All tests, the show, judge, and each participant adhere to the rules in accordance with USEF/WDAA guidelines. Ribbons will be awarded to the top 6 placings in each division of each class. Belt buckles will be awarded to the high score champion in each division (Junior, Adult Amateur, and Open).
