DRESSAGE, WESTERN SECTION

- No qualification is required for Level 2 and Above.
- No qualification is required for Miscellaneous Western Dressage classes.
- Introductory Level, Basic Level and Level 1 horse/rider combination entered in the Western Dressage Section must have been shown at any show (see General Rules, Regs and Info) in a test at that level. List qualifying show on the entry blank.
- To be shown by a professional, amateur or junior exhibitor rider. Stallions are permitted except in Junior Exhibitor classes (MO104.1). No horse may perform the same test more than once.
- Ties will be broken per WD 127.3.
- World Champion Awards are based on the same horse/rider combination. You are automatically entered in the Championship, no need to enter on entry blank.
- A horse/rider combination may not cross enter between open and amateur or open and junior exhibitor.
- No horse may compete in more than four Western Dressage tests per day.
- No horse may compete in levels that differ any more than one with the same rider.

WORLD CHAMPION WESTERN DRESSAGE INTRODUCTORY LEVEL AMATEUR

- To be eligible for Western Dressage Suitability, a horse must not have shown in a Western Dressage test at First Level or above and/or shown in a Western Dressage Hack class. See Subchapter WD-10 for complete class specifications.
- Western Dressage Hack horses may not enter Western Dressage Suitability. Subchapter WD-11
- Western Dressage Seat Equitation is performed on the rail and is shown at the walk, working jog and working lope both directions. Horses should back easily and stand quietly. The jog must be ridden sitting. Subchapter WD-12.
- Musical Freestyle riders must supply their music to the show office the day before the class.
- Classes will take place on the day as scheduled. The order of classes will depend on the number of entries and the classes entered. Ride times will be posted at gnwcmhs.com. Please direct any scheduling issues to Carol Spangler wrks4good@aol.com.
- In the interest of safety and cooperation, non-riders may not stand or coach from the middle of the warmup area.

- Horses must have qualified by winning the appropriate placing in that class. EXCEPTIONS: Youth qualifies by having been shown in any class in this division, any Amateur class will qualify for Masters, any Ladies class will qualify for Ladies Amateur to Ride.
- To be shown under English tack at a walk, pleasure trot, road trot, and canter, with light rein but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth. Horses may be asked to back.
- In Open and Youth classes, horses to be judged on manners, performance with proper cadence and balance, quality, presence, and apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride 60%; type and conformation 40%.
- In Junior Horse classes, horses to be judged on manners, quality, performance with proper cadence and balance, presence, and apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride 60%; type and conformation 40%.
- In Junior Exhibitor classes, horses to be judged on manners, suitability, performance with proper cadence and balance, quality, presence, and apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride 60%; type and conformation 40%.
- In Ladies and Ladies Amateur classes, horses to be judged on manners, suitability, quality, performance with proper cadence and balance, presence, and apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride 60%; type and conformation 40%.
- In Amateur classes, horses to be judged on manners, performance with proper cadence and balance, suitability, quality, presence, and apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride 60%; type and conformation 40%.
- Championships to be judged 50% 50%; horses to be stripped in Open and Junior Horse Championships.
