Person Responsible

The Person(s) responsible (PR) for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares responsibility for the care, training, custody, and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules. The PR is liable under the penalty provisions of the applicable EC Rules for any rule violations. Every entry form for an EC sanctioned competition must identify the PR and be signed by the PR.

The Person(s) responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed by himself/herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse in the stables, elsewhere on the grounds, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised.

A: For adult entries into EC sanctioned competitions the PR shall be either the trainer, the owner of the horse of the competitor who rides or drives the horse during the EC sanctioned competition. Section A Page 101

B: For Junior entries into EC sanctioned competitions the Junior competitor cannot be the PR. For Junior entries the PR may be either the trainer, the owner of the horse, or a parent/guardian of the Junior competitor (A801) Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person(s) responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition.

It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC- sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition."

AHA Membership Statement

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank in an AHA recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card or join AHA for this Regional Championship show.

When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and the agent must be a member of AHA.

Single Event membership is not allowed at Regional or National competitions.

Exhibitors in Walk-Trot classes must have an AHA Competition membership from AHA in a Regional Competition.

Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or parents/guardians signing for minor are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5.12)

The Region 17 Championship and Championship Pre-show (**Silver**) competitions are sanctioned competition members of Equestrian Canada (c/o House of Sport 2451 Riverside Drive, Ottawa, Ontario, K1H 7X7) and are governed by the Rules of EC.

The Equestrian Canada Federation (EC), the national federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.
- The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibiting procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

THE RULE BOOK

Exhibitors, Judges, and Show Officials are responsible for knowledge of the Rules. Both a complete knowledge of and compliance with the rules are essential, and all participants must be fully cognizant of all rules as well as class specifications in the division in which they compete. Full details of Horse Show operation - EC (including FEI) rules - list of recognized Judges - other vital information is in the RULE BOOK copyright for exclusive use of recognized shows. [See current EC Rules and Amendments](#). Every individual is eligible to count points won at recognized EC Shows for Annual and Provincial Championship Awards. The current EC Rules and Amendments are presently in effect and have been used to compile the Rules and Regulations for this prize list. Passports are **not** required in a recognized "Breed" competition.

EC Coach Status Requirements



In 2023, minimum Coach Status requirements will be enforced at all EC-sanctioned events. Recognizing some coaches will not have completed their EC Coach Status requirements when enforcement begins, the EC Board approved Temporary Coach Status (TCS) for the 2023 show season. **Temporary Coach Status (TCS) will come into effect on July 1, 2023.**

TCS applies to **Canadian-residents** coaching one or more athletes at any EC-sanctioned event and who do not meet minimum EC Coach Status requirements as listed below:

EVENT SANCTIONING	MINIMUM Coaching Requirement in 2023
EC Bronze and/or Silver	EC Registered Coach Status
EC Silver and/or Gold	EC Licensed Coach Status



Currently, **EC Coach Status requirements are only for those whose primary place of residence and coaching practices are within Canadian borders.** Those whose primary place of residence is outside of Canada are considered International Coaches and are exempt from EC Coach Status requirements at this time.



The **TCS fee** is determined by the event sanctioning level and the individual coach's EC Coach Status. **TCS is valid for one (1) EC-sanctioned event only.** The TCS fee will increase annually until it is retired at the end of 2025.

Coaches **without** minimum coaching requirements must complete a TCS Form and submit this to the show office with appropriate payment. **The show office will not issue numbers to athletes of any coach with insufficient coaching status until the TCS form and fee has been submitted.**

The TCS fee may not be added to a trainer split or applied to one or more athletes' show bill without written consent from those included on the split and/or bill(s). This fee is to be incurred by the coach and not the athlete(s).

When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, **athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self-coached.** Coaches from other countries, must be in good-standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments.

** Sweepstakes classes eligible to be split into Saddle/Pleasure, Stock/Hunter and/or multiple age divisions (age splits must be all inclusive). Sport Horse Classes may be split by Dressage or Hunter Type.

^At Regional Shows, the highest test will be used. At the Regional Level, these classes can be combined as Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian.

General Rules

1. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian Horse Association, Equestrian Canada Federation, the Region 17 Arabian Horse Association, and the Region 17 Championship Horse Show Commission, their officers, contract person or volunteers or any of its affiliates, will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any exhibitor, his or her agent or employee, or to any horse or any article of any kind.

The exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury, to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify all parties listed above against any and all loss, damages, or liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof.

The submitting of any entry form to the Entry Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

2. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to any official or volunteer of the Region 17 Championship Horse Show on the part of any owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler may result in the immediate removal from the show of said person, at the discretion of the Show Commission and the owner will forfeit their entry fees. Such action will be reported to EC and AHA for disciplinary action. Official protests (\$100 cash fee) will be filed as per the EC Rule Book A1206

3. The R17 Show Commission reserves the power to remove any person or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.

4. The R17 Show Commission reserves the right to add to, amend, or decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make necessary alterations in the show prize list and the show program.

5. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. (EC Article A602) Classes that are non-rated by EC are: Lead Line; Select Stallion Futurities

6. **Region 17 Show Commission reserves the right to cancel any class with less than three (3) horses entered.** Exception: designated Sweepstakes, Dressage, and Stakes Classes.

7. Patterns & Orders of Go will be posted at the show office 24 hours prior to classes.

8. **No horse shall remain on the grounds if it is not entered in the Region 17 Show** unless written permission is granted by Show Commission. Exception: mares with foal at side. Every horse entered in this show **must** have a stall.

9. Potentially large classes may be split by the Region 17 Commission into a Section A & Section B, with the final section right after both sections, especially for any sweepstake classes. An Amateur class could be split by date of birth into a G and H class title with awards on both classes.

10. **Scoring System is MOS – Majority of Opinion System** – See Current AHA Handbook. This system will be used for all Region 17 Championship Classes including Halter Classes. Exception: Performance Halter classes with a three-judge system will use the Arabian Performance Halter Score Card, turned into placings and completed with the final placings determined by MOS.

11. Stallions are permitted in Junior Exhibitor Performance Classes. Stallions are **not** permitted in Junior Showmanship, WalkTrot/Jog or Lead Line classes.

12. **Select ATR** see current AHA (Arabian Horse Association) for the leveling system and the EC Arabian section B1502.6** - It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the rules of each class/each division of each class they enter. Please read the changes for this category! Riders of Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo Arabian horses competing in the same section shall not be considered separately.

13. If a rider is eligible to compete as a Select rider in a respective section on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year. This rule also includes Elite and Choice riders.

14. Sport Horse In-Hand Classes will use Pattern "A", Triangle. (Refer to EC Article B2405.1/USEF 1649E1.1)

15. **Sport Horse In-Hand will be split to Dressage Type and Hunter Type** for the Region 17 Championship Show.

General Rules

16. TBA's must be requested and approved prior to the start of the show. **There will be a maximum of three TBA classes. Contact Show Secretary to put in designated Schedule.**

17. Lead Line 2-7yrs old - No Fee -- can enter at show office one session before the class.

18. Signature of Parent or Guardian is mandatory. (not EC rated) Lead Line youth are not allowed to enter performance classes. Does not require a Provincial or EC membership. HCBC recommends Lead Line exhibitors and handlers have the Provincial membership for insurance benefits. Contact HCBC for more information.

- a. Safety is the main priority
- b. Child must wear a helmet
- c. The lead line must be attached to the halter and not to the bridle bit.
- d. Saddle must fit child with feet in stirrups
- e. Person leading horse must be 14 yrs or older
- f. Horse must be entered in the show.

19. Age of Junior or Youth exhibitors for this show is 18 years as of December 1, 2023. Unless there is an different age listed in the title, **JTR & JOTR classes are 18 years & Under. Adult --- AATR & AAOTR classes are 19 years & Over.**

20. Hors Concor will not be considered at the Region 17 Championship.

21. Substitution of any horse will be handled on an individual basis and approved by the Show Commission.

22. Unrelated Owners In Owner Classes - For the purpose of showing in Junior Owner & Amateur Owner classes, two non-related owners are now be able to co-own a horse and show in owner classes provided that :

- a. The Ownership must be an "and" relationship – not an "or" relationship.
- b. No family member of a professional may enter into this relationship.
- c. "Non-family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by EC.
- d. Family members of these two co-owners are not permitted to show in owner classes.
- e. Both co-owners must be members of EC/USEF and hold a valid Amateur card.

Refer to Equestrian Canada rules for more information.

***Reminder: Exhibitor number must be on the horse (halter or bridle) at any time that it leaves the stall and on the Exhibitor's back in any Class per EC rule EC B1306 Competitor number(s) must be worn in the paddock or warm-up area prior to the class and in the show arena during competition. Failure to wear a competitor number during a class may result in disqualification of the entry by the judge.**

Farrier & Veterinarian Permit

No other Farrier or Veterinarian will be permitted to work on the grounds other than the official Farrier and official Show Veterinarian (on call) without registering with the Region 17 Show.

Exhibitors wishing to use a Farrier or Veterinarian other than the official farrier or veterinarian must apply at the Show Office and pay a fee of \$100.00 before they can officially work on the grounds at any time during the Region 17 Championship show.

Photographer Permit

Region 17 Championship show has booked a professional photographer who is under contract for all 'in ring' photos of the main ring or outside rings. Family or Friends may take photos/videos of their rider/handler from the outer perimeter of any show ring, Those personal photographs may be posted on Face Book, Messenger, Emails, etc. However, the photographs taken by family or friends are not permitted to be sold either on line or privately. In addition, professional photographers, not under contract with Region 17, are not permitted to take nor sell photos/videos at any time during the Region 17 Championship show.

Border Crossing



With a few simple preparations, it is easy to cross the border. **People need a valid passport.** Covid tests and vaccinations are **NOT** required.



For horses, **vaccination requirements are the same as USEF-licensed competitions as is a valid Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA)) test.** *"All horses attending EC sanctioned competitions must have been administered Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (1 and 4) vaccinations within six (6) months (+21 days grace period) before arrival at the competition. No horse shall have received vaccination within seven (7) days prior to arrival at the event."*



USDA website with link to Health Forms

A United States origin Health Certificate is required. It must be issued by a veterinarian no more than thirty (30) days prior to export.

A single health certificate can be used for multiple-horse consignments if all of the following provisions are met:

- a.** All horses must be from a single consignor, they must be consigned to the same destination, and they must come from the same premises of origin.
- b.** All horses must have current EIA test charts, and these charts must be attached to the health certificate. These charts must have accurate drawn descriptions of the horse, adequate to unambiguously identify the animal and link it to the certificate
- c.** All horses must be identified on the health certificate with a written description.

You may wish to check in with American Customs and provide them with a list of your tack and equipment before proceeding to Canada Customs. This is entirely optional, but could save some time on your return.

A Canadian Border Services agent will inspect your papers on arrival.

U.S. origin horses exported to Canada with a U.S. issued export health certificate (valid for 30 days from the date of inspection) may re-enter the U.S. for an unlimited number of times during the 30 day period **without** an USDA Veterinary Services port inspection. The importer must present the original export health certificate to customs at a land border port of entry designated for animals from Canada.



USDA Health Forms

Horses entering Canada temporarily for competition do NOT require a "Border Bond" or security deposit



CBSA Memorandum D8-1-1

It is common for third party importers to reference a 'border bond' when importing horses into Canada.

This is NOT required for horses imported temporarily for competition. Refer to Canada Border Services Agency **Memorandum D8-1-1**.

"Horses

107. Horses and other equines imported temporarily for pasturage, **competition**, training or breeding qualify for customs duty free entry under tariff item No. 9993.00.00 and are **non-taxable** for the purposes of the GST/HST under the Non-taxable Imported Goods (GST/HST) Regulations and Item 39 of the Schedule to the Temporary Importation (Excise Levies and Additional Duties) Regulations. These provisions apply whether the importer is a resident or a non-resident of Canada.

108. Unless the inspecting officer has reasonable cause to believe that the horses will not be exported, the requirement to document the horses on a Form E29B and post a security deposit is waived. However, the importer must present any documentation required by OGDs" (Other Government Departments - such as the Health information described above.)

It is recommended you bring a copy of the Prize List and a copies of your entry forms as evidence of temporary import for competition.

The Washington State Department of Transportation website provides excellent resources, including links to current border wait times and links to state-wide traffic cameras to check current conditions.

Emailed entries must be **one per each horse** which will include the Entry form completed with signatures (Back page of entry form must have signatures as indicated on the top and the bottom of that page), horse papers, and all memberships (AHA & EC) required for this entry. Minors can **not** sign the entry form.

2. E-transfer must be done with the treasurer and a copy sent in with email or mail.

3. Cancellation of Entry. Exhibitors cancelling entries after the closing date of June 12, 2023 shall forfeit a refund of ALL fees unless accompanied with a valid Veterinarian Certificate showing the Owner name, Horse Name and cause of injury or illness.

4. Refunds will be considered upon receipt of a valid veterinarian certificate within seven (7) days after the occurrence of said illness or injury & is received by the show secretary by email or at the show office. No vet outs will be accepted after 8:00 am, July 18, 2023. Granted refunds will be sent by mail after the close of the show and payable to the owner of the horse. Vet outs will be refunded the AHA Resolution 9/90 fee as per AHA rules.

5. There will be **no refund of stall fees for any reason after June 26, 2023** unless the Region 17 Show Commission has cause to resell it and has agreed with the approval of the Trainer/Owner. However, if there is another horse owned by and/or exhibited by the same person as the vet-out horse then the new horse will be able to use the vet-out stall by contacting the show secretary who will contact the Show Commission for approval.

6. The **vet-out processing fee of \$25.00 per horse plus office fee & number fee will be retained** on all entries that are an approved vet-out.

7. Completion of Entry. Please make sure that all areas on the entry form are completed in full & signed where indicated. The entry form is considered a legal document. **No minor signatures.** All horses must be entered in the proper class and **must be entered in the name of their bonafide owner or lessee as per the registration papers.** Copy of a registered lease agreement must accompany entries for leased horses.

8. Minors 18 years of age or younger, or those who are still showing in Junior classes, can NOT sign the entry form. A parent/guardian signature is required on all signature lines (including rider and/or owner). The parent/guardian or trainer may sign as the responsible person on the entry form, understanding that the responsibility of that signature(s) includes the most responsible person signature.

9. Any entry accompanied with a postdated cheque will be processed on that date. If this date is after the closing date of entries, this entry will be considered a late entry and the double class fee will be charged. E-transfer must be paid when entered and confirmation included with the entry form, whether the entry is mailed or emailed.

10. Qualification Report Refer to 2023 AHA Handbook for details regarding the qualification of each horse as specified in the AHA handbook. It is up to the exhibitor/trainer to know this information.

11. Refer to AHA Article 1201.4. It is the responsibility of the person(s) signing the Entry Form to verify that the horse is eligible to be entered and verified to compete in the respective Regional Championship class(es).

Essential Information

- 12. AHA Competition Membership and EC Silver Sport or USEF equivalent licenses are required for the Regional Championship Show. A single event membership is not allowed at a Regional Show.** Affidavits are **not** allowed at any AHA approved show.
- 13.** Collect calls may be made to exhibitors/owners by the Entry Secretary if it is deemed necessary to clarify any information on the entry form or stabling form.
- 14. Acknowledgements will be sent out by email** to all trainers or owners. Please make sure that an email destination is on the entry form.
- 15. If items are required on your emailed acknowledgement, please bring those items to the show office.** Please do not email or mail them. Provide items needed to complete your entry/entries at the show office when picking up your assigned packet.
- 16.** The Show Commission reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries of any owner. EC Rule Book A805.
- 17. Eligibility** All horses entered must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry; the Canadian Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Registry; AHA Arabian Registry; or the AHA Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Registry.
- 18.** Geldings need to show as "Gelding" on the horse registration papers or entry may be considered incorrect. The only exception will be horses recently gelded whose papers have not yet been returned with the correction.
- 19. Returned Items** Upon receiving a returned cheque or an invalid credit card a \$50.00 charge will be levied and must be cleared immediately. After 30 days a \$100.00 charge will be levied. If after 45 days payment in full has not been replaced, the Show Commission has the option to report the payee to AHA and EC for suspension and/or to impose further action for future shows. All corrected payments and charges will be accepted by certified cheque, money order, cash or new credit card.
- 20. For your convenience payment by credit card or e-transfer (e-transfer exception: USA exhibitors) will be accepted** at this Region 17 Championship show. You may also pay by cheque. **All charges will be made in Canadian Dollars.**

IMPORTANT ARTICLE A602 -- MANDATORY INFORMATION

“All horses attending Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. ARTICLE A802 ENTRY FORMS (7.) the following statement, must be signed by the person(s) responsible):

“I hereby certify that every horse listed on this entry form has met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations”.

All Stalls must be cleaned before leaving the grounds. Region 17 will require a \$50.00 Cheque or a Credit Card sent with the entry form to be held in your file until the stall (s) are cleaned.

Awards

Region 17 Championship: Champion & Reserve Champion plus three additional awards shall be presented in each Regional Class to a **Top Five**. Per AHA rules, all results in this show will report placings First through to and including Fifth in ranked order.

In all Region 17 Championship classes: Champion will be awarded a Garland. Reserve Champion will be awarded a Garland. All remaining **Top Five placings** will receive a Top 5 Ribbon.

Full Top Five Awards will be given in all classes regardless of how many entries are competing, at the close of the gate, to a maximum of 5. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse, Achievement Award, High Point Amateur Achievement Award and Distance Award Points.

Awards – Pot of Gold (Jackpot)

Prize Payout – 100% of the nomination fee will make up the prize money payout as follows:

Champion – 40% Reserve Champion – 30% Remaining 3 of the Top 5 – 10% = 100% Ribbons to Top 5

No trophy will be presented to Champion or Reserve Champion placings. Monies will be paid within 90 days of the end of the show to the owner of the horse.

Region 17 Select Stallion Futurity Yearling classes will receive ribbons & prize money for **Champion, Reserve Champion & remainder of Top 5 placings**. Contact **Tammy Hayward** (306) 535-7402 email: Tammy.Hayward@fcl.crs if you have any questions regarding the Futurity Classes.

Prize Monies are added to specified ATR and JTR classes. In addition to Region 17 Championship Awards of a Champion and Reserve Champion Garland and Top Five Ribbons, Champions will receive \$400; Reserve Champions will receive \$200, and the remaining Top Five placings will receive \$100 each. See detailed information on page 8. Monies will be paid at the show to the amateur or junior riding the horse.

Barn Calls & Gate Holds

Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that their horse is at the gate at the prescribed time/call.** Every effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls, however **no protest will be upheld, nor will any section or class be changed on the basis of the public address system malfunctions.**

Exhibitors are responsible for reporting all entries to the Paddock Master before each respective class is called for showing and must enter the ring promptly when called. Remember the Paddock Master cannot see you, therefore it is important that you listen carefully and report immediately to the hitching ring when your class is called.

Two Minute Gate: In collective classes, the gate will close two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in large classes taking more than two minutes the gate will be closed at the completion of the final horse, in a continuous string of horses, entering the ring. **After the gate is closed, no entry will be allowed in unless approved by the Judge or Steward.** Rules- EC B1305.8.

In single event classes, such as reining, **the gate is will close within one (1) minute of that individual rider being called to the ring in the order that is posted on the Order of Go.** No entry shall go out of order unless approved by the Steward at the Ring or previously approved at the Show Office.

Every effort will be made to advise the exhibitor of any changes in the Tentative Schedule. Check in at the Show Office often as it will be posted.

Membership Requirements

- 1. General** Membership in AHA (EC Article B1302.3) and EC/USEF is required for all riders, drivers, owners, lessees, agents or trainers and handlers (see EC Article B1302.2). **Exception:** Owners that are listed on the registration papers as “and” or “and/or”. For show purposes, only one owner is required to be a member. Joint ownership does **not** allow for the owners to ride in Amateur classes unless the joint ownership is of the immediate family. Refer to current EC rules.
- 2. Sport Horse License for Arabian/H/AA entries** - All exhibitors, owners, trainers must possess a 2023 Provincial membership in their participating PSO and a **2023 “Silver” Sport License** from Equestrian Canada to compete in this Region 17 Championship Show.
- 3. Amateur** – No additional fee is charged to the Sport Horse License. However, Amateurs must complete the EC form. All exhibitors showing in AAOTR and AAOH classes or are an “ADULT” in an AOTR and AOTH classes must carry a current “Amateur” Sport Horse License card from EC/USEF – EC Rule #A902 Amateur Status must be applied for separately on an individual competitive license and is not automatic.
- 4. Farm, Syndicate or Business** Horses registered in the ownership of a Farm, Syndicate or Business must have an **AHA Business Membership and EC/USEF Farm Certificate** (see EC Rulebook for exact Canadian rule) AHA Business Memberships must be purchased directly from AHA (Article 701.6). A Business **must** provide documentation showing the owners of that business for owner classes. Joint ownership – if not of immediate family – will not be able to enter any “owner” class.
- 5. AHA Single Event Membership** is **not** allowed at a Regional or National Championship show. AHA Membership affidavits **will not** be accepted for verification of membership at any AHA recognized show. If you do not have a valid current competition membership card then you will have to purchase an AHA competition membership at the Region 17 Championship to participate in this show. See AHA Chapter 7. Article 705
- 6.** Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner, all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches & the person(s) signing the entry form blank) in an AHA recognized Arabian division at the time of entry into a competition, **must** submit a copy of a **valid AHA Competition card**. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the single event membership – exception Regional or National events. **Exhibitors in Walk-Trot classes must have memberships in a Regional or National event.**

When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self-coached. Coaches from other countries must be in good-standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance . See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments.

ARTICLE A102 SAFE SPORT ENVIRONMENTS

- 1. Effective 2022, EC Sport License holders at least 18 years of age must complete recognized Safe Sport training modules addressing the recognition and prevention of maltreatment in sport and concussion.**
- 2. Effective 2022, Coach Status is required to engage in coaching activities at EC sanctioned events.**

Ring Procedures

Grooms, attendants, & headers are to appear in the ring neat, clean & suitably attired, in the opinion of the Show Commission (clean, unmarked smock)

No person other than officials, steward, attendants on duty, & judge of the class may enter the show ring without permission from the call judge.

Any exhibitor using the wrong number or having no number may be excused or disqualified from the class at the discretion of the call judge.

Region 17 Championship will use the “in ring procedure” for all halter classes.

Stress

A horse shall not be punished unnecessarily or severely anywhere on show grounds. Abuse will be dealt with under the EC/AHA rules. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds, be selected for equine medication control testing. (EC Article 602.5) By entering the show all owners agree to testing for their horse(s) if selected for one.

A Silver show testing fee of \$7.00 is charged to all eligible horses and is included on the entry form. *EC statement: Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chairman of the provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chairman's appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing. Any horse entered in any class is required to pay drug testing fee & may be selected for Equine medication testing. This includes all Breeding & In-Hand horses.*

All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the show arena will be disqualified. The use of any substance to induce temporary heat will also not be allowed. If it is ascertained that an exhibitor has made, or caused to be made, any false statements in regards to any animal or article exhibited or if any exhibitor attempts to interfere with the judge in the performance of his/her duties, that exhibitor shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting.

Region 17 In Hand/Breeding Classes: In the Ring Class Procedure. Judging begins when the first horse enters the ring and its movement is being evaluated and scored. The horse shall enter at a trot. In order to lessen stress on In Hand horses, grooms/owners etc. will be requested to leave the hitching ring prior to the entry of each halter class.

Region 17 Championship In-Hand/Breeding classes will use the Majority Opinion System when utilizing a three-judge panel. Exception: “Performance Halter” will be judged using the Arabian Performance Halter Score Card, turned into placings and with the final placings for Champion, Reserve Champion and Top Ten determined by the Majority Opinion System.

Halter: - Rule reference AR114.: *One specified person assisting with entrance of in-hand horses into the ring will be allowed to use only the same length whip and appendages as are currently allowed for the individual handling the horse. Whips are to be no longer than 6' including snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted. The designated person will not hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, etc., to make any noise.*

In addition, the use of plastic or paper bags of any type or size is prohibited in assisting with entrance(s) into the arena

All In-hand horses are required to enter their halter class in the assigned, posted order of oldest to youngest.

Hunter Pleasure Performance 5 Years of Age & Under Pot of Gold Jackpot (Arabian & HA/AA) Competitors enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction, at the trot. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop both directions of the ring. To stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on quality, performance, suitability as a Hunter, manners and conformation.

Western Pleasure Performance 5 Years of Age & Under Pot of Gold Jackpot (Arabian & HA/AA) Competitors enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction at the jog-trot. To be shown at a walk, jog-trot and lope. To be judged on substance, quality, performance and manners.

Country English Pleasure Performance 5 Years of Age & Under Pot of Gold Jackpot (Arabian & HA/AA) Competitors enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction, at the normal trot. Light contact must be maintained with all reins at all gaits. To be shown at a walk, normal trot, and canter. It is mandatory that horses be asked to halt on the rail, stand quietly, back, and walk off on a loose rein at least one direction of the ring. To be judged on attitude, manners, quality and performance, in that order. It is imperative that the horse give the distinct appearance of being a pleasure to ride. A quiet, responsive mouth is paramount.

Awards: Prize Payout - 100% of the nomination fee will make up the prize money payout as follows:

Champion – 40% Reserve Champion – 30% remaining 3 of the Top 5 each – 10% = 100%

If there are fewer than 5 entries in any of these classes, money from the vacant placing(s) will be divided equally among the winners.

No trophy will be presented to Champion or Reserve Champion Placings. Ribbons will be given to all Top 5.

Award Money will be paid out to the owner of the horse within 90 days of the end of the show.

Qualifications

1. Qualification period is the previous year plus the current year up to the close of entries.
2. There are 3 Levels of Shows.
 - a. Level 1 AHA Recognized Qualifying Shows which includes Concurrent Shows, Pre-Shows, Value Shows.
 - i.e. Buckeye, Scottsdale
 - Participation Qualifies for Regionals and Nationals
 - b. Level 2 Regional and Regional Off-Site Championships
 - Top 5 and or participation Qualifies ONLY for Nationals. See #13 & 14 below.
 - c. Level 3 National Championships.
 - National Champ & Reserve can Qualify for Nationals per QUAL 113.
3. You can compete in any region.
4. An Amateur must qualify the horse to participate in an Amateur or Amateur Owner class. i.e **Any Amateur can qualify a horse for an owner class however only an owner can ride in an Owner class per USEF rules.**
5. Compete in a recognized section, i.e., HA/AA Western Pleasure, Arabian Country English Pleasure, Arabian Hunter Pleasure, etc.
6. Compete in any recognized class within that section. (Note: for Dressage, each level is considered its own section).
Exception: Performance Halter / Ranch Horse Conformation classes do NOT require competing in the Performance Halter Section or Ranch Horse Conformation Section. The horse must be qualified, entered and adjudicated in a performance class at that show. This is the only qualification required including Regional and National Shows.
7. Participate in that one recognized class in that section now qualifies you to compete in as many classes within that section at any one Regional Championship Show of your choice.
 - a. **Example:** Participate at a **Level 1** qualifying show in HA/AA Western Pleasure ATR qualifies for any and as many classes in HA/AA Western Pleasure as long as you meet the definition for an Amateur, Amateur Owner, Leveling, Jr. Horse, etc. *The qualification could have been earned in Region 8 but was used for the Region 6 Championship Show.*
8. Participate at two (2) **Level 1 AHA Recognized** Qualifying Shows and compete at any and as many Regional Championships in that section.
9. Equitation is based on the rider and the rider must participate in their qualifying section.
- A. **Youth** – to qualify for a National Championship Show, a rider must obtain:
 1. Win a Medal, in a class of three or more entries; or
 2. A participation qualification in AHA Medal classes or
 3. obtain Top Five or better from corresponding classes in Regional Championship Shows, East Coast Championship or Pacific Slope Championship, or a Top Six or better from corresponding classes in Eastern or Western Canadian Breeders Championship Classes.
- B. **Adult** – to qualify for a National Championship Show, a rider must obtain:
 1. A participation qualifications; or
 2. a Top Five or better from corresponding classes in Regional Championship Shows, East Coast Championship or Pacific Slope Championship, or a Top Six or better from corresponding classes in Eastern or Western Canadian Breeders Championship Classes. (For classes requiring a pattern, see USEF Subchapter AR 29).
10. Participation can also be used to qualify in Specialty classes and can be obtained through Open Shows (and placings for Working Western/Dressage/Western Dressage).
11. A National Show Commission has the right to place restrictions on cross entry into classes.
12. The USEF/EC family definition and two distinct non-family owner definition must be adhered to.
13. **Obtain a Regional placing and compete at any and as many National Championships in that section. If you do not place at Regionals, it counts as participation See #3 for Amateur and Owner classes. EXCEPTION (Placing or participation in Restricted Regional HA/AA ABS Yearling class can NOT be used for USN HA/AA Yearling classes**
14. East Coast and Pacific Slope (Top Five), Eastern and Western Canadian Breeders (Top Six) all count as Regional placings.
15. Participation definition:
 - a. In a class where horses compete together, participated means a horse/rider/driver/handler must have been entered, shown, and judged (must attempt to perform at all required gaits both ways of the ring and remain in the ring until excused by the judge). In other words, finishing the class.
 - b. In a class where horses compete individually, participated means a horse/rider must have completed the individual requirements of the class and be eligible to receive a score.
 - c. Horses which are excused/disqualified/eliminated/received a “no score” are not considered “adjudicated”.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccines, a letter must be provided with the entry form from a veterinarian, on official letterhead, stating the equine cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns. At the discretion of competition management, a log of the horse's temperature prior to arrival at the event site or during the event can be requested.

The Person Responsible for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares, responsibility for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules and is liable under the penalty provisions of the Rules for any violation of the EC Rules. For the purpose of these Rules, the Person Responsible is normally the trainer, owner or the competitor who rides or drives the horse during an event, or a parent or legal guardian in the case of junior (legal minor) competitors. The Person Responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed in the stables by himself or herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised. The Person Responsible must hold a valid EC Sport License in good standing at the same level or higher in which the horse is competing. Junior (legal minor) competitors cannot be the Person Responsible. In the case of Junior (legal minor) owner entries the Person Responsible may be a parent/ guardian OR an EC Sport License holder of age of majority.

2022 placings 1 - 6 recorded by AHA from AHA local shows may be used. A Top Five or better from a 2022 Regional may NOT be used!

CATEGORY I CLASSES (all except those in Category II, III, IV)

Regional Qualification: Participate at one (1) AHA qualifying show in order to compete at one Regional Championship of your choice. Participate at two (2) AHA qualifying shows in order to compete at any and as many Regional Championships.

CATEGORY II CLASSES: Junior horses, Pleasure & Country Pleasure Driving, Park Horse, Walk Trot 10 & Under, Walk Trot 11 & Over, Reining, Trail, Reined Cow Horse, Limited Reined Cow Horse, Working Cow Horse, Herd Work, Cutting, Ranch Riding, Ranch Reining, Ranch Trail, Ranch Working Cow, Ranch Horse Cow Work, Versatility Ranch Riding, Ranch Cutting, Ranch Rail, Ranch Horse Conformation.

Regional Qualification: Participate at one (1) AHA Qualifying Show or “Open Qualifying Show” (for Working Western, if enrolled) in order to compete at any and as many Regional Championships.

CATEGORY III CLASSES are those which require a “Program Enrollment” i.e., Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes classes, Performance and Breeding/In-hand futurities.
