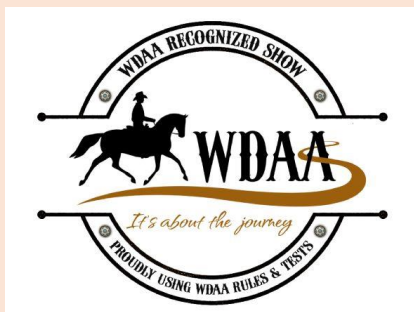

Complete entries include the following by Closing Date or will be charged a \$10 documentation Fee.

- **COMPLETE ENTRY FORM** will all required Membership information.
- **MANDATORY SIGNATURES** on Federation Entry Agreement, Waiver and Release of Liability & Release of liability for Rider, Owner, or Trainer
- **COPIES OF ALL CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS** for Horse, Rider, Owner, or Trainer
- **WDAA MEMBERSHIP** or Show Pass fee is required
- **USEF MEMBERSHIP** is only required for amateurs or exhibitors who want to be eligible for HOYT points
- **COPIES OF FLU/RHINO VACCINES** within six months of entering the stables

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: Every horse and pony entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but the show management will, in no case, be responsible for loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of each entry that each exhibitor should hold the horse show, the officials, the show employees, the show facility, it's directors, and employees, USEF, it's directors and employees harmless for any loss or accident to his horse, horse or equipment which may occur from accident, sickness, fire, or otherwise. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes, or to change officials as it deems necessary. Decision of Show Management is final. Failure to enter the ring by scheduled time may incur elimination. This is the responsibility of exhibitor. Score sheets will only be given to riders of their authorized representatives after results have been posted.

POST ENTRIES: Will be accepted if time is available. Fee will be \$25

ONCE A LATE ENTRY IS ACCEPTED IT WILL NOT BE REFUNDED

Entry Cancellation/Refunds: Office fee is not refundable. Entries with cancellation on or before the closing date will receive 100% refund of all fees minus the office fee. NO REFUNDS (including stabling) after original Closing Date even if Closing date is extended.

MANAGEMENT: Horse Show Management will refuse entries only in accordance with GR914. Management will not refund entries for shows cancelled due to severe weather, acts of God, or other such emergencies.

TIES will be broken as stated in this prize list which follows WD127.3

Show Cancellation Policy: Factors outside of show management's control may cause a show to be interrupted, stopped or cancelled. Factors include, but are not limited to, human communicable disease, equine communicable disease, directive from USEF, or other. If a show must be cancelled in advance due to reasons outside of show management's control, management will execute a good faith refund policy. If show management deems it necessary to cancel a show for any reason in advance of the competition, submitted entry fees will be handled as follows: Organization fees (USEF, USDF) refunded in full, stabling fees refunded in full. Show management will endeavor to refund to entrants as much of their show fees as possible. Office fees are not refunded. Shows are held "rain or shine". No refunds are given for any of the following weather conditions: heat, cold, rain wind, lighting, air quality or other environmental conditions. Conditions may cause interruptions or show stoppage due to safety concerns. A competitor is free to choose to scratch, however, no refund will be granted.

FARRIER: Information will be provided and posted in the show office

SCHEDULE: Will be posted on the website www.centerliness.com and will be posted on social media by noon the day prior to the first day of the show.

RETURNED CHECKS: All checks returned by the bank for any reason will be charged a \$50 fee. Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the USEF for further disciplinary actions.

SHARPS CONTAINER: Available in the show office for disposal of any needles. Competition management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

BARN INFORMATION: Stalls are 12 x 12 with dirt floors, water, and electric outlets. All stalls have doors

ARENA INFORMATION: Main Arena and 2nd Arena are covered, clay-based footing, 150' x 200'. Warm up area has all weather footing

RV Hook-Ups: Are available with water and electric

RING SIZE: All Intro, Basic, Special Olympics and Lead Line Classes will be in a small ring 20x40. All other classes will be in a 20x60

AWARDS: 1st-6th place will receive ribbons. Open/Amateur/Junior classes will be pinned separately. High Point in schooling classes will be pinned. For a2c classes Overall and Reserve will be pinned. Show management may decide not pin classes if the entry does not warrant it.

SHOW DRESS CODE: We enforce the dress codes as outlined in the USEF and WDAA. No rider will be penalized for wearing protective headgear.

HEADGEAR: It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

A2C ENTRIES: must include a completed USEF Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement, a copy of which is contained in this prize list. Current Coggins and current Vaccine record.

Non-Compete Horses: must complete entry form for number. Stabling, haul in & office fee required

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport Training requirements to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Preventions Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org. No refunds will be given if competitor cannot provide proof of completion.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PERSONAL ELECTRONIC TRANSPORT DEVICES: The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

EQUINE VACCINATION RULE: At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.

DRUG TESTING: While the exhibitors are not subject to the USEF Drug & Medication fee of \$23, they are still subject to being randomly drug tested at the competition.

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

In the event of a tie:

- a. The competitor with the highest scores for Collective Marks shall be declared the winner of the tie
- b. In the event a tie remains, the competitor with the highest Collective Mark scores by the judge sitting at C shall be declared the winner of the tie
- c. In the event a tie still remains, the competitor with the highest free walk score shall be declared the winner
- d. In the event there is a tie on the free walk, the competitor with the highest sum of scores with coefficients greater than one shall be declared the winner
- e. If a tie remains, the judge(s) must break the tie.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and a2c Western Dressage Show (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“Risks”).

WARNING:

Under Tennessee Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, title 44, chapter 20.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the “Released Parties” or “Event Organizers”**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature (“Liability”) which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (“Harm”).

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse, or damage to my carriage and for any Harm of any nature caused by me, my horse, or my carriage to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation.
