Entries: Entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date. Entries postmarked after closing date will be considered post entry and will incur late fees. FOR SPECIAL DELIVERIES, PLEASE SEND ENTRIES WITHOUT A SIGNATURE NEEDED. NO CERTIFIED, REGISTERED, OR EXPRESS MAIL WITH A SIGNATURE NECESSARY FOR RECEIPT WILL BE ACCEPTED. Online entry is available at <a href="https://www.showsecretary.com">www.showsecretary.com</a>. You may also mail your paper entry and check to Susan Peacock. Make checks payable to MODA – Mid-Ohio Dressage Association and send with entry to Show Secretary: Susan Peacock, 837 Glenlake Dr., Edmond, OK 73013. No post-dated checks accepted. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, based on postmark date and entries may be limited. Those entries postmarked after closing will be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary, based on space available basis and charged a \$30.00 late fee per show. If the classes are oversubscribed, a Waiting List (in order of receipt) will be maintained. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

<u>Vaccination & Coggins:</u> Records must be uploaded or mailed with your show entry in order for your entry to be accepted. A negative Coggins (EIA) Report listing the horse's recorded show name within one year of show dates is required for all horses on the grounds, including haul-ins. Show numbers will not be assigned without negative Coggins.

<u>Official Ride Times:</u> Provisional times will be available to competitors at www.showsecretary.com. Please inform the Show Secretary of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving provisional ride times.

**Refund Policy:** Cancellations prior to closing date will be refunded, less office fee(s). No refunds will be given after closing date.

<u>Hazardous Weather/Act of God/Accident Policy:</u> Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

<u>Schedule:</u> Classes may not necessarily run in the order listed on the prize list. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the show secretary of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, and modify the schedule, to modify or cancel awards and/or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein.

Show management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of any entry for cause deemed sufficient by show management.

JR/YR Division: Riders must be under 21 as of January 1, 2024 to receive JR/YR pricing.

Lead Line: Individual leading the horse/pony must be 18 years of age or older. The leading rein should be attached to the cavesson, noseband, or halter while leaving control of the horse to the rider. Rider must wear a shoe with a heel and their feet must be in the stirrups. Riders and handlers must comply with helmet rules. Stallions may not participate in the leadline class.

#### Helmets: Protective headgear is required for all riders any time mounted.

**Scores:** It is the responsibility of all competitors to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day during which the score was earned.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be given through six places.

**Year End Awards:** Members of MODA are eligible for year-end awards in both Classical and Western Dressage. MODA awards a Classical and Western Crossover buckle for the horse and rider pair with the highest scores at the same level in both disciplines.

**Non-compete horses:** Non-compete horses are welcome if space permits. Owner is required to complete an entry form and pay all applicable fees.

**Show Rules:** All classes will be conducted in accordance with the rules of WDAA. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason, including but not limited to unsportsmanlike conduct and animal cruelty. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes, vary or add officials.

**Breaking Scoring Ties:** In the case of a scoring tie, ties will be broken per the USEF WD127.

**TIP Awards:** Thoroughbred Incentive Program awards sponsored by The Jocky Club are being offered at this show in the following categories: First Level Dressage High Point Award, High Score Dressage Thoroughbred (Overall), Introductory Dressage High Point Award, Second/Third/Fourth Level Dressage High Point Award, Training Level Dressage High Point Award, Western Dressage High Point Thoroughbred. Note: Only the Western Dressage High Point Thoroughbred Award will be awarded during Saturday's WDAA Recognized Show.

**Stabling:** Groups wishing to be stabled together must all use the same name or group name on the "Stable Group" line of entry form. Every possible effort will be made to honor these requests; however, **no guarantees will be made**. Stall charts will be posted and check-in will begin at 5:00

pm on Friday. Stalls must be vacated by 1 hour after the last ride on Sunday. Horse or Tack stalls cannot be changed/switched unless you obtain approval from Show Office.

<u>Class/Test Limit:</u> Each horse can be entered in no more than 4 classes total per day and with no more than 2 different riders each day. Horses may only be shown at 2 consecutive levels.

#### **Facility Information:**

- The facility is a private breeding farm with mares and foals turned out close to the outdoor arena, which may be distracting to some show horses.
- Management has the right to use the small ring (20X40 meters) for Intro Classes if the schedule warrants.
- The facility trails are not available for riding.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED.
- Men's and Women's restrooms are handicap accessible but do not have grab bars.
- Size and footing of outdoor arena: 150 X 250 Euro footing with fiber and white sand
- If bad weather indoor: 80 X 200 with natural loam
- Lunging is only allowed in marked lunging area a covered round pen for one horse at a time
- Parking in a grass field for haul-ins and overnight non-hook-ups
- No arrivals prior to 5:00 p.m. on Friday September 9 and leave 1 hour after last ride on Sunday for the weekend fee. An overnight fee is a 24 hour period (thus if showing Saturday afternoon come Saturday morning and leave Sunday morning)

#### **Facility Entrance Directions:**

From the WEST:

Traveling East on Marysville Rd (Hwy 36) out of Marysville, toward Delaware travel approximately 5 miles and turn North (Left) on Delaware County Line Road. Take the first Right at the long driveway between two fenced fields (you will see the black and gold Four Star Quarter Horses sign at the end of the driveway).

#### From the EAST:

Traveling West on Marysville Rd (Hwy 36) out of Delaware, toward Marysville travel approximately 2 miles past the Midway Market in Ostrander, you will pass our front entrance gate and go 1/2 mile further to and turn North (Right) on Delaware County Line Road. Take the first Right at the long driveway between two fenced fields (you will see the black and gold Four Star Quarter Horses sign at the end of the driveway).

THERE WILL BE NO SMOKING IN THE BARNS, ARENA OR BUILDINGS.

#### **AQHA & WDAA Information:**

- You do not need to be a member of any organization to compete at this schooling show. All breeds are welcome!
- Bridle numbers must be displayed at all times.
- This show will be governed by USEF Western Dressage rules, WDAA rules, and AQHA rules.
  - o In accordance with these rules WDAA exhibitors will be subject to horse, tack, and attire check of at least one-third of the entrants. This check will occur after the test outside of the arena. Any horse must be eliminated from the test if a horse or any tack is in violation of the rules.
- Exhibitors competing for WDAA points:
  - Must be WDAA members and include their owner and rider WDAA numbers on the entry form.
  - WDAA classes, to compete as an adult amateur (AA) you must have a USEF/WDAA amateur card, otherwise you must show in the open division.
  - $\circ$  WDAA members are responsible for submitting their own test results to WDAA per their rules.
  - 2022 WDAA/USEF Western Dressage tests will be used. These are available at www.westerndressageassociation.org
- Exhibitors competing for AQHA points both Traditional and Western Dressage
  - o There is an AQHA processing fee per horse/rider combination each day
  - To be eligible, the horse must be AQHA registered, and the exhibitor must have a current AQHA individual membership.
  - Open, amateur and youth eligibility based on criteria found in the AQHA Official Handbook (free at AQHA.com)
  - o Eligibility can be found under rules SHW215, SHW 220, SHW 225, and SHW 235
  - Horse registration number and exhibitor membership number must be on the entry form. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of their entries.
  - A photocopy of the horse's papers (front and back) as well as a photocopy of the AQHA exhibitor 2022 membership card must be provided at the time of bridle number pick-up. These copies will not be returned.
  - Exhibitors of TRADITIONAL dressage AQHA horses must pay an AQHA competition license fee of \$85.
    - This fee is for the lifetime of the horse. Proof of license is required with entry.
  - All AQHA rules for Traditional Dressage and Western Dressage are available in the 2022 AQHA rulebook SHW 680 and SHW 682.
  - AQHA horses will not run in a separate class. Their test and their scores will be separated out for the purpose of submission to AQHA.
  - $\circ~$  AQHA points are offered beginning at the Training/Basic Level. Introductory and Intro levels are not eligible for AQHA points.

I AGREE THAT: I choose to participate voluntarily in the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association (MODA) East Meets West Show. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horseback riding and equine activities carry inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss and serious bodily injury. In accordance with the Ohio's Equine Liability Act, Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, I do hereby acknowledge the following INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES:

- a. The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine;
- b. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sound, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, person or other animals;
- c. Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- d. A collision with another equine, another animal, a person or an object;
- e. The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

I AGREE THAT: in consideration of the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association allowing my participation in Mid-Ohio Dressage Association's hosted or sponsored activities, and/or any other equine activity, under the terms set forth herein, I, the rider, and the parent or guardian thereof if a minor, do (a) agree to hold harmless and release the Mid Ohio Dressage Association, its, agents, volunteers, employee, officers, member, premises owner, affiliated organizations and insurers from legal liability due to any of their negligence or the negligence or actions of other riders, auditors, clinicians or spectators, (b) waive any legal claim I or my minor child or ward named below may have against the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association, its agents, volunteers, employees, officers, members, premises owners, affiliated organizations and Insurers for injuries resulting from any INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES, as described above in Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, and (c) agree that I am participating in all equine activities hosted, organized or sponsored by Mid-Ohio Dressage Association at my own risk and assume all risk of damage or injury to my person, horse, or property other than that due to the intentional misconduct of the Mid-Ohio Dressage Association. I understand that this waiver will remain effective unless and until revoked by me in writing. #### RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND IMDEMNITY AGREEMENT

READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING IT. YOUR SIGNATURE INDICATES YOU UNDERSTAND IT AND AGREE ON ITS TERMS. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU AND YOUR CHILD ARE GIVING UP CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE OR RECOVER DAMAGES IN CASE OF INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGES, FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE STABLE; IT'S OWNER, EMPLOYEE AND AGENTS ("THE RELEASEES").

In consideration for allowing me (or my minor child) to handle and ride a horse and on behalf of myself, my child or our personal representatives, heirs, next-of-kin, spouses and assigns, I HEREBY:

- Acknowledge that a horse or mule may, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make
  unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's feet, push or shove a person, saddles or bridles may loosen or break
  all of which may cause the rider to fall or be joited, resulting in serious injury or death.
- ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSEBACK RIDING IS AN INHERENTLY DANGEROUS ACTIVITY AND INVOLVES RISKS
  THAT MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY AND IN SOME CASES DEATH, because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior
  of horses, regardless of their training and past performance.
- Voluntarily assume the risk and danger of injury or death inherent in the use of the horse, equipment and gear provided to me by Chuck's Trail Riding Adventures, hereinafter referred to as the Stable.
- 4. RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND PROMISE NOT TO SUE the Stable, doing business under its own name or any other name and/or any of its owners, officers, employees and agents (hereinafter the "Releasees"), for any loss, liability, damages, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to my person or property.
- Release the `eleasees from any claim that such Releasees are or may be negligent in connection with my riding experience or ability
  including but not limited to training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjustment of saddles or bridles, instruction or riding
  skills or leading and supervising riders.
- 6. INDEMNIFY, AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Stable, instructors, its employees and agents from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either my use of the horse and any equipment of gear provided therewith or any acts or omissions of wranglers or other employees or agents.
- 7. The Undersigned expressly agrees that the foregoing release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement is governed by the State of Arizona and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by Arizona Law (RIDE VALUE), and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the full legal force and effect.
- 8. Acknowledge that this document is a contract and agree that if a lawsuit is filed against the Stable or its owner, agents, employees, guides or wrangles for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, the Undersigned will pay all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the Stable in defending such an action.
- State that I am not now pregnant and that I have no history of epileptic seizures, heart condition or any other medical problem that could be affected by horseback riding.
- 10. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT MY CHILD AND ALL RIDERS WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMET. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THAT A PROTECTIVE HELMET IS AVAILABLE AND HAS BEEN OFFERED FOR MY OWN OR MY CHILD'S SAFETY.
