What Is Working Equitation?

Working Equitation is a competitive sport that showcases classical horsemanship applied for livestock management. The sport originated in Europe, and consists of four trials. Dressage, Ease of Handling, Speed and Cattle trials are completed to test the training and partnership of each horse and rider team.

Competitions are open to all breeds (including mules, donkeys and gaited horses), and all styles of riding. Dressage consists of

completing a prescribed pattern of movements judged on a scale of 0-10. Ease of Handling consists of completing an obstacle course with balance and precision. Each obstacle is scored on a scale of 0-10.

Lidia Taylor is a USA Working Equitation licensed "r" judge and Technical Delegate. She has been teaching for 3 decades focusing on rider biomechanics, correct timing and application of the aids, and extensive use of school figures and exercises to address training issues, having studied the all important basics under Mr. Karl Mikolka, former Chief Rider of the Spanish Riding School of Vienna. Lidia is certified by the American Riding Instructor's Association as Level II Dressage, Driving, and Recreational Riding and Level III Western Dressage instructor and is a proud graduate of the Western Dressage Association of America's Train the Trainer program.



Clinic Details:

The clinic will consist of two days of instruction with both unmounted lecture/instruction and mounted group instruction. All disciplines and all breeds are welcome! Participants new to the sport will learn the basics of the sport of Working Equitation as they receive instruction in Dressage and Ease of Handling. Riders with experience in working equitation will have the opportunity to fine tune skills with more advanced instruction.

SHOW GUIDELINES & RULES

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

This horse show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Arabian Horse Division. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. This premium list is based on the rules of the current Rule Book. Any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. The Show Committee shall decide questions not covered by USEF rules and its decisions will be final.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

AHA REQUIREMENTS:

- A) At Chile Roast AVS Show, all exhibitors entered in A/HA/AA classes must be a current AHA member with a competition card, join AHA at the show, or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$35.00 per person. This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse. A photocopy of your AHA membership card must accompany your entry. No Single Event Memberships are available at the Region 8 Championship Show.
- B) AHA Membership affidavits are no longer available. If you do not have your AHA card you must pay the single event Member fee.
- C) There is an AHA fee of \$10.00 per horse for Chile Roast AVS Show (\$5 AHA judges' commission and education/evaluation, Resolution 9-90 and \$5 AHA per horse fee) for all Arabian Recognized classes offered.

Half-Arabians and Anglo-Arabians: Horses shown in this section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the International Arabian Horse Association or the Arabian Horse Association or the Canadian Partbred Arabian Register as a Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian, **or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.**

ARENAS: Arena 1: 300' x 105'. Arena 2: 300' x 145'. Arena 3: 300' x 150', Arena 4: 300' x 190'. Arena 5 150' x 200' All are outdoor. Footing in all arenas and warm up areas is sandy loam. **Arena 1 (Court) will be available after 2pm Thursday September 7th. Arena 2 will be available starting at 9am for schooling on Thursday September 7th. Arena 3 (trail) will be available 9:00 Friday September 8th. Jumping arena 4 will be available starting at 9am Friday September 8th. Arena 5 (Working Equitation Clinic) will be available starting after 5pm Friday September 8th.

BAD CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: There will be a \$50.00 handling fee charged for any returned check or declined credit card. Action in accordance with USEF rules will be taken against any owner, exhibitor or trainer who does not make a returned check/declined credit card charge good and will be reported to AHA.

BARN OFFICE: Barn manager is Margie Billau (505) 980-6806. Early arrival or late departure is \$25 per day per stall used. **HIPICO SANTA FE/OR AHANM IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ITEMS LEFT UNATTENDED OR DAMAGED WHILE ON GROUNDS.**

CALL FOR CLASSES: The two-minute gate will be enforced. The gate will close two minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than two minutes, after the entry of the final horse in a continuous string of horses. If tack changes are necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the gate person and request a three-minute gate hold. Note: Due

to unforeseeable problems with the mechanical devices, the paddock and barn calls over the PA system must be considered a COURTESY. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES DUE TO EMERGENCIES: If a class, or a series of classes, or all or part of the competition is cancelled due to an accident, storm, or other emergency after the start of the show (defined as initial Move-In Day), no refund of entry fees will be made. Classes are subject to change. Weather delays are possible and may affect the schedule. Show management reserves the right to delay or postpone classes as necessary.

DOGS: Dogs will be permitted on the show grounds but MUST be always on leashes. No dogs will be allowed in the show arena. This is a USEF Yellow Warning card offense (GR1037 & GR1301.6).

DRESSAGE CLASSES: FOR DRESSAGE/WESTERN DRESSAGE—POST ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER AUGUST 23RD***

Dressage classes may not run in order listed in the schedule. Maximum of 55 rides/day available – Maximum of three (3) rides per horse/day. Dressage entries must be mailed or e-mailed and postmarked or e-mail time will determine order of entry. No hand carried entries accepted. Ride Times will be available on the AHANM Website <https://www.nmarabs.org> and on Facebook. Once ride times are sent/posted they will not change. **Dressage Coordinator is Teresa Heine hawaiianwhitechick@yahoo.com. Horses wishing to ride same test once and have AQHA, AHA, All Breed and WDAA points may pay for each class fee and use same test/score.

ENTRIES: All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show or on the online entry system. A horse must be entered in the name of his registered owner(s) only and must be entered under its full registered name. A photocopy of all AHA membership cards and registration papers must accompany your entry form or be uploaded to the online entry system. All entries must be accompanied by a valid check or money order for the full amount of all fees made out to AHANM. A signature is required by the parent if a minor is showing. *No entries will be accepted with open checks. All entries must be paid in full. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Open checks will only be accepted for post entries.* Exhibitor Numbers will be released to exhibitors ONLY when ALL the fees, signatures and information are complete. **Closing Date for Entries –8/23/23. Emailed entries are accepted. CC payment, QR online payment, or open check must be provided for back number to be released at check-in. NO EXCEPTIONS. Cash may be paid at end of show, however, open check or cc on file is required during the show to compete.**

FARRIER: A Farrier will be available on call for show grounds.

FEED & BEDDING: Feed and bedding is available for purchase from the show office/barn manager. Please pre-order shavings on entry. Additional shavings may be purchased after arrival from show office. No outside shavings allowed on site. Shavings must be purchased through the show office @ \$13.50/bag. Preorder with Margie 505-980-6806. Tabs will be maintained on your show bill.

HEALTH REGULATIONS: All out-of-state horses must have a negative Coggins Test dated within twelve (12) months (must be original not photocopied). All out-of-state horses must also be accompanied by an Official Health Certificate issued within 30 days of arrival that identifies the animals listed, including all vaccinations, and date and results of required test. THE ABOVE ITEMS SHOULD BE CARRIED WITH YOU – DO NOT FORWARD WITH YOUR ENTRY. Any animals brought into New Mexico must observe all regulations of the State of New Mexico, Animal Health Division. Any horse that develops a communicable disease must be removed from the show grounds.

INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW: Any exhibitor who fails to settle his/her indebtedness to this show will automatically be reported to AHA.

JUDGES: This show will be judged according to the single judge systems. If an official is unable to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official according to USEF rules. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging and any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the Show Committee. No contact shall be made with the Judges during the period of the show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee designated by the committee for such purpose. Further, no exhibitor shall approach a Judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permissions from the Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Golf Carts and Other Motorized Vehicles – To operate any motorized vehicle on the New Mexico State Fairgrounds, you must have a valid driver's license or operator's license as defined by the state in which you reside. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule. Golf carts must be registered with NMSF to be driven anywhere on the fairgrounds.

****Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.**

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

POST ENTRIES: NO Post Entries will be accepted for Dressage or Western Dressage classes. Post entries will be accepted for all other Chile Roast AVS with an added Class Fee of \$5/class. Entry close date is August 23, 2023.

PRIZE LIST CHANGES AND/OR CORRECTIONS: Changes and/or corrections to the Premium, if any, will be posted on the Club's website www.nmarabs.org and Facebook page for AHANM.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES/PROTESTS: The show Management will be governed by USEF rules with respect to refusal of entries. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. **Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason including but not limited to unsportsmanlike like conduct and animal cruelty.**

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS: Horses shown in the Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and must be entered under their full registered name. Horses shown in the Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry and entered under their registered name.

RESPONSIBILITY: All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither Arabian Horse Association of New Mexico nor the Hipico Santa Fe will be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to any horse exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any person, animal or property occasioned by him or his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Arabian Horse Association of New Mexico and the Hipico Santa Fe against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may be the result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions herein set forth.

SCRATCHING CLASSES: No refund of entry fee when scratching classes.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: The Show Office will be open at 2pm September 7th. Check-in appointments are encouraged for groups of 6 or more. The show office will remain open throughout the show and will close 30 minutes after the last class of the show each day. Please remember to check out after your last class. Failure to close out checks will be consent for secretary to close your check.

STALLIONS are not allowed in showmanship or walk-trot classes.

STALLS: Horse Stalls & Tack Stalls are available for \$25 a night or single day. Stalls and alleyways must be kept clean. Horse tie out is available with a ground tie fee of \$25 per day per horse, no overnight. Stalls can be reserved by sending in the appropriate stall

fees, but no stalls will be held without payment. Early Arrival/Late Departure is \$25/stall/night. Stalls are 10 x 10 with a door. Early or Late Arrivals, please contact the Barn Manager.

VETERINARIAN: A veterinarian will not be on the fairgrounds. Information for the closest vet will be posted at Show Office.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: Entries may be scratched from the show PRIOR TO 8/23/23 with a refund of all fees EXCEPT the office fee. After that date, withdrawals accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show will receive refunds of class entry fees only. No refunds for scratched classes—No exceptions.

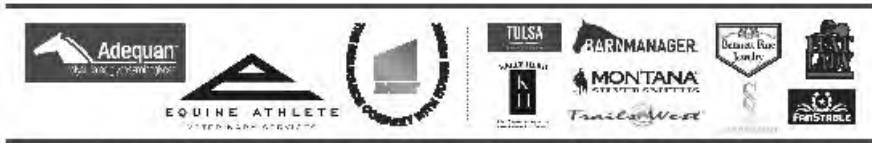

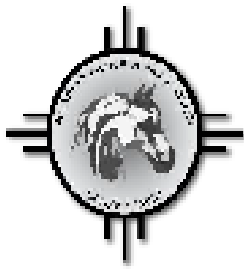

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook / Directory and Competition Prize List and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLIGENCE OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s) qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.

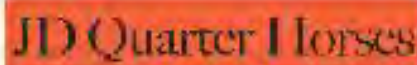
