Ohio Championships

Exhibitors wanting to be a part of the Ohio Championships must be Current WDAA and OWDA members.

You DO NOT have to be a USEF, WDAA or OWDA member to participate in this Too Hot to Trot Show.

Exception: Amateur riders. Riding in the Amateur classes must be USEF members and have an amateur status card. IF you are NOT a USEF Amateur, you will be placed in the open classes.

All USEF members over 18 years of age must complete the Safe Sport Training.

Sunday OWDA Champion Awards

Will be presented to riders who have the highest average of their two highest scoring tests in one level. One test must be Test 4.

Join OWDA and your membership is good through 12/31/2023

Amateur riders and USEF members must send a copy of their safe sport certificate with their entry!

ENTRIES: All entries must be postmarked by July 31st with correct fees, current Coggins, shipping reports for all out of states horses, and completed forms.

Competitors wishing to take part in the Ohio Championship must be OWDA & WDAA members before the closing date.

LATE ENTRIES: postmarked after the closing date. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of management and will incur a late fee of \$35.

NONCOMPETING HORSE: must complete an entry and pay \$50 plus stall or grounds fee.

CLASS CHANGES: must be approved by management: \$10 per change.

EQUIPMENT: USEF rules and guidelines will be used for attire and equipment.

OUT OF STATE HORSE: Please ensure you have the appropriate documentation for your horses per the Ohio Department of Agriculture. http://www.agro.ohio.gov

STABLING: Stalls and tack stalls will be assigned "first come, first serve" basis by receipt of entry. If the requested stalls are filled, competitors will be assigned to other stall areas. Horse Barns 1 and 2 are approximately 10x10 new portable stalls. Brushed cement floor for outside wash racks. **NO OUTSIDE BEDDING.** There is a 2-bag minimum required. **Early arrival fee is \$40 per stall per day.** Please let us know on entry form if you have a barn preference. **Groups must fill out Stabling form to guarantee stabling together. One person should fill out this form and send with entry.**

NO REFUNDS: after closing date. Refunds before the closing date will be issued for the amount minus the \$30 office fee. Returned checks (NSF) will incur a \$50 fee. If not rectified within 10 days, the matter will be turned over to USEF for disciplinary action.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded first through sixth place. No awards will be mailed unless arrangements are made with the show secretary. Ohio Championships will be awarded after the show Sunday and awarded first through tenth.

RIDE TIMES: Tentative ride times will be available online at http://wdaoh.org by the Tuesday prior to the show, including the pre-printed showbill, are to be considered tentative until non the day before the show. Please check your ride times outside the show office, on the results board, for up-to-date times.

FOOTING: Pavilion (outdoor covered arena) Sand base arena, 130'x 385. All tests will be ridden in 20X60 arenas and will be reduced to a 20X40 for the Intro and Basic Levels.

RV HOOK UPS: 30- & 50-amp service available. No water or sewage. 2 city water filling station and dump station available

ACCOMODATIONS: Several local hotels. Information on Hotels is in the back of prize list.

VETRINARIAN: On call names and numbers to be posted at the office

FARRIER: Will be on call.

SHARPS DISPOSAL: Containers are located in each barn.

MANAGEMENT: reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and/or cancel awards of prizes without claims for damages and change order of classes, cancel splits, or combine classes at its discretion if entries deem necessary.

Food and Beverages: provided by Champions Grill and Bakery. Restaurant and Bar is located the Champion Center Arena.

Dogs: Are welcome but must be on a leash no longer than 6', at all times. Any loose dogs will result in the owner being charged \$50 that will be donated to local animal rescues. Any nuisance dogs will be asked to leave the grounds.

DIRECTIONS: 4122 Laybourne Rd is the entrance for the Champions Center.

Coming from the North on I-70, take exit 59. At the traffic light go straight across on the entrance ramp for I-70 then turn right on to Laybourne Rd; the entrance to the facility is on the right side of the road.

Coming from the South on I-70, take exit 59. At the traffic lights turn right across the bridge, at the next lights turn left on to the entrance ramp to I-70, then turn right on to Laybourne Rd; the entrance to the facility is on the right side of the road.

- c) Hazards, including, but not liable to, surfaces or subsurface conditions;
- d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other person, including, but not limited to, failing to main control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").
