Important Information

1. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS.

2. Facility:

Stabling: Show limited to 40 horses. 32 12x12 stalls in show barn, all with permanent doors and 1/2" rubber mats. Stalls will be lightly bedded. Electric outlets for each stall. Outdoor rated fans/cords only. 8 additional 12x12 matted stalls with doors in main barn for overflow.

Arenas: All tests will be in Standard Arena (20m x 60m)

- Competition Arena has mirrors at either side of "A" end.
- Competition arena is covered standard arena with sand footing
- Covered warm up 90'x 100' with sand footing
- Additional warm up (weather permitting) 100' x 260' with sand and rubber footing.

Schooling: -All three arenas will be open for schooling from Noon Friday until 8:00 pm Friday evening and after the end of classes on Saturday evening until 9:00 pm.

- Two round pens for lunging/round pen work. Lunging in round pens and designated areas ONLY.
- No lunging in arenas. No long lining.
- Weather permitting, riding on trails allowed, but not near competition arena.

6. **Pets:** For liability reasons (yours included) and for the safety of all participants, **please leave your dogs at home!**
7. **Non-competing horses.** Non-competing horses are welcome, based on space available. Each non-competing horse must have an entry form with all release signatures, a current negative Coggins, pay the applicable stall fees, and wear an entry number when out of its stall.
8. **Freestyles.** Music for freestyles on CD must be provided to management on Friday for Friday afternoon music check.
9. **Western Dressage Rule Reminders:**
 - A Horse/Rider combination may not enter more than two consecutive levels, freestyle included, suitability, hack, and equitation excluded. (WD 102.2).
 - No horse may be ridden more than once in any Western Dressage class. (WD 102.4)
 - Horses may not be ridden by more than two riders. (WD 102.5) In this show, no horse may be ridden in a total of more than six classes. (WD 102.5, 102.12)
 - Riders who require special accommodations due to disability shall provide appropriate medical certifications to management and the steward, at least 24 hours prior to the beginning of the competition. (WD 102.13, 102.14)
 - You are urged to review WD 120 through 123 for required and prohibited tack, WD 123 for attire, and **WD 128 for conduct that will result in elimination.**
 - **All tests will be WDAA Western Dressage tests, available at www.westerndressageassociation.org.**
10. **Tentative schedule:** Classes may not necessarily be run in the order listed in the class list. Each Western Dressage class shall be run in its entirety, provided that due to unforeseen circumstances or schedule conflicts, rides may be scheduled out of sequence, particularly between divisions. Consideration will be given to riders entered in more than one class on more than one horse. Initial Ride Times will be provided by email,

posted on Facebook, and available through equestrians as soon as possible the week of the show. **Official Ride Times** will be provided by email and will be posted by noon at the show grounds. If it becomes necessary to stop classes due to hazardous weather/"Acts of God"/natural disasters/accidents, management reserves the right to stop classes and to continue them later that day on 30 minutes notice and on two hours notice if they are continued to the following day.

11. COVID 19 Precautions:

- Masks required for all persons not mounted. (USEF Required. Also, state orders and local ordinances require that businesses require masks – please do not put us at risk of violation!)
- Maintain 6' (18 hands or one horse length!) physical distance, this includes tribes from the same barn!
- No "spectators." Each horse/rider pair may bring two people, a trainer/coach and a groom – using same trainer as another rider does not mean you can bring an extra person!
- If you have tested positive, have symptoms, have been in close contact with those with symptoms or who have tested positive, please stay home.
- If you develop symptoms within 7 days of attending the show, you must let us know so that we can warn others accordingly.
- No in person visits to show office. Questions and issues handled by call/text to management. (512) 565-8261

11. Awards. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 6th place for all classes and all divisions (Open/Adult Amateur/Junior). No separate divisions for freestyle, suitability, hack, or equitation. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons for each division. Ties will be broken with General Impression scores.

Entry Requirements: Complete entries must include a copy of a negative Coggins taken within 12 months of the show date and proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations given within 6 months of the show date. Entries accepted on a first come, first served, basis, based on postmark date/online entry date. Entries may be limited. **Post (Late) entries will be accepted on a space available basis at the discretion of show management. If entries exceed space available, a waiting list will be maintained, based on date of postmark/online entry date.**

Payment/Refunds/Cancellations

Payments: Please make checks payable to Rolling Ridge Stables. Please mail in time to assure receipt before closing date. Or pay through [Paypal.me/RollingRidgeStables](https://www.paypal.com/rollingridgestables), including all credit card payments, and upload scan of entry to jriggs@r-alaw.com with Coggins.

Refunds: Cancellations by competitors for any reason before the closing date will result in a refund, less the office fee. **No refunds after the closing date except for death of horse or rider.** Organizing and preparing for shows incurs many costs. Thank you for understanding.

Removal from grounds: No refunds if you are asked to leave the facility for violation of rules!

Cancellations: Management reserves the right to cancel the show or postpone classes in the event of hazardous weather, natural disasters,

accidents, emergencies, emergency orders from governmental entities, or similar unanticipated events that make it dangerous to continue the competition. Management will strive to resume or reschedule the competition. No refunds, however, will be given in the event of cancellations unless they occur before the closing date, except for the USEF drug/medication and other USEF fees. Office Fee is non-refundable.

These are two competitions: You must complete a separate entry for each if you wish to compete both days. Please put the stabling fees with Go West! Dressage I.

US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION RULES

“EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.”

US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION rules are in force from the moment show management allows access to the show grounds. This includes conduct, correct saddlery and equipment, and attire.

This is a USEF Lite Competition: To be eligible to compete, horse/rider, owner, lessee, coach, and trainer need **not** be a USEF registrant/member unless you wish to be eligible for USEF HOTY awards, and need **not** be a WDAA member unless you are seeking WDAA WHLPAP points.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Sharps Containers Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. **Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.** Please do not use garbage cans for this material. If local law has different requirements, local law will prevail.

Protective Headgear is required for all riders.

THE RULES MAY HAVE CHANGED FROM THE CURRENT RULE BOOK. IT IS THE COMPETITORS' RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK FOR ANY CHANGES. The listed rules Are only general and are subject to change at the discretion of the Board of Directors of USEF.

IT IS THE RIDER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO KNOW RULES FOR SHOWING AT A DRESSAGE SHOW.

HORSE/RIDER MEMBERSHIPS and SAFE SPORT

A **TRAINER**, as listed on the entry form, is defined as any adult (18 & older) who has responsibility for the care, custody or performance of the horse while the horse is on the competition grounds. This adult must sign the entry form as trainer. If the rider is considered the trainer, the rider must sign as the trainer. A parent or guardian signing on behalf of a junior exhibitor does not need to be a USEF member. A **COACH**, as listed on the entry form, is defined as an adult (18 & older) who gets paid for instructing, teaching, schooling or advising a rider with their horse on the competition grounds. This adult must sign the entry form as coach. If there is no coach, the signature for coach may be left blank.

USEF Membership This is a USEF LITE competition. NO USEF memberships, non-member fees, or horse registrations are required to compete in this show.

To be eligible to participate as a rider, owner, lessee, coach, or trainer at Federation LITE competitions, persons need NOT be members of USEF or WDAA.

EXCEPTIONS Those wishing to be eligible for USEF HOTY awards must have USEF horse registration and be USEF members, and those seeking WDAA WHLPAP points must be WDAA members.

USEF Numbers must be provided to show secretary prior to the show for results to be reported for USEF HOTY.

USEF SAFESPORT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS TO COMPETE Effective January 1, 2019, every USEF adult member (18 & older) with an active senior competing membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training, overseen by the U.S. Center for SafeSport. An adult member may be OWNER, RIDER, TRAINER and/or COACH. Adult members listed on the entry must complete the entire course and be Safe Sport Trained before the first day of competition. Safe Sport Training must be completed by all adult members on the entry or the rider will not be allowed to compete. You may access the Safe Sport modules from your USEF member dashboard at www.USEF.org.



Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules and of the current USEF/WDAA rules will be judged in accordance therewith.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

Show Management reserves the right to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, and/or prohibit entries deemed sufficient by Show Management without claims for damages.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the horse show management; their decision will be final.
