Western Dressage Jr riders are ages <18 on January 1, 2022.

USDF rules and guidelines will be adhered to four English tests and equipment. English Jr. Riders are ages <21 on January 1, 2022. All riders must wear a helmet while mounted. No bareback riding allowed and no dogs allowed.

Attire: WDAA show equipment and attire required (long sleeve shirt).

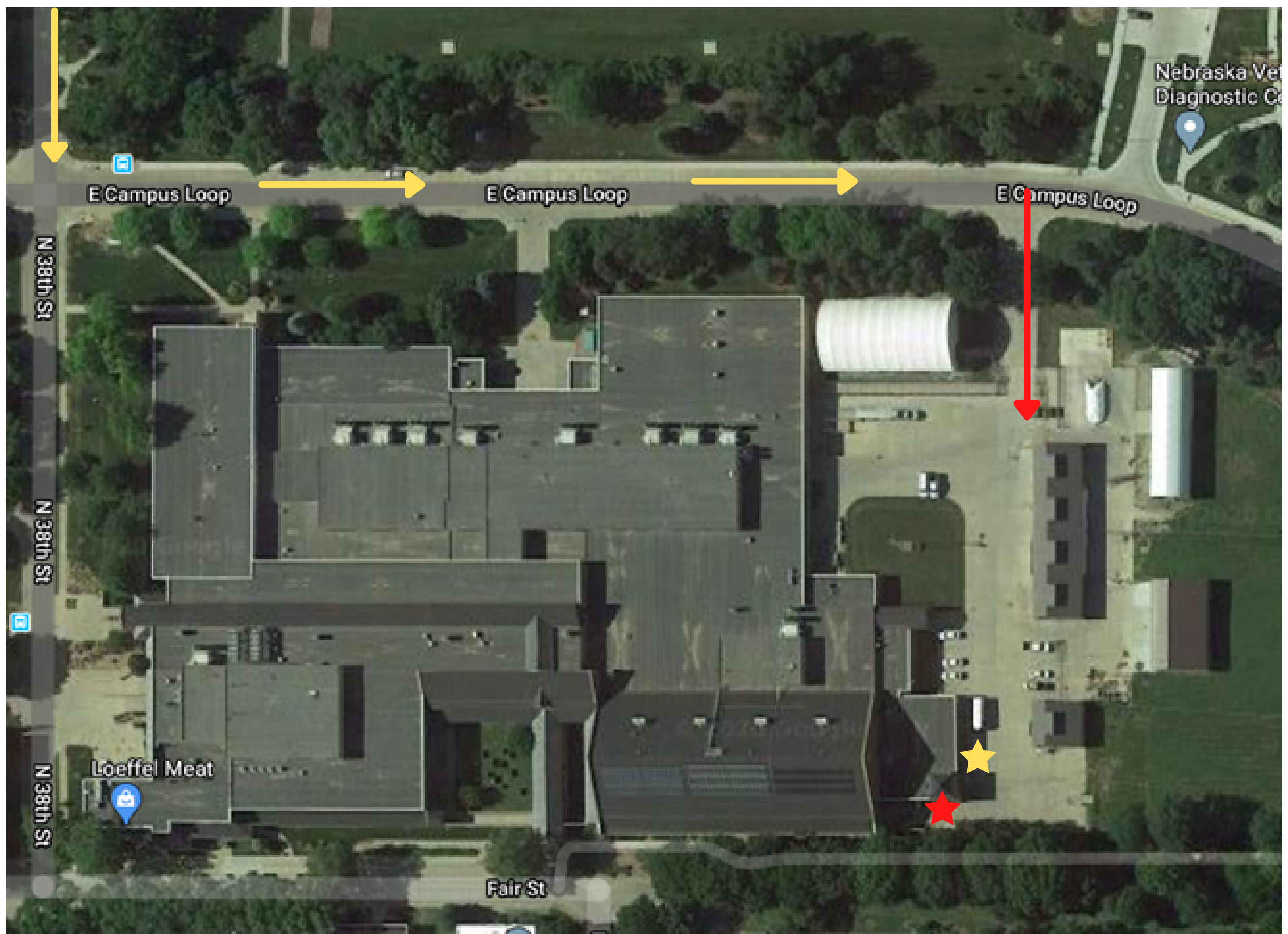
Liability Release - Adult must sign before you receive your number at the show

# 2022 Dressage Schooling Show Parking & Directions



The address for the Animal Science Complex is: 3940 Fair Street Lincoln, NE 68583-0908. However, that will get you to the front of the building. You will want to park in the area to the east of the Animal Science Building.

Depending on the direction you are coming from, I recommend the following:

- From the west — go to 33rd and Huntington and turn east./From the east go to 48th and Leighton and turn west. I recommend going to one of the two intersections even if coming from the south. Traffic flow on the south side of campus is not horse trailer friendly in all spots.
- From either direction, go to 38th street and there is the north entrance for UNL East Campus. Turn south.
- At 38th and East Campus Loop, you will want to turn and go east. You will go approximately two blocks and turn right to the entrance of the back of the Animal Science Building. (As directed below with red arrow). There will be an open chain link gate.
- You can park anywhere in the concrete area by/beyond the arrow. The horse barn entrance is south near the chain link fence as indicated by the yellow star. (There is a grain bin just outside the door). There also is a walk thru door you can use if you do not have a horse as indicated by the red star
