sleeve shirts with any collar, and trousers or pants as permitted in WD123.1. Jackets or vests and necktie or kerchief of any type are allowed but not required. Chaps or spurs are allowed as specified in WD123.2. Protective headgear may be worn without penalty as per GR801.

Ride Times: Ride times will be available the Thursday prior to the show.

## USEF LITE COMPETITION

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my status as a Fan. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. USEF may in its sole discretion, at any time, terminate my USEF Fan status.
