ENTRIES: Dressage tests \$35. \$20 Office fee per horse/rider combination, \$20 grounds fee for horses not stabled. Post entries will be accepted as the schedule allows with a \$10 per ride post entry fee. Classes will be split AA/Jr/Open if entry warrants. Indicate your status on entry form. Negative Coggins within past 12 months is required for all horses; include a copy with your entry. Non-competing horses allowed only by prior arrangement with Show Manager and a \$50 schooling fee. Late Entry (after closing date) \$25, if schedule allows.

ENTRY FORM available at www.dressage-shows.com. Draw checks to Northern Lights Dressage Shows (NLDS). Mail entries to Show Manager at address above. * Please mail early to ensure timely delivery

REFUNDS: Entry fees, less office fee, refundable through closing date. No refunds after closing.

STABLING: Stabling \$40 per day stall, \$55 overnight. **Stalls will not be bedded unless also stabling for Recognized Show.** Bring your own shavings or order on entry form. Limited shavings available at \$10 per bag. Horse must wear its bridle number whenever out of its stall. Jump-out horses may not be left unattended. No dogs, please.

ATTIRE: Either formal or informal attire, but Traditional Dressage riders must wear an approved safety helmet and all must wear appropriate riding footwear with heels when mounted.

TIMES: 8AM tentative start time. Western Dressage classes will run first, Traditional Dressage classes will begin later. Times will be emailed to competitors and posted prior to the show at www.Dressage-Shows.com

ARENAS: 20x60m Outdoor dressage rings with sand footing; open grassy areas for warm-up.

AWARDS: Ribbons to sixth place. Imprinted glassware for first place.
