Awards and Scoring	Classes will be judged and placed with ribbons awarded through 6 th place. Awards will be available 30 minutes after the results have been posted.
Coggins	Negative Coggins required with entry.
Dogs	All dogs must be on leash
Entries	Entries must be postmarked by Wednesday, June 29, 2022. A separate entry form with signature is required for each horse and rider combination. Show secretary reserves the right to limit dressage rides per rider, depending on scheduling. Late entries accepted on a space available basis, with a \$20 late entry fee. No class fees will be refunded after July 6, 2022.
Dressage Tests	All dressage tests will use the most current tests for US Dressage Federation, US Equestrian Federation, Western Dressage Association of America, or US Eventing Association
Food	There will be concessions on grounds
Grounds	HOI Arena has an indoor and outdoor arena. Show conditions will determine which arena is used. Tests at or above 1 st level will anticipate being outdoors
Order of Class	Tentative start time Dressage 8:00 am / Combined Stadium 12:00 PM
Refunds	If rain forces a show cancellation management will first try to establish a rain date of the following weekend and may refund entry fees ONLY if a rain date is unavailable.

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RELEASE, WAIVER, AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

The undersigned participant of an S2 Horse Shows event agrees to the following:

1. Assumption of Risk and Waiver: Participant understands and accepts the risks of engaging in equine activities and merely being near a horse, mule, or pony (collectively "equine"), including (i) the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to the participant (for example, jump, run, kick, buck, bolt, spin, rear up, strike, or bite), (ii) the inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or animals, (for example, kick, buck, bolt, spin, rear up, strike, or bite), and (iii) the hazards of surface or subsurface conditions. Participant understands the resulting injuries, death, and property damage that may result from the accepted risks of engaging in equine activities or just being near an equine, that equines are powerful and have the potential to be dangerous, even without warning, and that the risks listed in this Agreement are just a sampling and Participant is not relying on the Released Parties to this Agreement to list all possible equine-related risks. Member therefore agrees, on his/her own behalf and on behalf of his/her minor Member, to at all times to be responsible for his/her personal safety, remain financially responsible for his/her medical expenses, and waives his/her right to any claims arising from his/her participation in or observation of any equine activities, being near an equine, or mere presence at an S2 Horse Shows Event. Participant understands the risks and dangers inherent in equine activities and agrees to assume them on his/her own behalf and on behalf of the minor Participant, and Participant's guests, visitors, family members, heirs, agents, and assigns.

2. Release, Hold Harmless, Indemnification: Participant agrees to release and hold the organizers, their respective relatives, directors, other participants, partners, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, assistants, managers, officers, representatives, assigns, volunteers, employees, independent contractors, and others acting on their behalf (collectively "Released Parties"), harmless for any illness, injury, death, damage, or other loss (collectively "Losses") incurred unless directly caused by their gross negligence or wanton and willful misconduct. Participant agrees to indemnify Released Parties against all Losses sustained or suffered by any person or entity (including, but not limited to, anyone a party or not a party to this Agreement), whether caused by Released Parties directly or indirectly, and which shall include the reimbursement of Released Parties' costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees.

3. Governing Law and Time Limitation: This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. All disputes relating to the interpretation and enforcement of the provisions of this Agreement shall be resolved exclusively by the federal court or state court located in Illinois, and the parties hereto hereby submit to the jurisdiction and venue of the Court for such purpose. Participant agrees that any and all claims and/or causes of action, for Losses by Participant, on his/her own behalf and/or on behalf of a minor Participant, against the Released Parties, must be brought within one (1) year of the date they accrue.

4. Attorneys' Fees: Participant agrees to reimburse organizers for any and all expenses, costs, and attorneys' fees incurred by it in enforcing the terms of this Agreement and/or in defending or prosecuting any claims or causes of action involving, or in any way relating to, Participant.

5. Participant Certification: Participant certifies that he/she has read this entire Agreement and understands, agrees, and intends on his/her own behalf, and on behalf of his/her heirs, agents, representatives, relatives, successors, and assigns, to be bound by all of the terms and conditions contained herein.

6. Notice to all attendees and participants: There may be photographers taking pictures and video during the event, approved by show management. With your entrance to the show, you are giving permission for S2 Horse Shows to use any photos and/or videos of you which might appear in future promotional materials or advertising used for S2 Horse Shows.
