Please TEXT 850-445-5775 TO RSVP at least 24 hours in advance. Due to cost and our desire to conserve water, we will not fill the water jump if no one has RSVP'd in advance.

Your schooling fee includes the use of our all purpose arena, Dressage arena, Show Jumping field, and Cross Country course, which includes over 30 jumps ranging in height from 12" to 3'6" with banks, drops, ditches, and our water jump!

Plus, anyone is welcome to come "trail ride" through our Cross Country course and out to 1 back of our property.
