BLUE RIDGE ARABIAN CLASSIC RULES & REGULATIONS

EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT A NON-RETURNABLE COPY OF

EACH HORSE'S COGGINS & VACCINE RECORDS WITH THEIR ENTRIES

1. Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. (or in the case of foreign entry, have been issued a competition visa by the AHR of America), and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for (Exception AR101 and must be entered under their full registered name.
2. **DISCIPLINE:** Exhibitors are cautioned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver or their families will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove an owner, lessee, trainer, groom, horse, rider, driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Show management will be charged with the responsibility of enforcing all USEF and AHA rules. Questions not covered are decided by management and are final.
3. **INDEMNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither Virginia Horse Center, its officers, the Show, The Show Committee, Show Officials nor any of its sponsors will be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, and the exhibitor shall indemnify the above mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. THE SUBMITTING OF AN ENTRY FORM TO THE SHOW SHALL
- CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERSON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.
4. **PROTEST:** Must be filed in accordance with the USEF rules and be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 for members or parent(s) of junior exhibitor(s) and \$300 for nonmembers which will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained (See GR603).
5. **PARKING:** No trailers or vehicles will be allowed to be parked in the barn area. No electrical cords may be run from any barn. If found, a hook-up charge of \$50 per night will be charged.
6. **ARENA:** Indoor open THURSDAY 11am until 11pm. NO LUNGING HORSES IN THE INDOOR ARENA, DESIGNATED LUNGING AREA IS LOCATED BEHIND THE WILEY ARENA. Sizes 125' x 250' - Footing sand/sawdust mix, main and warm-up rings. No person will be permitted to enter the arena, upon the start of the show, except participants in the class, judges and their assistants, show photographer and assistant, show officials and staff. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena unless summoned by the judge.
7. **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:** by the Show Veterinarian or Farrier outside the ring will be on a Private Fee Basis. The name and phone number of the vet will be posted at the show office.
8. **CALLS FOR CLASSES:** Classes called promptly. Two minute clock begins when the gate opens, the in-gate MUST be closed at the end of 2 minutes after the 1st horse enters the ring (GR109.2(a)) If the same horses are entered in back to back classes, a tack hold should be arranged with the paddock. Maximum of 3 minutes allowed. Always check-in with the paddock master.

Problems with mechanical devices like the PA system can happen - paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure his horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry calls, no protest will be upheld nor will any section be changed on the basis of a PA system malfunction. Management has the right to cancel any class not filled or change classes/arenas in case of bad weather.

9. AGE OF INDIVIDUALS: for show purposes, an individual's age on December 1 shall be maintained throughout the entire year. Born December 1 assumes the greater age of that date.
10. INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW: Failure to settle Indebtedness to the show will result in being barred from taking part in USEF Recognized Shows until settlement is made. USEF (GR913). Remedies available to the show under USEF rules for non-collect ability of checks show management will assess a fee of \$100.00 if a check is returned unpaid. Unless, secretary confirms arrangements, each exhibitor who leaves at close of the show without settling any fees, will be assessed a \$50.00 service fee for sending a bill. All fees will be settled at time of checkout.
11. REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The Show Committee and the Management reserve the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel any entry, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and remove from the grounds any individual, stable or both without claim for damages. The submitting of an entry form to the show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions herein set forth. See USEF GR914
12. ENTRIES: All entries MUST be sent with a current copy of membership cards for AHA,

USEF, USDF, WDAA or a fee of \$30 per person will be charged, AHA Competition Membership Cards or a Single Event Membership fee of \$45.00 per person MUST be paid. Current Horse Registration and a Coggins test dated within the last (12 mos) also required. No entry will be processed without copies unless you are applying for membership at the show. The entry blank provides space for signatures, address of the trainer, owner or agent, rider, driver, handler of each entry. Under age 18 may not sign as trainer, USEF GR906-909 ALL MONEY MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM AND BE PAID BEFORE NUMBERS CAN BE ISSUED (NO OPEN CHECKS. ALL ENTRIES SENT WITH AN OPEN CHECK WILL BE CHARGED A POST ENTRY FEE PER HORSE!!).

Absolutely no numbers will be given out without all cards and papers when you check in with the show office.

13. An OPEN/SIGNED CHECK will be required to add any classes or bedding, etc at the show. Any additional charges must be paid before leaving the show grounds. Any unpaid charges will be invoiced within 30 days and will be assessed a \$50.00 service fee. Failure to pay within 30 days will be considered an unsportsmanlike act and may result in actions taken against such conduct in accordance with USEF rules. There will be a \$100 charge for any checks returned.
14. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: In accordance with USEF rules, all juniors riding in Hunt Seat Equitation Over Fences and Not to Jump, Hunter Over Fences and Jumper classes must wear protective headgear passing applicable ASTM standards (must be stamped inside helmet) while riding in designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds.
15. DRESSAGE EXHIBITORS please refer to USEF DR 120 for protective headgear rules

16. **SHOWING OUT OF TRAILER: IS NOT PERMITTED.** A day stall fee of \$50 per day will be charged if a regular show stall is not purchased for your horse. You may arrive the evening before to get settled in. If you stay an additional day you must notify the show office. If present when stalls are counted daily you will be billed for that day.
17. **SMOKING:** Smoking in the barns is prohibited. This safety rule will be strictly enforced. Please Note: Fines may be levied.
18. **BEDDING:** Please preorder bedding, if you will be arriving after 8pm on any night you will not receive bedding unless a pre-order was placed with the stable office (then bedding will be waiting for you in your stalls). There will not be anyone on the grounds to distribute bedding after 8pm. Orders for additional bedding must be requested at the VHC barn office daily.
19. **POST ENTRIES:** Pre-Entries close on March 25, 2024. Entries postmarked after this date will automatically be considered Post Entries and assessed the post entry fee as shown in the fee schedule. A United Postal Service postmark will take precedence over postmarks from private meters, etc. Extra classes for pre-entered horses will not be post entries, however, no horse may be substituted for horses already entered. Entry blanks must be completed and returned before the closing date. Post entry fee will be charged if postmarked after the closing date. **DO NOT MAIL AFTER March 25, 2024 - DO YOUR ENTRIES ONLINE OR BRING WITH YOU TO THE SHOW and CALL Kim Dickinson for STALLS.**
20. **REFUND POLICY:** Withdrawal of entries must be made in writing and accompanied by a vet certificate. Those received before the closing date will be refunded all fees except office fee. After the closing date, until the start of the show, all fees will be refunded except office, one class and stall fee. Post entry fees will be retained. No refunds on stall fees after closing date. Refund of AHA/USEF fees applies only if the horse isn't shown at all. If Vetting out of the horse's remaining classes, the exhibitor/owner must inform the office at the time the horse is taken out of the last class that it will not be shown again. No Refunds in Sport Horse in Hand, Dressage and Trail classes for any reason!
21. **ENTRY AND SCRATCH POLICY:** Entries being Added **MUST** be made by the end of the session prior to the session being entered, not during breaks, as the office may be closed. Horses entering the ring without prior entry in the office will be charged a \$10 gate fee. Class fees will be refunded if you scratch your class before the class prior to yours is lined up. Qualifying Class **MUST** be scratched in office or by signature with Paddock Master. Championships **MUST** be scratched in Office Only. Use this order or no refund. Last class fee for a horse will be kept.
22. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense.

Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties.

23. Show Officials - In the event of illness or failure of a judge or any other official to attend this show or to perform his duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one who was officially designated in the prize list, according to USEF rules.
24. Food Service will be available on the show grounds.
25. Sharps Containers - One sharps container per 50 occupied stalls will be available for the disposal of needles and other sharp instruments in the barns. Competition management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or other agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of sharps. This includes disposable safety razors!! USEF GR1210.4

26. NEW IN 2024: PER GR1215.4: For 6 consecutive hours overnight, stabling must have minimal lighting and noise to allow stabled horses adequate rest.

***** STABLE LIGHTING WILL BE REDUCED FROM 11PM - 5AM *****

27. SAFESPORT - All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
28. Stabling - Permanent box stalls are required for all horses staying overnight. VHC has fireproof barns containing spacious 10'x12' stalls with steel mesh doors. Each barn features interior wash racks, and rest rooms. All horses must have a stall. No tie outs. Requests for adjoining stalls from different owners will be honored if all entries are mailed together. NOTHING should be hung from the electrical conduit along the tops of the stalls.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, Senior active and Junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule:

1. leadline;
2. exhibitions;
3. games and races;
4. classes for 4-H members;
5. walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program);
6. USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes;
7. NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions.
8. Opportunity classes,
9. citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation,
10. USEA beginner novice division; and
11. assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Each Competitor (This Includes At Least One Recorded Owner And All Trainers, Drivers, Riders, Halter Handlers, Coaches And The Person(S) Signing The Entry Blank) In An Arabian Horse Association Recognized Arabian Division, At The Time Of Entry Into A Competition, Must Submit A Copy Of A Valid AHA Membership/Competition Card, Join AHA Or Pay An AHA Single Event Membership Fee Per Competitor.

When An Agent Signs For The Owner At An AHA Recognized Competition, Both The Owner And Agent Must Be Members Of AHA Or Pay The AHA Single Event Membership. Single Event Membership Is Not Acceptable At AHA Regional Or National Competitions. Exhibitors In Walk-Trot Classes Are Exempt From AHA Membership Requirements At Qualifying Competitions, But Must Have An AHA Membership With Competition Card At AHA Regional And National Competitions. Exhibitors In Lead Line Classes Or Parents/Guardians Signing For Minors Are Exempt From AHA Membership Requirements. (Bod 5/12)

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Exhibitors are encouraged to read the FEDERATION rulebook, and particularly Chapter AR, for the complete Arabian horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: The rated Sections of this Competitions are official USEF point competitions for the USEF National and USEF Service Company Zone Horse of the Year Awards Programs. Exhibitors encouraged to read USEF Rule book, particularly CHAPTER AR, for the complete Arabian horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR: Junior exhibitors shall not have reached their 19th birthday. For horse show purposes, the age of the junior exhibitor on December 1 of the show year shall be maintained throughout the entire year.

AMATEUR: Every rider having reached his/her 19th birthday prior to 12/1 must have in their possession an amateur card issued yearly by USEF or make application for such card at least one hour prior to showing in an Amateur class.

OWNERS CLASSES - Combined ownership is not permitted in Owners or Amateur Owners classes unless all owners are members of the same family. For competition purposes the term "family" includes husband, wife, parent, step-parent, child, brother, step-child, sister, half-brother, half-sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather, and in-laws of the same relations as stated above. Leased horses are not eligible. Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR140. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted). USEF AR101.2

FOR ALL EQUITATION RULES: Refer to USEF Rule AR25, 219-225.

WALK TROT/JOG -- (See USEF AR231) Open to riders 10 years old & under. As of January 1, 1997, a rider must have never been judged in a class at licensed competition that required a canter or lope. No cross entries into any other classes except halter for showmanship. **NO STALLIONS ALLOWED.** One header per horse during line-up; a plain, unmarked smock is required.

LEADLINE - Rider 2 to 6 years of age and never shown alone, no cross-entry is allowed into any other class in the show. If the horse entered is not entered in any other class in the show, stall fee, and office fee must be paid. **STALLIONS NOT ALLOWED.** Leaders must be at least 14 years of age. One rider per horse. AHA 237

ANGLO-ARABIANS - All Half Arabian classes are open to Anglo Arabians. HA/AA colts/stallions may compete in weanling and yearling halter classes for Geldings; however, HA/AA colts/stallions two years old and older are excluded from all halter classes.

PB/HA HALTER The following procedures shall be followed in all breeding classes, including gelding IH classes. Competition management shall have the option of choosing one of the two class procedures: (1) In the ring class procedure (2) exit the ring class procedure. This show shall use the "IN THE RING CLASS PROCEDURE" (see USEF AR107 - 108). For championship classes, horses will return and be judged comparatively.

AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook / Directory and Competition Prize List and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:
I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.
I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.
By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.
This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

- A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.
- B. 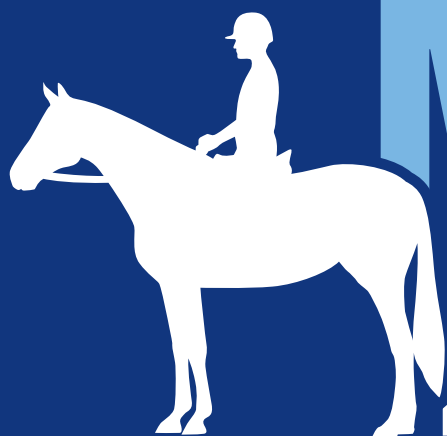

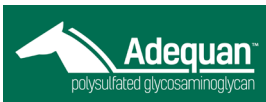

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

Committed to serving the needs, well-being, and safety of both rider and horse, the VHCF supports a 600-acre competition facility that serves over 500,000 people and 100,000 animals of all breeds and disciplines. The VHCF manages 115 events annually, most free and open to the public. Host to the Hoofbeats Therapeutic Riding Center, the Foundation's mission is to enrich lives with programs focused on recreation, education, and preservation.



DIRECTIONS TO THE VIRGINIA HORSE CENTER:

From the North: 1-81 South to Exit 191. Proceed on I-64 West to Exit 55. Turn right on Route 11 North, and immediately left on Route 39 West. One mile ahead on the left.

From the South: 1-81 North to Exit 191, then same as above.

From the East: I-64 West to I-81 South, then same as above.

From the West: I-64 East to Exit 55. Turn left on Route 11 North, and proceed 1/4 mile to the stoplight.

Turn left on Route 39 West. One mile ahead on the left.
