We are excited to begin year nine of our open horse show series at the Chemung County Fairgrounds in Horseheads, NY sponsored by the Chemung County Agricultural Society. Our main objective is to provide a FUN and REWARDING show environment at a great facility! 2022 pointed shows: May 7 & 8, June 4 & 5, July 9 & 10, August 6 & 7 (Chemung County Fair – double pointed) and September 3 & 4. Division high point awards will be given at the end of each show day. Year-end awards: We will be giving year end awards at a banquet in the winter for individual class awards & Top 10 horse awards. Again this year the requirement is that you be a member of our club (TTC) and show 5 of the 9 shows and Western Dressage exhibitors are required to show 3 of the 4 shows, to be considered for the year end awards. TTC General Rules:

- Chemung County Agricultural Society and Chemung County are not responsible for any accident, injury, loss, theft, etc
 of the horse, rider or belongings during any TTC/Chemung County Agricultural Society sponsored event.
- Negative coggins conducted with in the present or preceding calendar year for <u>instate</u> horses; For 2021 this would mean that the test would have to been conducted in 2021 or 2022 AND current rabies required for all entries. For all <u>out of state</u> horses the coggins needs to be conducted within 2022. All interstate Health Certificate rules apply.
- You and your horse need to participate in 5 out of the 9 shows & Western Dressage exhibitors in 3 out of 4 shows and be a current TTC member to qualify for year-end awards. An exhibitor must compete in the same class in at least 5 TTC shows to be eligible for a year end award in that class.
 - Membership (Family/Individual) must be filed and paid before the show to have class placing count toward year end points
- Exhibitors must show in appropriate class for the age. Horses must show in appropriate class for the age. Youth
 cannot show in adult division or vice versa. Age for exhibitor is as of January 1st of the current year.
- Lead line Division: Age 8 & Under. Note: If you (parent) choose to enter a child under 5 years old you do so at your own risk and you will be required to sign a waiver. A side-walker is encouraged and accepted for safety precautions. The side-walker is not to talk to or assist in any way except safety.
- AQHA and USEF rules are to be used as guidelines. <u>Judge's decisions are final</u>.
- Stallions are not to be exhibited by anyone under 19 years of age.
- An exhibitor may move up into a new Age division during the course of the year, but they may only qualify for year end
 awards in one age division. They may not cross enter into a new age division in a specific show.
- Walk Jog/Trot Exhibitors CAN NOT enter into any other division (even with another horse). You can enter the open walk jog/trot classes, age appropriate showmanship classes, halter and In-Hand Trail classes.
- There must be 3 horses shown in 3 classes within a division for a weekend high point award to be given **EXCEPT** Leadline and Youth Walk/Jog/Trot Divisions and the Youth 18 & Under Division.
- Any class with less than 3 horses entered the committee reserves the right to combine or cancel the class.
- Registration papers (copy) are to be on file in the office when entering Registered Halter Classes and/or Breed classes
- Jackpot Classes: \$15 to enter with \$50 added for 1-5 entries and \$100 added for 6-10 entries paybacks to be awarded to the 1st-4th placings (35%, 30%, 20%, 15%).***There MUST be at least 3 horses shown in the class to get payback***
- Novice Division Rules: The exhibitor to have not won more than 5 blue ribbons in the class being entered with a class size of 5 or more entries. <u>Can cross enter into other divisions following the rules of that division</u>. We ask that you be honest with entering this division our show staff will do our best to monitor this.
- Green Horse Division Rules: The horse must be within their 1st and 2nd year of showing. Can cross enter into other divisions following the rules of that division. ****This will be an English and Western combined division****
- Color Breed Division: Will be open to ANY color breed (Must have registration papers on file in the show office). The Division will consist of Showmanship, HUS, Hunt Seat Equitation, Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, and Trail. This is an open division so under saddle classes will be walk, jog/trot, lope/canter.
- Ranch Horse Division Rules: Will be judged using AQHA guidelines. No horses less than 3 years of age are eligible.
 <u>No horse may cross enter into a western pleasure class regardless of age division</u>. The horse can be shown in all other divisions/classes, the ONLY exception to that rule is that the "horse" can be shown in all walk jog/trot classes with a different exhibitor (than the one showing Ranch Horse) as their pleasure is a combined English and Western class.

- Youth Divisions: They will be combined to be Youth 18 & Under for running class purposes. We will continue to award a weekend high points and year end class high points for Youth 13 & Under and Youth 14-18. The age divisions need to be designated on each entry form so that the office staff can ensure correct awarding of weekend high points.
- TTC Versatility Year End Award: This is open to any TTC member (judged on horse/rider combo) to participate in this program all you have to do is show in the following classes at the corresponding shows: June 5th Halter Class (can be any halter class your highest placing (with the most number of exhibitors in the class) will be counted toward the year end award); August 6th or 7th HUS or Western Pleasure (can do both only your highest placing (with the most number of exhibitors in the class) will be counted toward the year end award); September 4th Equitation or Horsemanship (can do both only your highest placing (with the most number of exhibitors in the class) will be counted toward the year end award). The top point earning horse will receive a monetary award at the end of the year (presented at the year- end awards banquet).
- ****NEW*** Western Dressage is being added to the Sunday shows of our June, July, September shows and respective classes held at the Chemung County Fair Horse Show. Dressage exhibitors must show 3 of the 4 shows to count for year end awards.
 - Multiple Riders horses may be ridden by multiple riders Each horse/rider combination requires a separate entry with signatures and emergency contact
 - Level Restrictions:
 - Horses may not compete in the same test in a different division even with a different rider (ex. Basic Level Test 3 Open Rider and Basic Level Test 3 Amateur Rider)
 - Horses may only compete in levels that are adjacent with the same rider. For example a horse
 may not be ridden in a Basic Level Test and a Level 2 Test UNLESS it is with a different rider
 - Maximum Dressage Tests per day Horses may not compete in more than 6 tests per day
 - Tests: Current WDAA/USEF Western Dressage tests are available at www.westerndressageassociation.org
 - Attire and Equipment: USEF rules and guidelines will be used for attire and equipment. For more inform ation please visit www.usef.org
 - Protective headgear must be worn.
