Entries:

Enter ONLINE: Entries may be made online at www.horseshowsonline.com. Click the Show Selector tab and scroll to the **WDACO Spring Into Summer Show** in the list. Complete the online entry form and submit the entry to the show secretary. The Show Secretary will email an invoice once your entry is accepted. Then you can submit your payment to info@wdaco.org using PayPal with a comment that states *August 13th show fees*. For payment assistance, please call the Show Secretary.

OR

For paper entries go to: www.wdaco.org to print entry forms. Make checks payable to WDACO and send entries together with check and required documents to the show secretary (Didi DeKrey, 10318 Miners Lake Road, Ft. Collins, CO 80524). Ride times will be sent via e-mail unless otherwise specified. You may send your entry any time after the opening date and entries must be postmarked no later than closing date (postmarked). Every horse/rider team requires a separate entry and office fee.

An Entry is Complete when:

- *A vaccination record (Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) within 6 months of show date) accompanies each entry. (USEF GR 845.)*
- *All horses traveling from out of state must have a health certificate dated within 30 days of horses' arrival at the show as well as a copy of a negative Coggins test dated within the 12 months of the show date and a current vaccination record. Your health certificate will be checked at the show office.*
- *WDACO Liability form must be signed by Rider/Owner/Trainer.*
- *All fees are paid*

All information must be received before entering show grounds. Thank You!

All grooms, family, assistants, etc., who will be on the Fairgrounds during the show must sign the WDACO Liability Release when arriving at the venue.

Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, based on postmark/electronic submission date. Entries may be limited.

Late entries are accepted on a space-available basis and charged a \$30/entry late fee.

If classes are oversubscribed, a "wait list" will be maintained. Horses will be moved into the show based on wait list order prior to scheduling. After the show has been timed, show secretary will work wait list horses to get them into the show based on the best fit with the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Day Sheet: Be certain to check the day sheet, which will be posted near the indoor arena.

Refunds: Up to closing date, all fees are refundable except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from a wait list. During the competition no refunds including 'Acts of God' will be issued. **Office fee is non-refundable.**

Awards: Ribbons to 5th place in all classes. Management reserves the right to break ties. High Point awards will be given for each division; Open, Amateur, Junior, Gaited Open, Gaited Amateur, and Gaited Junior. There will also be a High Point Overall award for the rider with the highest score regardless of level or Division.

Freestyle Classes – please provide a USB flash drive containing your music.

You may enter any class you wish. You may enter multiple classes; however, you cannot ride in two non-consecutive levels (i.e. Intro and Level 2). We recommend that you keep your entries to a maximum of four classes per horse per day. ***Class schedule will not be in order of the class list but rather based on entries. Specific ride time(s) will be emailed to you before the show. Please make sure your entry is filled out legibly, especially your e-mail address so you can receive your ride times via email prior to the show.***

Competition Rules

Amateur Status: Riders competing in amateur classes may not have received payment or any kind of remuneration for services or other equine activities. GR 1306.

Open Status: An adult (over 18 years of age) engaging in professional activities as defined by USEF rules.

Junior Status: Riders are eligible to compete as juniors if they are 17 years of age or less at the beginning of the 2024 competition year (December 1, 2023 – November 30, 2024). GR 103.

Numbers: You will be provided with a bridle/halter number for each horse/rider combination. Horses must always have a bridle number attached when outside of their stall.

Horses Not Competing: Non-competing horses must have a separate entry.

Tests: We will be using the 2022 WDAA Western Dressage tests, which are available at <https://westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-tests/>

Attire and Equipment: USEF rules and guidelines will be used for attire and equipment. For more information, please review the USEF rules WD 120, 121, 122, and 123. **An ASTM safety helmet is required whenever riding for competitors under the age of 18. Proper footwear is required for all competitors.**

Dogs: No dogs are allowed on the premises.

Hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accident Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

Other: Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules and of the current USEF/WDAA rules will be judged in accordance therewith.

Scheduling, and Scoring

Scheduling

Ride Conflicts: Competitors with multiple horses and horses with multiple riders are urged to bring enough help. If a conflict is discovered, notify the show secretary immediately.

Official Ride Times

Acknowledgements: Entries will be acknowledged via email upon receipt by the show secretary. **Provisional Ride Times:** Provisional ride times will be emailed. **Day Sheet:** Be certain to check the day sheet, which will be posted near the indoor arena.

Musical freestyle sound check is during the morning break. Take your music to the show manager upon arrival to the show grounds. Music must be on a flash drive with a MP3 format. No CDs.

Scores

Tests will be scored and posted outside the show office. It is the responsibility of the competitor to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day.

Tests and ribbons are available after the class is completed. Please allow at least 30 minutes from the class's last ride time before sending a designated person to pick them up.

Stabling

Facility Information

Please stop at the show office to obtain your stall assignments and bridle numbers and sign Liability Release prior to unloading. Stall fee **does not** include shavings, buckets for water or feed. If you require shavings, you must bring your own. The stall chart will be posted in the large animal barn on the evening before the show. We request that stalls be requested in advance of the show.

Early Arrival and Extended Stay: On the entry form please indicate your arrival and departure dates if you are reserving stalls. A scheduled arrival time may need to be arranged and additional day stall fees may apply for early arrivals or extended stays.

Arena

The indoor arena will be available for warm up and getting horses accustomed to the surroundings on Friday afternoon/evening not later than 3 to 7 PM. Please advise the Show Secretary what time you plan to arrive to warm up. Maximum three people inside the dressage arena at a time; others may warm up outside the dressage arena until space is available.

NO LUNGEING IN THE INDOOR ARENA.

Warm-up and lunging arenas: Warm up and lunging areas will be available outside before and during the show.

Facility Location and Parking

Directions: Take I-25 to the Plum Creek Exit #181. Turn east at the signal onto Plum Creek Parkway. Go east on Plum Creek Parkway, approximately one mile to Fairgrounds Road (3rd light). Turn left on Fairgrounds Road. Once you are on the Fairgrounds keep going east between indoor arena and admin building until you get to end of road. Turn left and follow along the indoor arena to parking and barns.

WDACO RELEASE, WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT:

Every entry in a WDACO sponsored event/competition or WDACO sponsored competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, handler and the horse), for themselves, their principles, representatives, employees and/or agents: (1) Shall be subject to the Constitution, By-Laws and rules of the WDACO, all licensing Organizations and the local rules of the competition and the rental location; (2) Represents that every horse, rider, driver, and handler is eligible as entered; (3) Agrees to be bound by the Constitution, By-Laws and rules of the WDACO, all licensing Organizations and of the competition, and will accept as final, the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the competition, the WDACO, other officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) Agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, they authorize the WDACO, and/or the competition management to market, transfer, assign or otherwise make any use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcast, cablecasts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horses(s) and participants(s) while on the grounds, incident to, on in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion, cover-age or benefit of the event, sport, or the WDACO, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waives and releases any rights in connection with such, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation; and (5) Agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and all horse competitions are dangerous and involve inherent risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to hold the WDACO, the competition and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless from and against all claims including claims based on negligence, breach of contract, strict liability and/or otherwise for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition, officials, directors, employees or agents of the WDACO or the competition. The construction and application of WDACO rules are governed by the laws of the State of Colorado, and any action instituted against the WDACO must be filed in the State of Colorado.
