Directions

From the North:

US 23 to M-72 turn west, stay on 72 until F-41; turn south towards Mikado, go about a mile and turn right on Dewar Road, First driveway on the left. Lucky Dog Ranch is on the south-west corner of F-41 and Dewar rd.

From the South:

US 23 North to M-72 turn west, stay on 72 until F-41 turn south towards Mikado go about a mile and turn right on Dewar Road, First driveway on the left. Ranch is on the south-west corner of F-41 and Dewar rd.

From the West: M-72 west to M-65 south, turn east on M-72 until F-41 turn south towards Mikado, go about a mile a turn right on Dewar Road. First driveway on the left. Ranch is on the south-west corner of F-41 and Dewar Road.

Entries:

Entries open two weeks before each show and close three days before each show at 11:59PM. Entries are accepted on first come, first serve basis by email or mail. One entry per horse/rider combination. Entries submitted after the closing date will be accepted on a space available basis. All competitors must submit a current coggins within 12 months of show date with their show entry.

General Rules

- Helmets are required for all riders while mounted
- No smoking is allowed on the show grounds
- A Horse/Rider combination may enter no more than two consecutive levels, freestyle levels included, at any one competition.
- No horse may be ridden more than once in any Western Dressage Class.
- Horses cannot be ridden by more than two riders.
- Rides will be limited to 3 tests per horse, excluding rail classes, suitability, equitation, and hack.
- Exhibitors should also be aware of the USEF rules governing drugs and medications.

Awards: 1st to 6th place Ribbons (Ties will be broken per USEF DR 127.3.)
Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons for each level.
The judge will award one Harmony Award at each show

Stabling is limited- Please let management know if you need to haul in the night before or if you are staying for clinic on Sunday.

Show Fees: \$15 Per Class, \$10.00 Office fee per horse/rider combination, \$10 Stabling per day, or \$5 Haul in fee day of the show.

Show Arenas: Arena 1: 20m x 40m outdoor arena with grass footing,
 Arena 2: 20 m x 60m outdoor arena with sand footing
 Warm up arena: 20m x 40m indoor arena with sand footing.
