## Show Series Rules

- 1. This competition is open to horses and ponies of any gait or breed.
- 2. All classes will be divided into Open, Junior, Amateur, Gaited.
- 3. Please designate on your entry which division you are riding.
- 4. USDF, WDAA, and NAWD tests will be used.
- 5. Readers are permitted.
- 6. Proper turnout appropriate for a schooling show is expected for both horse and rider. No T-shirts or Tank Tops. ASTM hard hats are mandatory.
- 7. Horse and Rider as a team must attend and compete in at least 3 shows in order to qualify for series year end awards.
- 8. Year-end awards will be based on average of top six (6) scores earned by horse and rider combination.
- 9. Management reserves the right to make adjustments to class offerings, Judges and awards offered as needed.
- 10. All horses on grounds must have a current Coggins test (within 12 months).
- 11. The Show Committee will render the final decision on any disputes which may arise.
- 12. Exhibitors desiring early arrival or delayed departure should contact Show Manager for availability.
- 13. On entry form, select which test you want to ride and note the division. Open (O), Amateur (A), Junior (J), Gaited (G)
- 14. Championships will be based on the top six scores. Must attend three (3) shows.
- 15. Musical Freestyle music must be on CD. And turned into office the morning of the show.

#### 16. Rules for Team Competition:

- 1. Will be divided by Classical, Western, Gaited
- 2. 3 or 4 riders per team. May consist of 1- professional, 3 or 4 amateur or juniors.
- 3. Top score from 3 riders, if 4 lowest score will be dropped, unless only canter class.
- 4. At least one rider MUST ride Training/Basic or above.
