**Ring Size:** Intro, Training, SO, LL, and USEA tests will be in a small arena. If a test is required to be ridden in a 20x60 ring it will be ridden in that. **You can** 

request your test to be ridden in the standard size ring.

All stalls are required to have at least 1 bag of shavings!

**Entry Cancellations/Refunds:** Office fee is not refundable. Scratches before the closing date will be refunded, all except for office fees. **NO REFUNDS (including stabling) after original closing date, even if the closing date was extended.** 

Management has the right to refuse entries only in accordance with GR914.

Management will not refund entries for shows canceled due to severe weather, acts of God, or other such emergencies.
