ENTRIES

Accepted on first come, first serve basis by mail ONLY. One entry per horse/rider combination. Opening date is February, 3rd, 2023. Closing date is March 18th. If you cancel by postmarked date of March 18th 2023 (with written notice) you will be refunded all monies paid except the office fee per each horse/rider entry of \$25.00. *NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE*

A \$50 NSF fee will be charged for all returned checks.

Entry Cancellation/Refunds: Office fee is not refundable. Entries with written cancellation on or before the closing date will receive 100% refund of all fees minus the \$25 office fee. NO REFUNDS after Closing Date even if original Closing date is extended. Entries must be received by 6:00 pm on the closing date.

Ride Times: Ride times will be sent by email and will also be posted on our Website at http://www.wdaaz.org. Email provided on your entry form must be valid and legible.

You are responsible to keep track of your scheduled rides. If you are not back at the arena to ride your test, you will be considered a scratch and no refund will be given.

No Shows: All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled. **Scratches During Show:** Competitors have responsibility to inform the Show Manager or Secretary at the Show Office of their intent to scratch a ride prior to the scheduled ride time. Scratches are not refundable.

ARENAS/FOOTING:

Competition arenas are 20m X 60m with sand/dirt footing mixture. A sand/dirt footing mixture arena is available for warm-up, with a separate lunging area. Lunging is allowed only in the designated lunging area and not in the warm-up area during the show.

NOTE: When schooling in the warm-up or competition arena, ALL riders must wear their bridle number.

Food/Concessions: A Food Truck will be available on the grounds for food and drink purchases.

Parking: No car or trailer parking between the barns and arenas. Trailers must be parked in the designated areas. Do not block the fire lanes.

Awards: Award and ribbon to 1st place in each division, ribbon for 2nd through 6th place in each division. Ties will be broken by the Collective Marks on Score Card.

Management: Show management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and/or cancel awards of prizes without claims for damages &

change order of classes, cancel, split, or combine classes at its discretion if entries deem necessary.

General Information:

Dogs: Dogs are only allowed on a short leash and controlled at all times. You must clean up after your dog.

Horse/Rider combination must be the same and may enter no more than two consecutive levels and a maximum of 4 tests.

Horses cannot be ridden by more than two (2) riders. Each rider/horse combination will require a separate entry fee and entry form. Rides will be limited to 4 tests per horse/rider combination.

Rules will be governed by the United States Equestrian Federation and WDAA. Rules are in force from the moment you enter the grounds.

Riders are required to clean up after their horses.

Riders need to provide their own callers.

Western riding attire is boots, long sleeve shirt, trousers, a Western hat or ATSM (American Society For Testing and Materials) rated helmet. If wearing a Western hat, you are required to sign a Helmet Waiver.

It is the rider's responsibility to go to: WDAA Equipment and Attire Guide on their Website: <u>https://www.westerndressageassociation.org</u>. One third of the riders will be checked by the Ring Steward AFTER your rides for legal Equipment & Attire. Classical Riding Attire is boots (tall or paddock boots with half chaps), breeches, long sleeve shirt, and a ATSM Helmet.

All liability forms for WDAAZ and Carefree Farms Liability forms must be completed and on file at Registration

Copies of your Coggins Test and Health Certificate to be provided at Registration for any out of state horse.

WDAAZ Release, Wavier, & Hold Harmless Agreement

Agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk, serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to hold WDAAZ, the competition and their officials, directors, employees, and volunteers harmless from and against all claims including claims based on negligence, breach of contract, strict liability and/or otherwise for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition, officials, directors, employees, or volunteers of the WDAAZ competition.
