If additional forms are needed, please make copies of <u>both sides</u> of all forms.
- 2. Complete name and address of Registered Owner MUST appear in space for Owner Information. ONE OWNER ONLY per form. If a horse(s) is owned by a farm or any other entity, a USEF Farm Recording must be current for the 2022 competition year either by an Annual or Lifetime Recording or pay a USEF Show Pass Fee. Applications for Farm Recording will be available in the Show office. The USEF Farm Recording number must be used as the Owner USEF number. AHA also requires the farm/entity must have an AHA Business Membership or pay a \$35 AHA Single Event Fee and that the Business Membership number must be used as the Owner AHA number. A copy of the Business Membership card must accompany the entry.

- DRESSAGE exhibitors MUST include copies of USDF, CDS and WDAA membership cards with their entries. If showing in Western Dressage, the Owner, Trainer & Rider MUST be a current member of WDAA or each will be required to pay the WDAA non-member fee of \$35.00 (new 2022).
- 10. INCOMPLETE ENTRY FEE (not to exceed \$20) may be assessed on any entry received that is illegible, incomplete, or incorrect. All required information must be clear, easily read, and correct. An entry will be considered incomplete if there are missing copies of registration papers, missing copies of AHA, USEF and/or USDF cards for trainers, owners, rider, or handlers, missing signatures, missing or incorrect payment for entries, missing or incomplete forms, etc.

DOGS AND PETS The state humane officer requires <u>all dogs to be leashed AT ALL TIMES</u>. This rule will be strictly enforced. Owner assumes all liability for pet animals.

DRESSAGE All dressage classes are open to Arabian, Half Arabian & Anglo Arabian horses. Standard arena size will be used; current USEF tests will be ridden. Western Dressage use 2022 tests. Classes will not be scheduled in number order or day shown. Ride times will be posted at the show office. Failure to enter the ring by specified times will incur elimination. All riders must wear protective head gear. (USEF DR 120.6) TEST OF CHOICE (T of C) CLASSES WILL USE TEST 1 IF YOUR IS CHOICE NOT INDICATED ON ENTRY!

FARRIER A farrier will be available on the grounds during show hours.

FIRE REGULATIONS PROHIBIT PARKING BETWEEN THE BARNS As soon as you unload your horse, please move your vehicle to a designated parking area. Parking in the barn area is prohibited. Vehicles in "No Parking" areas will be towed at the owner's expense. Access to the barn area during the show hours will be limited. Specific areas have been set aside for parking horse trailers and vans for exhibitors showing from the trailer. Trailers may be moved by Brookside Management if not parked properly.

FIRST AID There will be an EMT on the grounds during show hours.

FOOTING There is sand footing in all arenas and warm-up rings. Ring dimensions are as follows: Main Arena -275' x 150' Arena #2 - 240' x 150' and Grand Prix Arena -150' x 240'. The warm-up arenas are 200' x 150'.

REFUNDS To encourage early entries, the management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before May 17, 2022. Requests received between May 18 and May 22, 2022, show management will consider refunds due to illness, injury or accidents. All requests must be in writing, accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate, and must be received by the Show Secretary prior to the start of the show. On approved refunds, all class fees will be refunded. Refunds for stalls, tack rooms or association fees will be on a case by case basis. Any refunds will be made by mail, approximately one month after the show.

The show office will be open 9:00 AM -5:00 PM on Wednesday May 18th and daily one hour prior to the start of the first class each day of the show. The office will be closed for lunch and dinner. It will close ½ hour after the last class of each day except Sunday when the office will stay open 1 hour after the last class. An open check or credit card will be required in the show office in order to pick up your back numbers. PLEASE BRING YOUR HORSE'S VACCINATION INFORMATION WITH YOU UNLESS YOU HAVE INCLUDED IT WITH YOUR MAILED ENTRY. An open check must be left at Brookside office if you will be ordering shavings, hay, grain, RV or RV space during the show.

STABLING ASSIGNMENTS NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT PRE-PAYMENT IN FULL Assignment of stalls is entirely at the discretion of the Barn & Show Manager. Horses must be placed in stalls assigned and no changes will be permitted without the express consent of the Barn Manager. Assignments will be made as fairly as possible on the basis of the many considerations, including sponsorship support, number of horses, past participation in this show optimum use and convenience, show décor, time of receipt of entries, ring use, number of classes entered and access considerations. We ask your cooperation in these assignments and once assignments have been made, please do not deviate without specific approval of the Barn

Manager. Patron sponsors will have 1st priority over stable assignments. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together should submit their entries in the same envelope. Please indicate on the entry form (stable with line) any special requests. Management will try to stable late entries as closely as possible to other entries, but there are no guarantees. Show management's decision is final STABLING FACILITIES LIMITED Each animal must be assigned to a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in the stalls assigned. No changes permitted without express consent of the Barn Manager. Stalls will be available Wednesday May 18, 2022 and must be vacated no later than Sunday evening May 22, 2022. Exhibitors arriving prior to or departing later than these specified times should contact the Show Manager and make special arrangements and will be required to pay an additional daily fee of \$10 per horse stall per day. Portable stalls (canvas) with double doors will be \$130. Exhibitors may show from their trailers Trailer fee is \$30 per horse. Every horse entered in this show, (except nursing foals with their dams) must pay either a stall or trailer fee. NO EXCEPTIONS. Exhibitors requesting special stall arrangements for being handicapped or disabled must have the blue State Handicap Card. Card number must be listed with the stall request. Stall decorations shall be made of non-flammable material or treated and maintained in a flame retardant condition. (Fire Marshall Sub-chapter 8) No nails, staples, screws or etc. are allowed installs. No straw allowed. Only manure and shavings may be put in the manure piles or left in the stalls. Please put all trash in the trashcans. Any exhibitor found in violation of this rule will be charged accordingly for repair and repainting.

SUBSTITUTIONS If a horse is sold or injured after closing of entries, exhibitor may post enter another horse in accordance with USEF GR911.

STALLIONS Stallions may be shown by ladies and junior exhibitors in any class except showmanship, walk/trot and lead line.

TBA CLASSES Any class on the AHA Class list or that is recognized by AHA, with the exception of Dressage, Hunter/Jumper, Sport Horse, Carriage, and any class that requires a cow, will be held during the TBA time slots as noted in the schedule. Contact the show secretary if you would like to add a class. TBA Classes will be limited to TWO classes per entry and will be assigned on a FIRST COME FIRST BASIS. In addition to the paid entry, TBA's include a class sponsorship fee. NO exceptions. TBA Sponsorship fee - \$50 per class.

GATE RULE - When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed, and the class is deemed concluded. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed, and judging will commence. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e. two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between). Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant. Class calls must be considered a courtesy only. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a publicaddress system malfunction.

VETERINARIAN A veterinarian will be ON CALL during the show hours. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee. The "AFTER HOURS" Veterinarian contact information will be posted by the show office, main restrooms & stall chart.

CRUELTY to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the show grounds before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty. (See GR839)

ADMISSION TO THE RING No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants of the class, judges and their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge.

AGE OF HORSES For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. A Junior Horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

SAFE SPORT REQUIREMENTS Beginning January 1, 2019, every Federation adult member (18 years & over) with a "Competing Membership" shall complete Federation-approved Safe Sport Training in accordance with the U.S Center for Safe Sport's Education and Training Policies. See USEF GR1303. www.safesport.org. and their phone number for Safe Sport Technical Support Help Desk: 720 676-6417. The training MUST BE COMPLETED before they come to the show.

USEF MEMBERSHIP RULE Life, senior active and junior members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions. Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) lead line: 2) exhibitions: 3) games and races: 4) classes for 4-H members: 5) walk trot (exception :Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program): 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes: 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions: 8) Opportunity classes: 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION

1. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection, or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification. 2. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. Any amateur who wishes to be re-classified on the grounds that he/she has engaged or is planning on engaging in activities which would prevent him/her from continuing to remain an amateur must notify the Federation in writing.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

AMATEUR/OWNERS CLASSES An Owner's Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, handler or driver is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family (See GR142). Combined ownership is permitted in Owner or Amateur/Owner classes provided the rules are followed under USEF AR 110.4.e. Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner to ride classes.

CROSS ENTRIES – ARABIANS AND HALF-ARABIANS Cross-entries are prohibited between Country English Pleasure section and the English Pleasure section (this includes Pleasure Driving and Country Pleasure Driving sections) at the same competition. AR 107.6.

DRUG AND MEDICATION All horses entered in the competition must be assessed a fee of \$31 per horse to defray the expenses of the Drug testing. Horses in competition at a recognized competition are subject to examination by licensed veterinarian or appointed technician to perform certain duties under GR402. This fee is for both USEF (\$23.00) and the State of California (\$8.00).

EXHIBITOR IDENTIFCATION NUMBERS Each horse entered in this show must be assigned an identification number for this show. Correct numbers must be worn by the riders and handlers in all classes.

HALF-ARABIAN COLTS Half-Arabian Colts/Stallions, two years & older are excluded from all halter classes.

HOOF RULE See rule AR106 in the USEF Rulebook

HOSPITALITY No free coffee or tea will be offered. They can be purchased at the Sugar Shack next to the hospitality tables that will be set up under the tent across from the main ring. Donuts, fresh fruit and fresh orange juice will be provided by DAHA each morning of the show. This is free to everyone. It will be set up by 6:30-7:00 Thursday thru Sunday.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Diablo Arabian Horse Association and the Brookside Show Park will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited, or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify Diablo Arabian Horse Association and the Brookside Show Park against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the revisions herein set forth.

INSURANCE ADVISORY Due to the number and quality of horses at this show we urge each exhibitor to verify their liability insurance coverage and their livestock mortality coverage with their own insurance carrier(s). Be sure your coverage is in effect. The Diablo Arabian Horse Association, its members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

JUDGES If, for any reason, a judge fails to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize list. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS To be eligible, Riders must not have reached their 19th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1st assume the greater age on that date.

SELECT RIDERS Refer to USEF AR 110.2 and AHA Comp 721 for current rules.

MAIDEN, NOVICE AND LIMIT HORSES/EXHIBITORS A Maiden horse or exhibitor is one, which has not won a 1st place ribbon. A Novice horse or exhibitor is one, which has not won three 1st place ribbons. A Limit horse or exhibitor is one, who has not won 6 first place ribbons at a Recognized Show of the USEF. In the Arabian Division, ribbons won within a section shall not count in reckoning maiden/novice/limit status if the animal or exhibitor is transferred to a new classification (e.g. Arabian Park to Arabian Western Pleasure, etc.) at a Regular member Show of American Horse Shows Association or the Canadian Equestrian Federation. For purposes of this show, a maiden, novice or limit horse or exhibitor is as of the date of closing of entries.

PERFORMANCE HALTER CLASSES Classes will use the "in the ring" procedure (AR 116.6a and AR 116.6b). All horses three years of age and older must have been entered and shown in a performance class (Under Saddle and/or Driving) at the same show as the one in which the performance halter class is being held, or have completed an AHA sanctioned Endurance Ride or a Competitive Trail Ride recognized by AHA or sanctioned by an AHA recognized Competitive Trail riding organization in the past 90 days. Horses will be judged using the Arabian Performance Halter Score Sheet. Please refer to USEF AR 123 & 124 for more information."

PADDOCK/WARM UP ARENAS There shall be no conduct in the paddock area, which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers/riders. There will be no whips, noisemakers or other equipment device or objects allowed in the paddock area, which may disturb or create a hazard to horses or handlers/riders. Exception: The show whip carried properly by a handler. Spectators in the paddock/warm-up arena are asked not be in either area during the show.

PROTESTS Should any question or dispute arises, it must be protested in the same manner prescribed by USEF Rule GR603. A protest may be received by the Steward, Show Secretary, and Show Manager or by a member of the Show Committee within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES The management reserves the rights or to cancel any entries to any exhibitor, as stated in USEF GR914.

RULES The Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of USEF, the Prize List and the show based on rules of the current USEF Rule Book and the AHA Handbook; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF and AHA Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specification of the current USEF Rule Book and the AHA Handbook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Questions not covered by USEF and AHA Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decision will be final.

USEF WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT To participate in any capacity at this show (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer), the USEF Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement (see page after entry blank waiver) must be signed prior to showing and must be on file with the Show. This Agreement may be electronically signed.

DAHA WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILTY All participants at the show must sign this waiver and it must be on file prior to the show. This Waiver follows the USEF Waiver after the entry blank.

SCRATCHING CLASSES As a courtesy to the Gate Man, Announcer and Show Office, exhibitors are requested to notify the Gate and the Show Office when it is necessary to scratch a class entered. A fee of \$10.00 may be charged if notification is not given. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED IN 2022.

HELMET RULE - Affirmation of the United States Equestrian Federation Helmet/Vest Rule GR801.4 Dress - Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule

USEF GR845 EQUINE VACCINATION RULE

- 1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under a veterinarian.
- In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations: name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
- 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse, name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine, and date of vaccine administration.
- 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by the Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperatures taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
- Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.

High Point Rules

Eligibility: Adults must be voting members in good standing of both AHA and DAHA. Associate members are not qualified. Juniors must be youth members. Horses must be registered purebred or Half-Arabians.

Show Season: Points must be obtained during the competition year November 16 to November 15. (Points earned after November 15 count towards the following year.)

Enrollment: Owner/rider must submit completed High Point Entry Form, together with appropriate fees, anytime during the Show Season. Points do not count until all fees are paid. Participants may enter more than one class. Participants must include their current AHA card with entries. Participants cannot not alter, add classes, or contest placings after the December 1 cut off.

Results/Points: Results and Points must be submitted by December 1 of the competition year. A participant's show record from the AHA website may be submitted as evidence of show/placing, or the owner/rider may complete a High Point Reporting Form. Only points from shows judged by a rated AHSA, CSHA, CDS, USDF, or other official rating organization will be accepted for full points. Schooling shows shall count for half points. **Endurance** rides must be sanctioned by AERC. **Competitive Trail** rides must be sanctioned by NATRC. It is the responsibility of the participant to provide accurate results. A **stallion gelded** during the Show Season will have any points earned transferred and added to gelding points he earns. If a **horse is sold** during the Show Season, the accumulation of points will stop, and the horse will retain its current standing points, which may be transferred to the new owner, provided that the new owner is a voting or Youth member of DAHA or becomes one within 10 (ten) days of purchasing the horse.

Awards: Awards are at the discretion of the High Point Committee and may change from year to year. All Perpetual Trophies will remain the custody of the DAHA Board. Name plagues will be added to the trophy(s) on an annual basis.

Disputes: In the event of a complaint, or if questions arise regarding tabulation of points, a written request must be submitted to the DAHA President, who will appoint a Committee to review the complaint. The Committee's decision will be final. In the event of a discrepancy regarding points, the High Point Committee will contact the Secretary of the event in question to determine the actual point count.

ADULT Membership: Includes 1 AHA and 1 DAHA membership, with voting rights in both organizations Fee \$70.

FAMILY Membership: Includes 2 AHA and 2 DAHA Adult Memberships, and voting rights in both organizations Fee \$130.

YOUTH Membership: For young people under the age of 19. A Youth Member is entitled to all membership privileges except for the voting rights granted to Adult Members. A Youth Membership includes 1 AHA and 1 DAHA membership. Fee \$35.

COMPETITION CARD: Required for above members who compete or own horses that compete, and for officials at recognized AHA events (includes AHA recognized shows, endurance, and competitive trail rides), or members who participate in AHA Award programs. The Competition Card is also available to members who wish to receive coverage under the AHA excess personal liability insurance program.

Fees: Adult \$35. / Youth \$25.

ASSOCIATE Member: Membership for adult or youth who may belong to AHA through another club **or** does not wish the benefits of AHA membership. It is a **non-voting** membership. An Associate member is **not eligible** to hold office in Diablo AHA.

Fees: Adult \$20. / Youth \$15.

NOTE: A CURRENT AHA MEMBER who is <u>not affiliated</u> with a local club and wishes to add DAHA membership, contact the Membership Chair re procedure. Local Club fee (Adult \$20. /Youth \$15.) applies.

<u>USDF Membership Benefits:</u> USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee, (Note; USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as index with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition, secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filling fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those
 sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at
 Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are
 exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot,
 academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30: PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21th brithday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-Organizational Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan MUSDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.
