Entries:

One entry per horse/rider combination per show number. Payment in full must accompany entry.

Make checks payable to Mountain Rose Ranch. Proof of negative Coggins and of vaccines must accompany entry for any horse stabling by day or night. Not required for hauling in horses who do not require day or night stabling. Classes available for Jr. (ages 18 and under for the calendar year), Adult Amateur and Open.

Refunds:

Office fee is not refundable. Entries with written cancellation notice received on or before the closing date of August 18th will receive a full refund less the office fee. No refunds after the closing date unless in the case of a valid medical emergency of either horse or rider.

Ride Times: Ride times will be emailed to riders directly the Wednesday before the show and will also be posted on the Mountain Rose Ranch Facebook page.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded through 4th place. Additional prizes may also be awarded.

Arenas: The clinic, ride-a-tests and schooling show will take place in the indoor arena (80' x 260'), with footing composed of a dirt/sand mix. Intro and Basic/Training Level tests will be ridden in the small (20m x 40m) arena. Level 1/First Level and above tests will be ridden in the Large (20m x 60m) arena. Warm-up and lunging will take place in the outdoor arena (250' x 450) and round pen respectively with footing comprised of sand in each location. Please note that the outdoor warm-up arena is toward the back of the property and that horses will need to ride or be lead to and from via a private gravel driveway.

Show Rules: This show is recognized by the Nebraska Dressage Association and WDAA which allows both riders and volunteers to submit their scores for year-end awards. As such, the clinic, ride-a-test and schooling show will abide by the requirements of being a recognized show with both organizations.

Equipment: This show will follow the equipment regulations as listed in the WDAA Rulebook for Western Dressage classes (https://westerndressageassociation.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/02/2018-WDAA-Equipment-Guide.pdf) and the USEF Rulebook for English Dressage classes (https://www.usef.org/forms-pubs/sAH3nOVD85c/dressage-attire-equipment-booklet). Only equipment listed as legal by those associations is permissible at the show.

Attire: Casual, but clean attire. Riders must have long pants, boots with a heel & sleeves with a collar at all times while mounted. English: solid polo shirts/blouses; Western: shirts/attire per WDAA guidelines. Helmets are required on <u>all</u> riders when mounted per the NDA recognized show requirements above.

Accommodations: On-site accommodation options for both horses and humans are available with reservations granted on a first-to-reserve basis. See the Stabling section below for horse accommodations information and contact Emily at emily@mountainrosehorsemanship.com for information on reserving RV/LQ or Bunkhouse accommodations for people. If off-site accommodations are preferred, or on-site accommodations fill, there are many hotels in near proximity.

Stabling: Stalls are available at the rate of \$15/night with the owner providing hay. One bag of shavings is included in the stall rate, with additional shavings available for purchase. Outside shavings are prohibited. All horses who are reserving a stall (either for the day or overnight) must provide proof of a negative Coggins (within 12 months) and vaccinations for flu, rhino, and strangles (within 6 months). Proof of such health requirements is due in advance of arrival and ideally should accompany the entry or be remitted separately prior to the show date. Haul-ins, whereby the horse does not need any stabling are allowed and do not require any health requirements.

Horsemanship Protocol: No harsh handling or excessive use of force is permitted. Any participant utilizing methods considered in excess of normally accepted training practices or which compromise the safety of horse or human may be asked to leave the show grounds and will not be eligible for entry refund.

Facility Rules: All riders must properly clean up after themselves and their horses while at the facility. No smoking, no alcohol and no dogs while on premises.
