### **Important Note on Scheduling:**

We normally run all USDF Intro tests, WDAA Intro and Basic tests, all USEA Eventing tests, and all USA WE tests in the small arena (20x40m). If you are planning on riding USDF Intro and also USEF Training level then you most likely will have one ride in the morning and one in the afternoon. We do our best to let you ride your lower test before your higher level test but that is not always possible in the schedule. If you have questions on which tests to choose based on this information – please contact Simone.

**There has been an increase of EHV-1 in the United States – we therefore require proof of vaccination (flu/rhino) within 6 months of participation. We recommend that your horse has been vaccinated at least 14 days before the show to achieve immunity. You can show proof via a vet bill or the receipt of vaccine purchase if you administer it yourself.**

**Stall strip fee: \$50 (you must provide a separate check for this when you check in – upon confirmation that you have stripped your stall we will return your check to you).**

***Please note – no shavings are available – you must bring your own.***

**Entries:** Use the entry link on the Classical Horse Club website (available at <https://www.classicalhorse.org>)

Online entries are available using PayPal – you do not need to create a PayPal account to use this option. Ride times will be sent via e-mail and will be posted on the website.

**Refunds:** Up to Aug 11, 2023 all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to the day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition no refunds including Acts of God. ***Office fee is non-refundable.***

**Awards:** Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place all divisions. First place prizes. Management reserves the right to break ties.

**Highpoints:** Classical Horse Club is excited to offer three very special highpoints as follows: There will be one highpoint and one reserve highpoint to the overall highest scoring Iberian horses. There will be one highpoint and one reserve highpoint to the overall highest scoring Half-Iberian horses. There will be one highpoint and reserve highpoint to the overall highest scoring horses of any breed. The highpoint will be calculated based on a golf score. Example: You compete as an amateur and there are 5 other amateurs in your class. You win the class you get 5 points; you are second you get 4 points and so on. The horse/rider combination with the overall most points over three days will get the highpoint, the second highest points will get reserve. You may enter as many classes as you wish.

**Directions:** Take I-25 to the Plum Creek Exit #181. Turn left at the signal onto Plum Creek Parkway. Go east on Plum Creek Parkway, approximately one mile to Fairgrounds Road (the 3rd signal light). Turn left on Fairgrounds Road. Once you are on the Fairgrounds keep going east between indoor arena and admin building until you get to end of road. Turn left (north) and follow along the indoor arena to parking and barns.

**An ASTM safety helmet is required at all times while mounted (exception for Western Dressage and WE competitors over the age of 18). No dogs are allowed on the show grounds.**

**There are several restaurants and fast-food choices within a 5-mile radius.**
