2024 Winning Ways with Western Dressage Rules and Guidelines

Entries: Open to all breeds and levels. Entries for competing AQHA horses must include current AQHA registration papers, AQHA membership cards. All entries need entry form, Coggins, liability release and fees. One entry form per horse and rider combination. Entries must be registered online at <https://form.jotform.com/233404428301142>. Closing date Friday, June 14. Entries received after June 14, based on availability, may be accepted with a late fee of \$25. No refunds after closing date.

Fees: The same horse/rider combination may enter a maximum of 3 classes per day. Fees are \$45.00 per class which includes results reporting to AQHA and WDAA. There is a \$30.00 office fee per horse/rider combination.

Stabling and lodging: Onsite stabling is \$25 per night, bedding NOT included nor available for purchase. Please bring own bedding. Camping \$30 per night. Nearby hotels <https://bit.ly/46N3Kdy>.

Schooling: Schooling is available at the Complex on Friday afternoon (2:00 pm) for horses that are registered for the show. There is no schooling in the show arena on the day of the show.

Footing: 20m x 60m arena, 20m x 40m for Intro and Basic dependent upon number of entries. Arena size to be confirmed by closing date.

Awards: Ribbons or medals through sixth place. A high score award will be presented to the highest scoring rider of the day in each division (Open, Amateur and Youth).

Sunday-Tuesday Clinics: See the detailed information below. Register online separately or with horse show. Enter NA for any fields not pertaining to clinic registration.

On Sunday join the group for an 8:00 classroom session on the levels, geometry of the arena and basic rules for competition. After this session 8 riders have the opportunity to ride with higher accuracy. Monday and Tuesday 10 riders will work with Lynn in 2 groups. The clinic will follow a succession to improve rider and horse at their current level or prepare for their next level.

Lynn will offer tips to grow your scores through corrections in rider's position and balance, use of aids or improving horse's balance. With a conclusion at the end of the day, a dedicated time to Questions and Answers for all aspects of western dressage is your chance to collect information you need to host an event, compete, instruct, or coach.
